

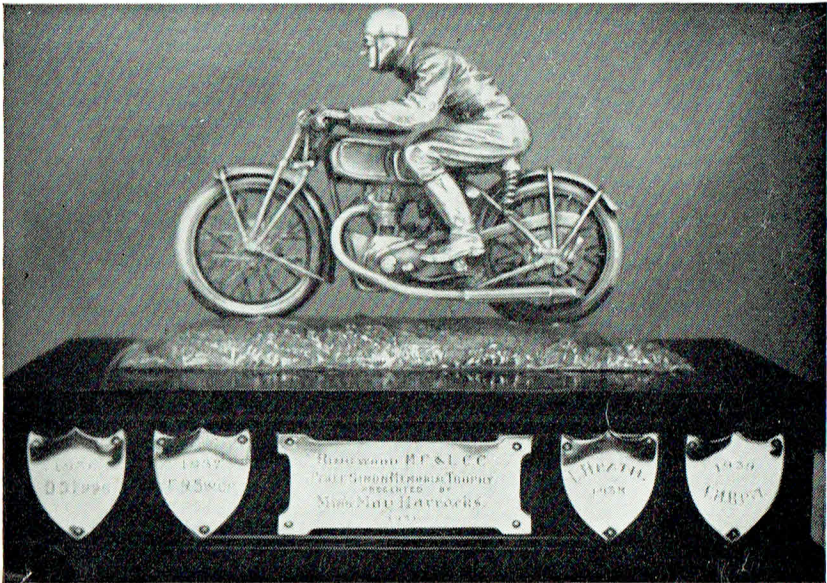

THE PERCE SIMON

WHY THE PERCE SIMON

Very briefly, the Simon brothers moved from Basingstoke into the Parkstone area in the 1930's, eventually joined the Ringwood Club and soon became well known locally in motor-cycling circles.

When Perce Simon was unfortunately killed during a Scramble, an exceptionally fine trophy was presented to the Club in his memory by his fiancée.

Frank Simon, who was a keen Trials and Scrambles rider, and who won the Perce Simon Trophy in 1937, was killed early in the last war whilst serving as a Sergeant Pilot.

The Trial was granted National status in 1938.

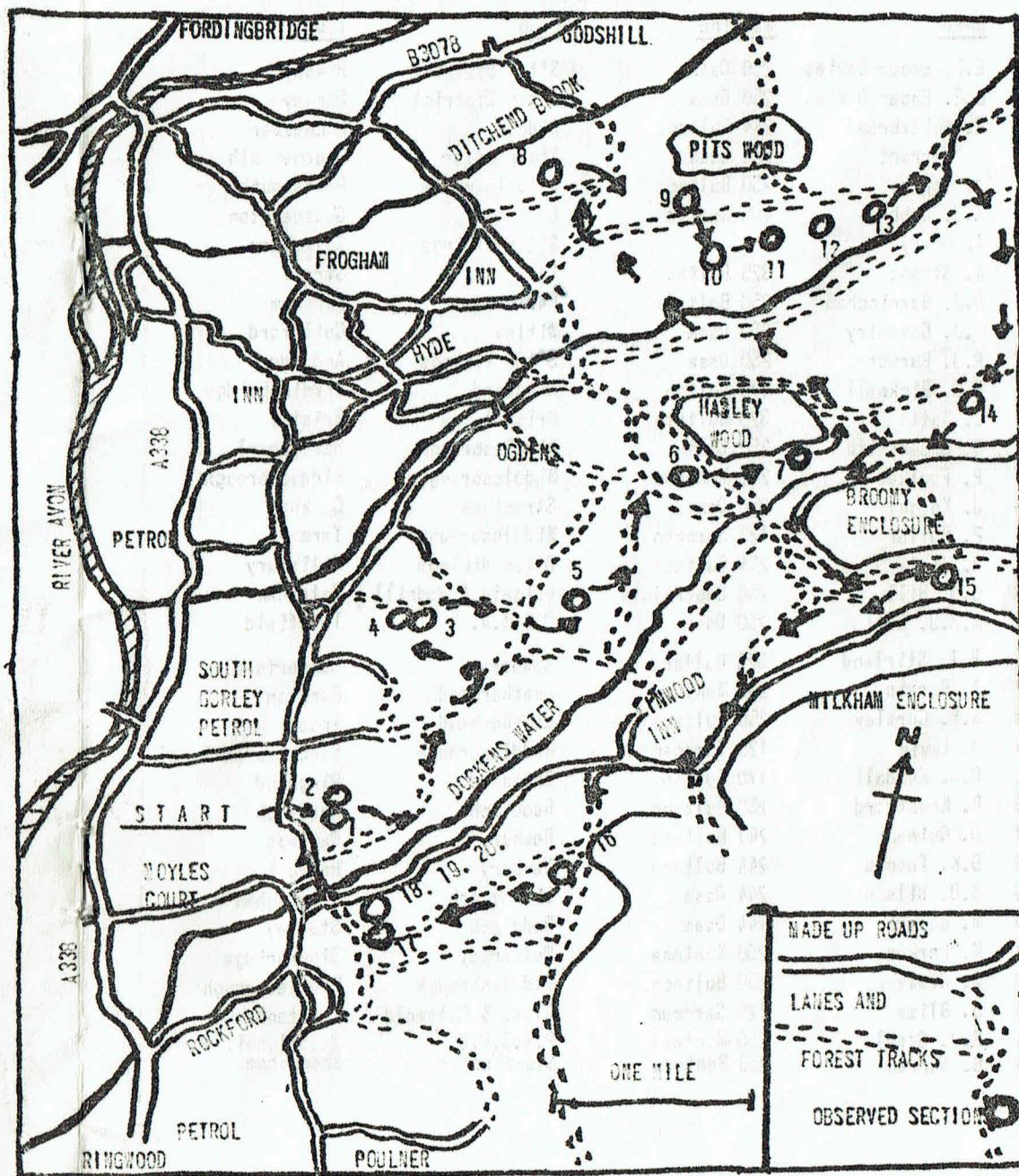

| 2. IBSLEY MOUNT | Steep climb through sand and heather steps. |
| 3. BOTTOMS UP | Mud approach to steep sandy climb. |
| 4. CUCKOO HILL | Muddy stream bed. |
| 5. LINHOOD | Severe hummacky muddy hill. |
| 6. HASLEY | Up, down, up over muddy humps. |
| 7. FOXES END | Nadgery round trees and loose sand. |
| 8. CHILLY HILL | Mud with good bottom out over steep heather. |
| 9. LONG BOTTOM | Wide deep mud ever upwards. |
| 10. ALDERWOOD | Very steep out over muddy slope. |
| 11. DOUBLE CRATER | Up through peat bog out over clay bomb crater. |
| 12. HAMPTON END. | Twist over deep mud and tufts. |
| 13. HAMPTON BOTTOM | More mud laced with small stones. |
| 14. SLODEN | Up and down on dry rooted hillside. |
| 15. BROOMY | Nadger on rooted stream bed. |
| 16. BADGERS HOLT | Up through deep bog. |
| 17. STEPS | Nadger round trees out over steep bank. |
| 18. THREE TREE 1. | Steep loose sand climb. |
| 19. THREE TREE 2. | Down and up loose gravel. |
| 20. THREE TREE 3. | Down and up over roots out on loose sand. |

Firstly if you are competing the ONLY motor cycles we want to see are the machines that are to be used in the event. Please leave all others at home, including any used by children as the Club intends to do all in its power to prevent any machines (other than competitor's) from being ridden anywhere (other than on the roads) in the area of the course.

Competitors are asked to cause as little trouble as possible and please help to keep the noise down, show a great deal of respect to anyone you should meet on the route especially if they are riding a horse. Please remember if people are walking or horse riding they have RIGHTS-we haven't.

If you are coming along to see what is going on, please confine yourselves to areas where your car can be parked without causing any bother, DO NOT drive off the roads and Please NO LITTER.

Remember this event is fighting for its very life.

Please help us in these matters and please tell other people if you see them doing anything that could cause annoyance or damage. If we can show that the event can be run without unduly upsetting anyone, then maybe we shall be able to continue to run it.

AWARDS :

The Perce Simon Trophy and Award for the best solo performance.

The Vale Cup and Award for the next best solo performance.

The Dorset Cup and Award for the best sidecar performance.

An Award for the next best sidecar performance.

Three Special First-Class Awards to the next best solo performances.

Team Awards to each member of the winning team in each Class.

As in regulation 6(a) and (b).

First Class Awards to the next best 10 per cent of finishers riding solo machines.

Second Class Awards to the next best 10 per cent of finishers riding solo machines.

The Perce Simon Trophy, the Vale Cup and the Dorset Cup are Challenge Trophies and will be held for one year only or until the next Perce Simon Trial, whichever is the sooner.

The Dorset Cup will be awarded only in the event of four or more sidecar entries being received, 1st Class Awards will be Awarded to the next 10 per cent of finishers and 2nd Class Awards to the next best 10 per cent of finishers in the Sidecar Category. An award will be given to the passenger of the winning sidecar.

The **CLUB CUP** for the best performance by a Trials League Registered member of the Ringwood Club on a solo machine.

No driver may win more than one award other than a team award and the Club Cup.

THE OBSERVERS. Our thanks to all those who have turned out (and to their wives who have let them) including most of the local Clubs. Often a very thankless task, one which must be done but not taken for granted.

A canteen will be at the start serving hot drinks and refreshments until the conclusion of the trial. The Perce Simon Trial is only made possible by the permission of the Forestry Commission and their co-operation, together with that of the Hants. C.C. to whom the Club offer grateful thanks. The Club have agreed to make good any damage and to respect the wishes of those bodies in every way. Any infringement could result in permission to hold future Trials being withdrawn. Spectators are therefore requested **NOT to take their vehicles off the hard roads** and are further reminded **that it is an offence to take vehicles on to Forest land or tracks and offenders render themselves liable to prosecution.** All sections can easily be visited on foot.
