Phil Heath recalls ...

The first road race meeting at Mallory Park was held on May 13th 1956, although a preliminary tryout had been held two weeks previously when about 60 riders enjoyed some informal events. The official opening had been on the previous Wednesday when Maurice Cann on his Guzzi and Leicester car racer Bob Gerard in a Cooper-Bristol did the honours.

Previous to this it was a grass track around what is now the test circuit cutting out the Lake Esses, the Hairpin and the Devil's Elbow. Both the grass and the road races were organised by the Leicester Query M.C.

I first went to Mallory to watch a meeting when it was still a grass track and a feature of this meeting was the appearance of two Australian sidecar outfits with permanently banked-in sidecar wheels and powered by two speedway JAP engines — that is two engines each! At the time I was convalescing after a high speed accident when I broke a leg and a few ribs at Chimay when I was a full-time member of the Continental Circus.

As I retired from "serious" racing in 1955 I never rode at Mallory as a "proper" road racer only a year or so later as a competitor in Vintage racing.

The inaugural meeting was attended by an estimated 20,000 crowd and the Leicester Query Club had to handle 248 riders competing in 29 short events which took nearly 7 ½ hours to complete. Even so it is interesting to note that they also allowed a 2 lap canter of mainly vintage machines to take place before the main events and this was organised by Titch Allen who rode his ex-Baragwanath supercharged Brough outfit.

Most of my Mallory memories are therefore of competing in vintage races and the odd Practice Day when amongst the interesting machinery I tried was a 500 cc Norton engined Formula 3 car and Owen Greenwood's famous Mini powered three-wheeler. Another happy memory was when Titch persuaded the late Howard Davies to "come back" to motorcycling when he had been out of touch for so many years and ride my 1926 HRD — A replica of the machine on which he won the Senior TT in 1925 — and once he started riding round the circuit we had a job to get him off!

The HRD is one of my favourite vintage machines and I rode it in several Standard Vintage class events and nearly always managed to finish 2nd or 3rd. The nearest I ever came to winning on it was events and nearly always managed to finish 2nd or 3rd. The nearest I ever came to winning o

at Mallory, when after a hard scrap with "Steve" Stephenson on his Sprint Sunbeam, I got the lead on the last but one lap, and then at the end of the Stibbe Straight the motor suddenly slowed and I stopped, thinking the engine was about to seize. It turned out to be the plug only — 18 mm racing plugs are hard to come by and although the Champion type I was using — intended I believe for a motorboat engine — had coped before, it was too much for it this time.

I won't admit I have definitely retired from racing now, although most of my outings these days are confined to Demonstration Laps.

To everyone who is either racing or taking part in the Parades, I wish them a very happy and successful day.
