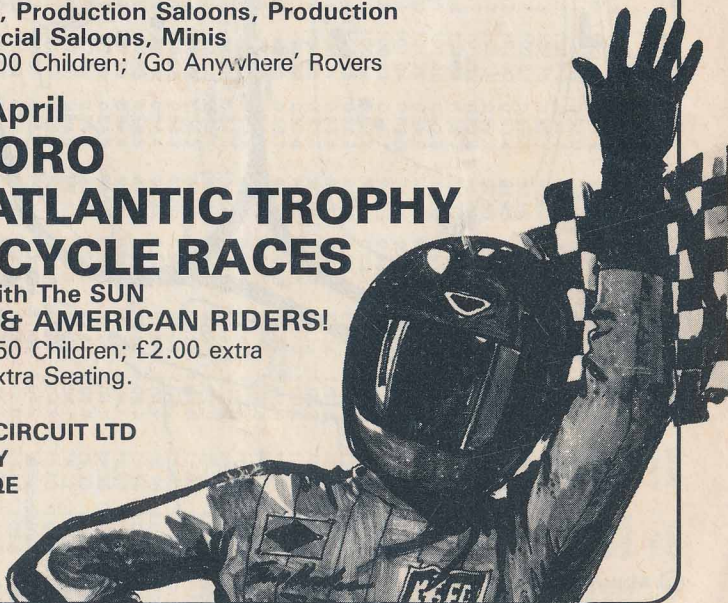

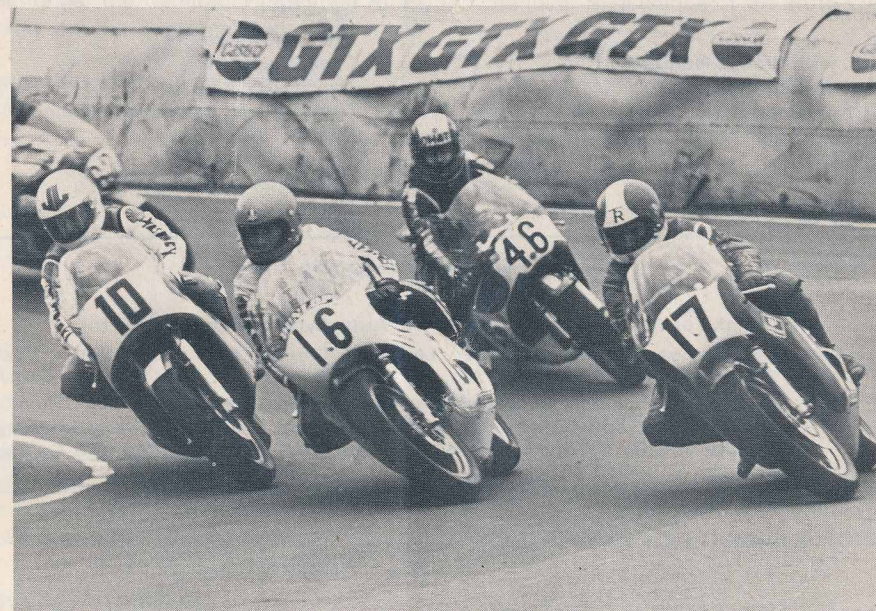

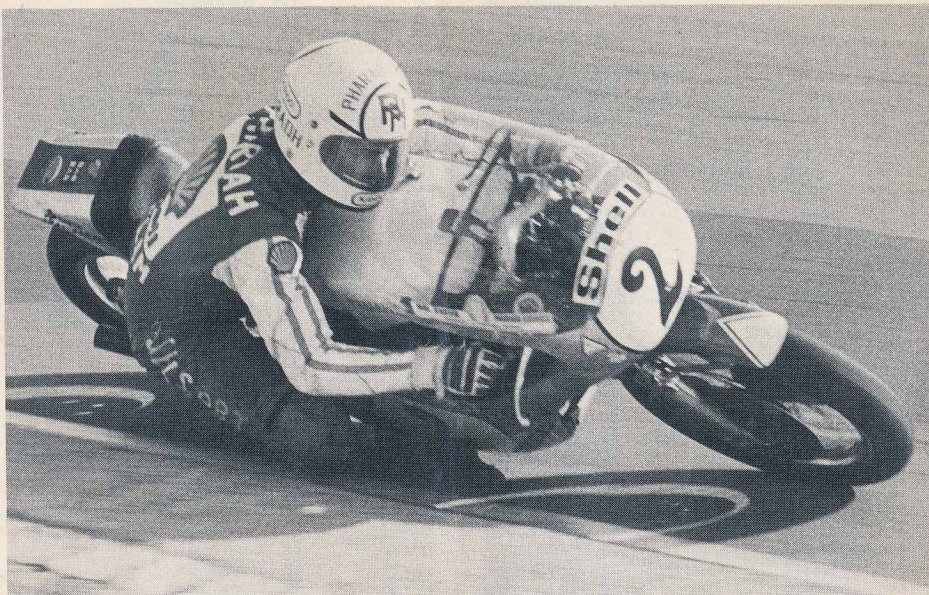

## WE'RE OFF!

Welcome back everyone! Mallory's opening motorcycle meeting really has the ingredients for a superb afternoon's sport. Several leading riders are set to compete and the East Midlands Centre of the ACU have laid on no fewer than 12 races.

The Marlboro Transatlantic Match Race qualifiers, the opening rounds of the British Championship and ACU Star series make up the afternoon's entertainment and overall prize money of £4,000 plus is awaiting today's lucky competitors.

During the close season, circuit staff have certainly not been idle at Mallory Park and there are a number of additional safety improvements which by now you will have noticed. Let us hope then that our February weather has not made us too complacent, but what a treat it would be to have fine weather to accompany fine racing on this opening weekend of the new season.

All being well, Brands Hatch got under way yesterday with the first rounds of their new Clubman's series, generously sponsored by NGK Sparking Plugs, Owen Helmets and Shell.

For the first time the ACU have extended their Star Series to include classes for 350's, 500's and three-wheelers with the junior class setting the ball rolling today.

That old stager Tony Rutter, now sponsored by Sid Griffiths, tops the list and surely must be one of the front runners. Going on 1979 form his main challengers may well be such riders as Phil Mellor (125 and 250 ACU Star holder), Alan Stewart, Glyn Marriott, Steve Wright and Eddie Roberts. However there are others quite capable of springing a surprise or two.

Talent abounds in the three-wheeler category, and the final could well be fought out between Marlboro Clubman winner Mike Crawford, Mal White, Andy Jackson, Stewart Pearson, Brian Webb, Dick Hawes, Terry Haslam, and Trevor Ireson. Look out too for the husband and wife team of Denis and Julia Bingham.

Without a doubt the two feature races of the day are the Marlboro Transatlantic qualifiers. Up to five riders will be short listed for the squad. The entry is headed by 1979 TT Formula 1 Champion and 1979 runner-up Superbike Champion 'rocket' Ron Haslam from Langley Mill. Ron, entered as usual by big Mal Carter, will be taking this opportunity of getting the feel of his 1980 machinery. He must start favourite but the final qualifiers will be anyone's guess.

Yamaha mounted John Newbold, 1979 British solo champion Keith Huewen and 1979 Joint 1000 cc Clubmans Champion David Vale will certainly be mixing it with the Kawasakis of Barry Ditchburn and that old reliable Asa Moyce. Likely 'outsiders' with a definite chance are Chris Guy, Phil Henderson, Steve Henshaw and Graham Wood. A double here and the winning rider goes home richer by some £700!

Phil Mellor is set to defend his 125 and 250 Star titles and he will encounter some spirited opposition in each of these races particularly in the 250s where Tony Rutter, Steve Henshaw, Alan Stewart, Bill Marks and Steve Wright are entered.

Pace setters in the first round of the ACU 500 cc Star championship should be Keith Huewen, Steve Manship, Phil Henderson, Bob Smith and Steve Henshaw and you can expect to see these riders joined in the final of the British Championship round by Chris Guy, Alan Stewart, Kevin Wretton and Eddie Roberts. As the afternoon's racing progresses there could be a double in prospect for many of this talented bunch.

So take it easy on the way home, for there are some more fine events listed between now and October, not only here but at other MCD Circuits.

Finally, remember that a Season Ticket can still save you a lot of money even if you have missed out on this first meeting — and this facility is available from the circuit office today.

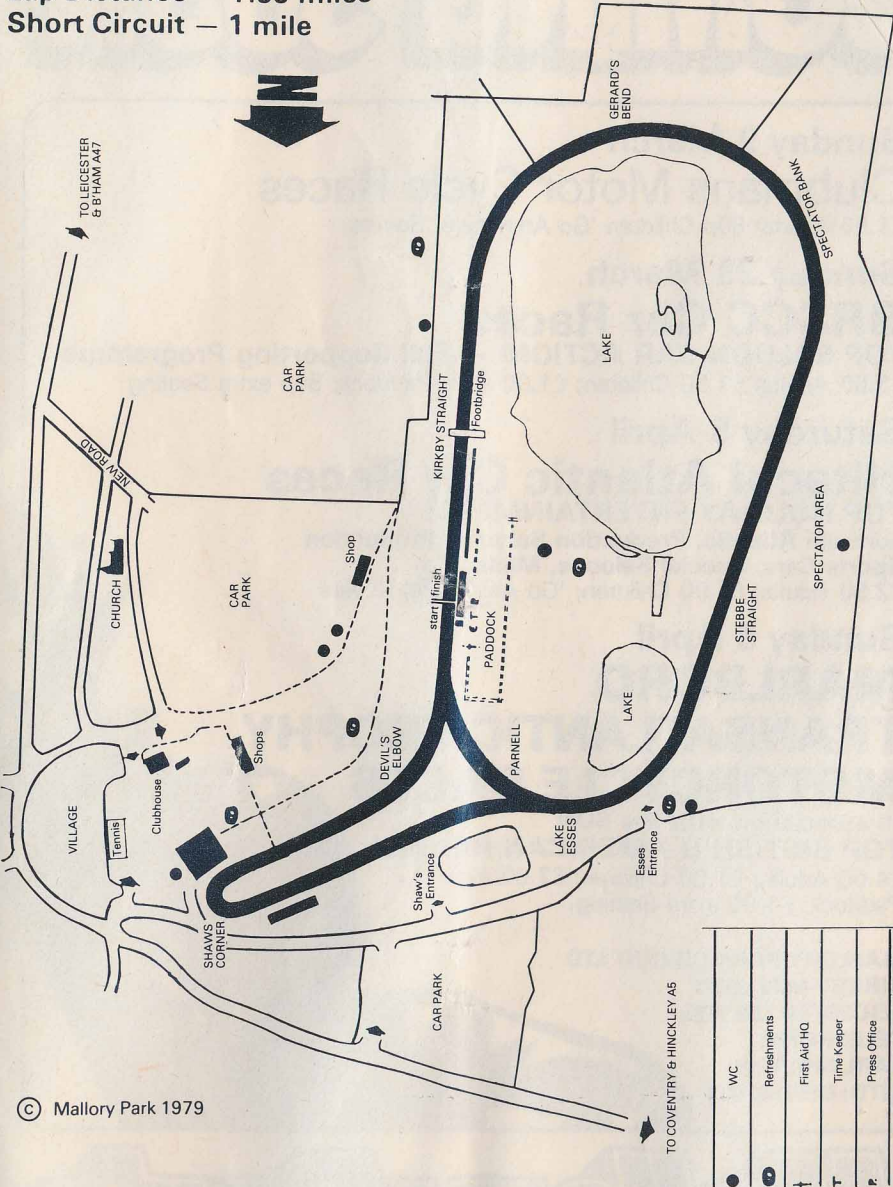
