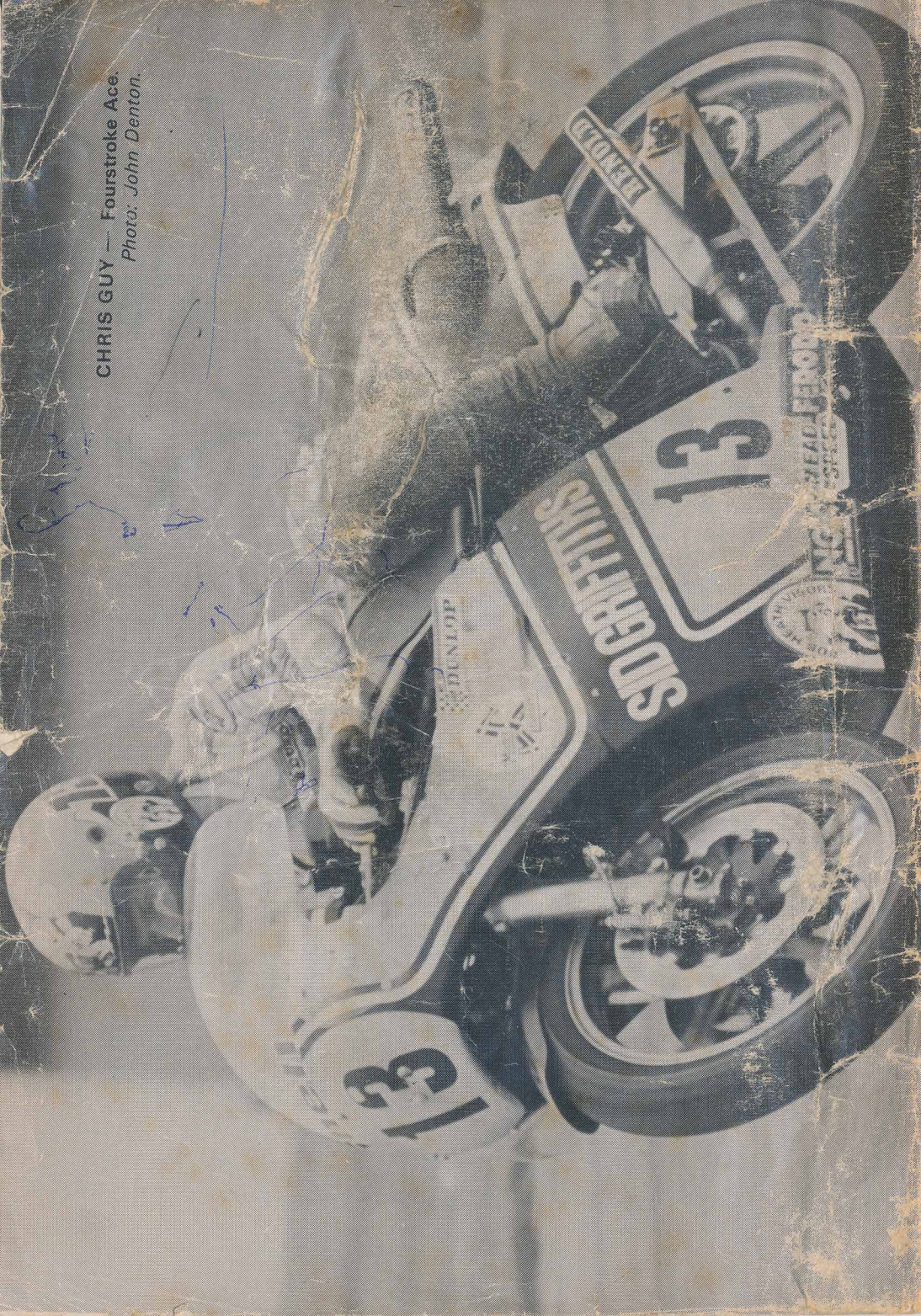

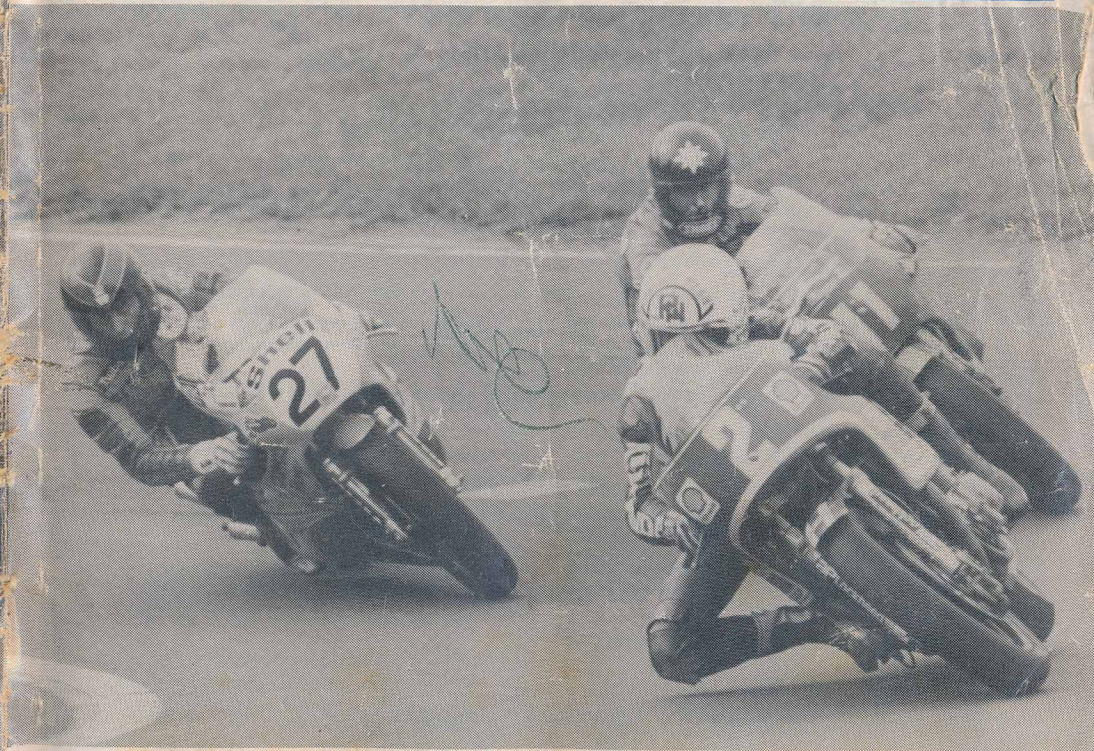

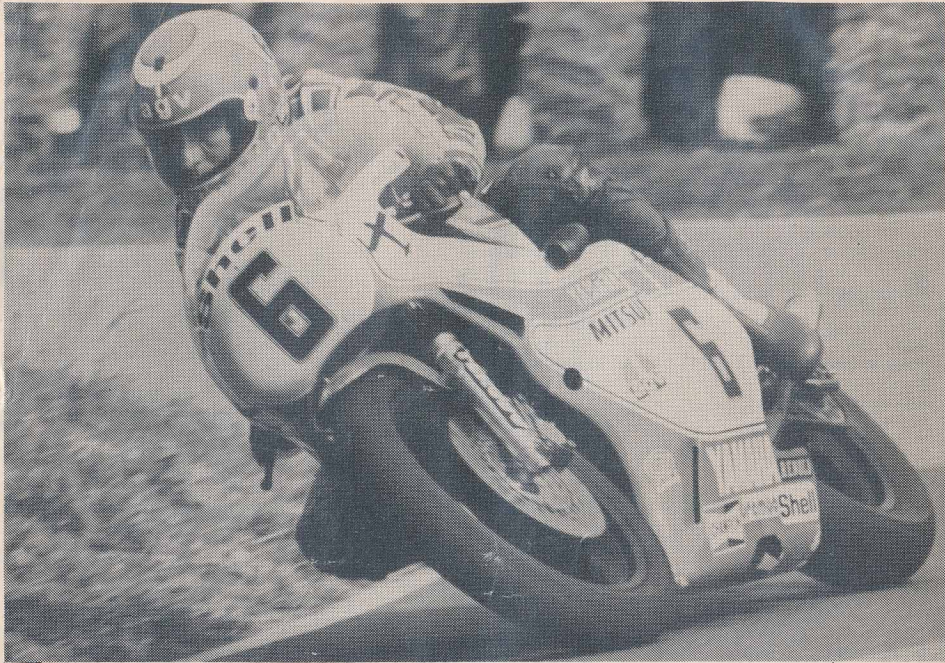

## Masters of Mallory

Welcome to Mallory Park's first National Motor Cycle meeting of the new season, and what a lot there is to look forward to in '82 for two wheel fans — especially the Second Leg of the annual MARLBORO TRANSATLANTIC TROPHY on Sunday April 11 — Wave those flags! I hope you've all got your 1982 MCD Programmes by now because they carry details of all the activities at Brands Hatch, Mallory, Oulton and Snetterton.

This afternoon's racing is organised by the East Midland Centre of the ACU and looks jam-packed with excitement — a big £2,000 open race with three heats to decide the eventual line-up for the Final, plus the first rounds of no fewer than five Championships including the new 80cc Star series.

Today's big race has attracted a Honda spearhead with local ace 'ROCKET' RON HASLAM — Britain's Superbike and Streetbike Champion, Ireland's crack JOEY DUNLOP — though more well known on the long circuits Joey has proved he is a force to be reckoned with around the short tracks too and Honda's new signing for '82 the spectacular and popular Aussie WAYNE GARDNER.

Happily Rocket Ron is in the British Team for the Match Races and other Transatlantic Teamsters set to 'shakedown' their machines prior to testing the Americans at Easter. In today's line-up are GRAHAM WOOD, STEVE HENSHAW and CHRIS GUY on their 750 Yamahas plus British Champion BOB SMITH with his rapid 500cc Suzuki.

Determined Yorkshireman MICK GRANT, happily with a good Suzuki deal for 1982 is also booked for his first appearance of the year, and ..... this race looks a real cracker with a £2,000 spread all the way down to 10th place and a strong flavour all through the entry — fast rising stars like GARY LINGHAM, KEVIN WRETTOM (Kawasakis), ANDY BOND and DAVE GRIFFITHS (a winner on the opening day here last year) plus SIMON BUCKMASTER — who was really flying on his recently acquired ex-Barry Ditchburn 750 Yamaha at the Brands Hatch test day a couple of weeks ago.

Another local hotshoe DAVID EAST — brilliant winner of the Manx Senior Grand Prix last year is set to re-appear, plus TOM DRURY, "legs and co." STEVE PARRISH — it'll certainly be good to see Steve back, and PHIL HENDERSON.

There are a number of 'dark horses' in the field so keep a watchful eye on the progress of MARK SALLE and '81 Marlboro 500 Clubmans Champion PHIL USHER while plenty of interest will also centre on the form of Big Mal's boy ALAN CARTER due on a Pharaoh Yamaha. 17 year old Alan is determined to gain an International licence this year and on his '81 form looks sure to acquit himself well, despite the formidable opponents he'll meet today.

Three heats will decide the line-up for the 12 lap Final last on today's packed programme — be sure of a good position!

But first on the programme is the opening round of the new 80cc British Star Series and I must confess to know little of the smallest class of racing other than that Kreidler finished second in the World 50cc Championships and there are a handful of that model — though unlikely to be to full GP spec — in today's field. With the demise of the popular Honda 125 series let's hope that this class will produce racing of a similar outstanding quality. With any new 'formula' it always takes a little time before it all takes shape, but it is pleasing to note Nolan (Helmets) have not been slow in supporting the races.

The 250 Production Star features yet another local ace, TREVOR CLOW who won the Newmarket Motor Cycle Club's Production 250 Championship last season and also found time to battle his way to 9th in the hotly contested Marlboro Production 250 Championship. Suffolk based Production bike specialist GREGG PAGE could provide the main opposition.

The first round of the 500 Production Star is so well subscribed that two heats are necessary to thin the hopefuls down and likely leading contenders include MARK ORDIDGE — runner-up in the Marlboro Production 500s last year and KENNY IRONS who was 3rd in the same series but the experience of Coventry's MARTIN

TAYLOR — who won the Mallory 'Silver Jubilee' here a year ago — might tell.

Sidecars too are split into two heats and in Heat One ACU British Sidecar Champion (and runner-up to Jock Taylor in the MCW Sidecar Championship) DEREK BAYLEY/BOB BRYSON appear as likely front runners. Sadly the speedy Folkestone-duo had lost their sponsorship as this programme was being printed so let's hope that their fine efforts of '81 did not go unnoticed and they are quick to find some all-important backing; I suspect that by now their GROVEWOOD AWARD cash has been used! Facing the might of Bayley and Bryson are former Clubmans Sidecar Champion KEITH COUSINS/STEVE CHINA plus Doncaster flyers FRANK WRATHALL/PHIL SPENDLOVE.

Sidecar Heat 2 features Marlboro Clubmans Champions BARRY BRINDLEY/CHRIS JONES and amongst their opposition are the ever-popular husband and wife team DENNIS/JULIA BINGHAM, and GARY GOLDER who will be hoping that his 750 Yamaha has benefited from Barry Ditchburn having 'breathed upon it' in recent weeks. Other Sidecar aces include MICK BARTON, GORDON NOTTINGHAM, TERRY HASLAM and CHAS GREATREX, so there's no doubt that the Sidecars will also provide plenty of good racing.

Lincoln's NEIL STOREY scored 3 wins, 2 seconds and 2 thirds from seven scores on his way to runner-up spot in last year's Marlboro Production 1300 Championship. The series was won by Paul Iddon who has since been snapped up by Suzuki which shows the class of riders competing in the Production Classes. Storey faces that man Gregg Page again, while others with a chance include ANDY KEY (3rd in Marlboro Production 1300 last year), KEITH SANDERSON, DAVID RAILTON and ERIC McFARLANE.

Then we've got the 3 x 6 lap Heats for the Open, the Production 500 Final, Sidecar Final and before you get your breath back the 'Open' Final. I hope I've pinpointed a few winners — most likely you've got your own ideas, but I do hope you enjoy it and — see you again soon?

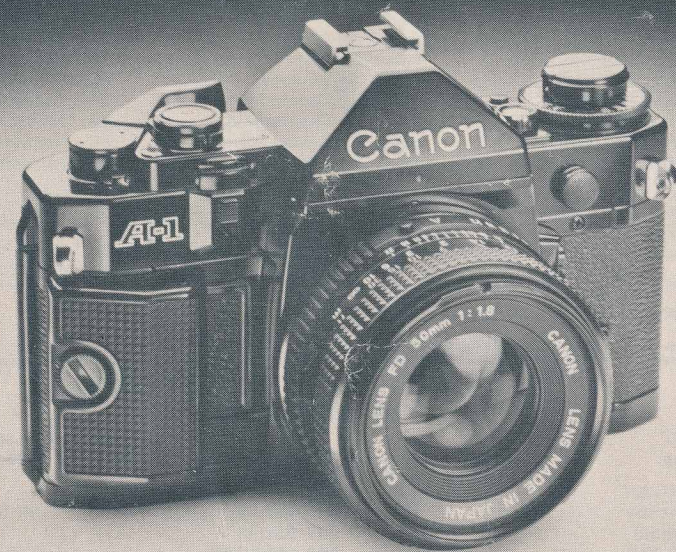

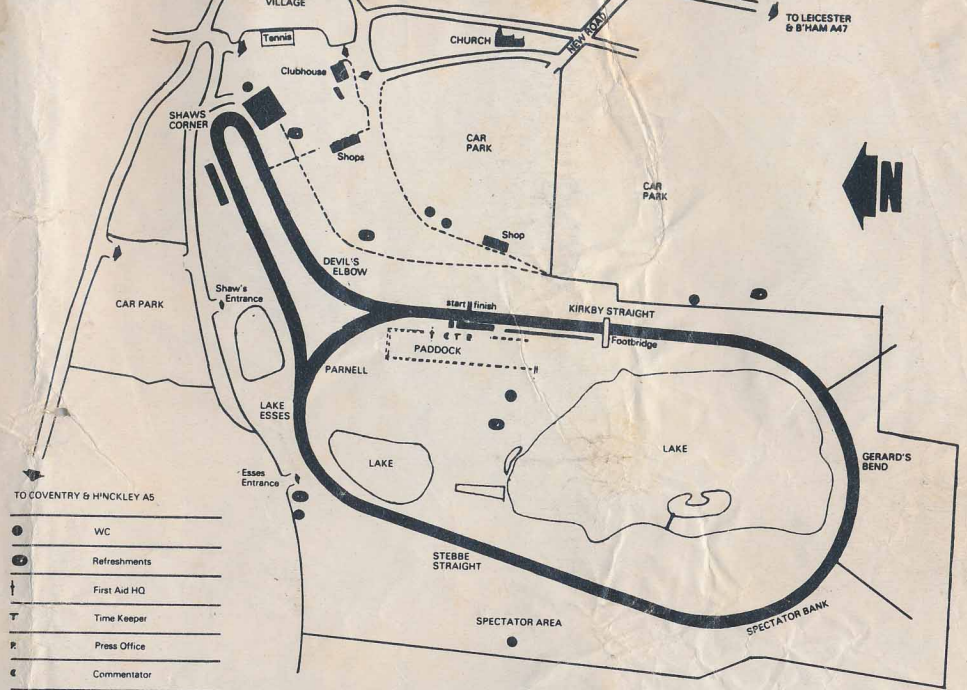
