


Enjoy the racing and come back again.

The Access Road is narrow with passing places and traffic is controlled. No pedestrian access is permitted.



The Manx Grand Prix Festival is one of the greatest spectator sports in the world. Nowhere do you get as close to the action as you would sitting on a hedge on the Isle of Man surrounded by breathtaking scenery as the country's leading road racers pass you.

However, MGP race spectators have a responsibility to themselves, the marshals and the riders to watch the races in a responsible manner. Motorsport is dangerous and while the organisers recognise that you want to get as close to the action

as possible you must follow the rules, listen to the marshals and keep your wits about you at all times. The bikes can reach speeds of up to 180mph and at no point can you go onto the track itself until the roads open car has passed the point on the circuit where you are.

Every year the course is reviewed and spectator viewing areas are altered according to the changing nature of motorsport. Changes in machinery can mean that what has previously been safe may no longer be the case. As a result areas that you may have previously watched from may now be prohibited or restricted. You must respect the marshal's advice and look for an alternative viewing area. With a track stretching to 37³/4 miles you are not short of alternatives!

Any unruly spectators will be dealt with by the police and in order to do so the practice or race may have to be stopped. The safety of the public, marshals and riders will not be compromised.

Enjoy the event and we look forward to welcoming you back on the Island for many years to come.





Important Information for MGP Visitors

The uniqueness of this road racing event creates safety issues that you might not automatically think about. Here are a few road safety tips that will help you to enjoy MGP 2011 to the maximum advantage

- The MGP course is entirely comprised of public roads, and these roads are closed when the races are in action. However it is important to remember that when the roads are open both residents and visitors use these very same sections of the course for their day to day activities. With this in mind, you should be prepared for regular traffic on the MGP course when the roads are open including queues at roundabouts and junctions
- You might be tempted to 'open up' your machine on long stretches of road, but for the safety of other road users please drive well within your capabilities and be mindful of your surroundings – expect the unexpected
- On right hand bends make sure that both you and your machine are behind the white line – not just your tyres
- The MGP festival attracts visitors from far and wide, many of whom may not be used to riding on the left hand side of the road. With this in mind, please take extra care when approaching areas where their journey might start for example campsites

- You need to be aware that temporary speed limits will be introduced around the Island to help our roads cope with the increased volume of traffic, but primarily improve safety for all road users
- Any driving ban imposed by an Isle of Man Court is applicable in the UK as there is now a reciprocal ban agreement in place – so a moment of madness could cost you dear in the long run
- In addition to the MGP races, you will probably want to go out and enjoy the many attractions on offer all over the Island. Naturally you may fancy the odd beer or two, but if you are going to enjoy the local brew then please leave your bike where you are staying. Alternatively stick to a soft drink as:
