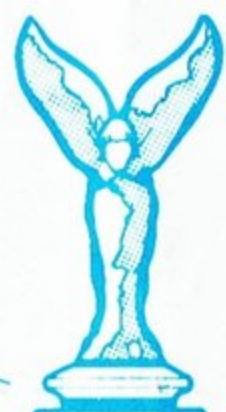

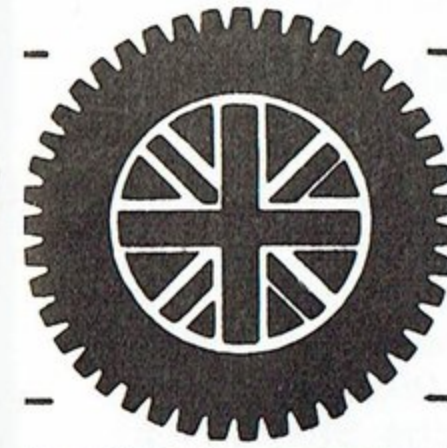

1984 AMCA COMPETITION LICENCES

Over 5,500 Licences have been issued this year including 68 Trials Only Licences not included in the figures below and about a dozen Enduro Only Licences. About 350 riders have cancelled their Licence and the highest number is 63 in the South East followed by the North West with 44. The figures below compile on the 15th August and licence applications are still arriving daily.

AMCA CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT FOR 85

Doug Briscoe put the following suggestions to the Executive Committee regarding the 85 AMCA Moto Cross Championships. The 250cc and 750cc qualifying events to be held this year the top 8 per group go forward which would not include the present Championship riders. 125's would need the top 10 from the groups who have more than 10 not including present championship riders. A suggestion that the top 8 sidecars from 1984 plus top 6 from the North and South qualifiers making a total of 20 outfits for the 85 Championships. The 4 Stroke for 85 should have two regional championships with 4 rounds each and then possibly 2 final rounds with the top riders from each or just regional rounds.

CHAMPIONSHIP RIDERS FAILING TO COMPETE

Riders who have qualified for Championships and fail to turn up for the event may find themselves liable for disciplinary action unless they notify the AMCA Office in advance giving the reasons why they are unable to ride.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING

A seven hour meeting of the AMCA's Executive Committee held at the AMCA Office was attended by the AMCA's President - Frank Green who signed the papers which formally transferred the Assets and Liabilities of the AMCA to AMCA Ltd.

13 of the 15 Group Co-Ordinators attended plus the AMCA Officials Carol Davis, John Davoll, Don Green and Doug Briscoe and amongst the items discussed was the problem of the late entries when Freedom of Choice was taking place. The rules are (a) if, when Freedom of Choice operates and all riders can go to the event of their choice, late entries will only be allowed within a riders home group. Late Entries will not be allowed out of group. (b) If a rider has no choice of event (i.e. if his whole club or group has been sent to a specific event) then the rider may be allowed on late entry in the group his club or group are riding in. Preference will be given to home group riders first.

Note:- Important - Late Entries are not automatic at any event, it is up to the organising clubs discretion whether to accept any or not.

A full minutes of the meeting will be going to each club shortly.
