POINTS OF VANTAGE

and directions for finding them from Forder Lane where it meets the Course.

START. Turn Right and follow Course backwards.

FORDER STEEP. Turn left and follow Course to this steep descent which will provide plenty of excitement. Stream at foot.

THE LAMBSDOWN STRAIGHT. Mainly level open moor—fast section. Plenty of passing on the approaching ascent from the dried bog. Can be reached by striking straight up the hill from the Hunting Gate at the foot of "Steep".

LAMBSDOWN HILL. Straight on in Forder Lane—ignore the Course. Left after copse, follow marking backwards. You will come to Copse Hill and Waterworks. Short hillock, stream now dry.

WATERWORKS HILL. Very short steep hillock followed by descent to dried stream bed and shortly by Copse Hill. For instruction see Lambsdown Hill.

COPSE HILL. Steep with watersplash at foot. Follow instructions for Lambsdown Hill. This point is near Forder Lane.

BRENT DRIVE and HAYFORD CORNER. The splash here is shallow. Turn Right and follow Course backwards for a quarter of a mile beyond the Start.

THE SNACK VAN will be parked in "Foxes Gorse" near the approach to Forder Steep.

TEAS at 1/6d. per head, and Snacks, will be available after the Meeting at **The Lion's Den, Golden Lion Hotel, Ashburton**, where members and friends are invited to spend the evening.
