VANTAGE POINTS

and directions for finding them from Forder Lane where it meets the Course.

START. Turn Right and follow Course backwards, this part of the Course is used for 1st. Lap only.

FORDER STEEP. Turn left and follow Course to this steep descent which will provide plenty of excitement. Stream at foot.

WATERWORKS HILL. Very short steep hillock followed by descent to dried stream bed and shortly by Copse Hill. Straight on in Forder Lane—ignore the Course. Left after Copse, follow marking backwards. You will come to Copse Hill and Waterworks.

COPSE HILL. Short hillock stream at foot now dry. Follow instructions for Waterworks Hill. This point is near Forder Lane.

THE SNACK VAN will be parked near the approach to Forder Steep.

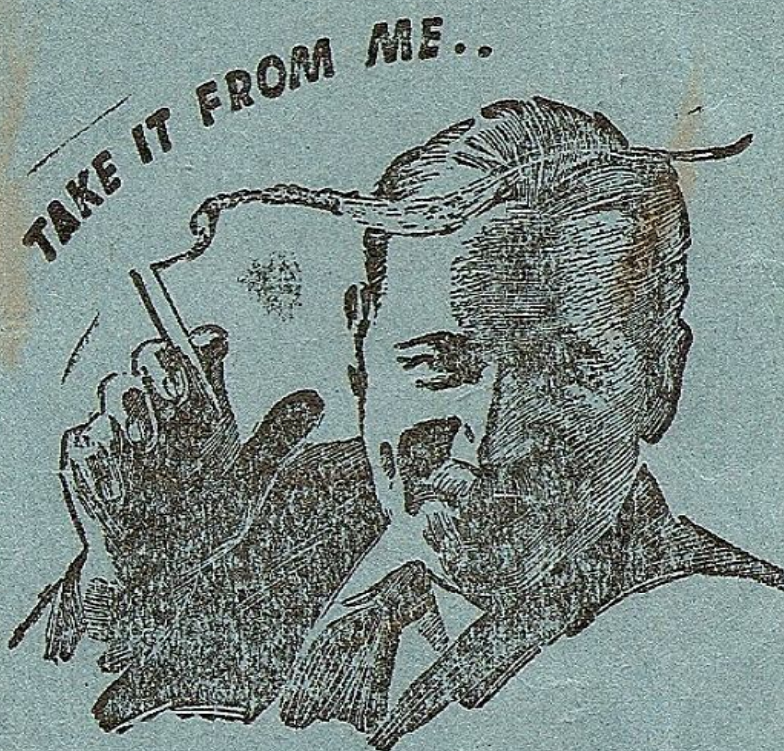
