# THE EXETER TRIAL

At a M.C.C. Committee Meeting on September 26th, 1910, an enterprising member suddenly said: "Mr. Chairman, why not a long distance Winter Club Run?" "Why not?" echoed several others and forthwith the idea was voted worth favourable consideration. A post-card to all members elicited the fact that a good number were prepared to "do or die," so arrangements went forward. After toying with the idea of a winter London to Edinburgh, the call of the West gained the day, and a Winter Club Run from London to Exeter and back was duly announced for December 26th and 27th, 1910.

Unlike the Edinburgh and Land's End Trials, the Exeter started off as a free for all—motorcycles, cyclecars and cars of any horse power, and 79 entered for the first event.

Starting from the Bell Hotel, Hounslow, the route went via Salisbury, Yeovil, Honiton, Exeter and back in the reverse direction, a total of 322 miles, to be covered in 24 hours for a "gold."

In 1912 the return journey was stiffened up via Lyme Regis, Dorchester and Blandford—"a very severe route" stated a motor journal. It was further stiffened up in 1913 by making Chard and Trow Hills non-stop. The run had by this time become firmly established—231 entries, of which 65 were cars.

No Exeter in 1914—and on resuming in 1919 the same course attracted a similar entry.

Coming so soon after the Motor Show, the Exeter always seemed a popular way of bringing new models to the public notice and many and varied were the vehicles which figured in the entry list.

Entries continued to increase in both car and motorcycle classes and in 1925 totalled 427, with 152 cars, 25% of whom collected "golds." In 1927 came an occurrence unique in M.C.C. history. The Trial had to be postponed for a fortnight on account of a heavy snowfall which covered the entire route—in many places several feet deep, very few of the entrants being able to even reach the Slough Trading Estate, which was the starting point that year.

1929 saw a new set of hills, Devenish Pit (on the outward journey), Higher Rill, Meerhay, Ibberton and Batcombe Ridge (special re-start test). The last-named created havoc in the awards list, only 23 out of 185 cars coming through with a clean sheet.

Fingle Bridge was included for the first time in 1932 and 68 out of 223 had to give it best.

Simms Hill stiffened up the 1933 route, its first appearance in any big trial, and the tractor installed at the top had a busy time assisting no less than 191 out of the 273 car entries, whose wheels ceased to rotate in the forward direction, whilst Fingle Bridge proved too much for 86.

The increased severity of the routes had a stimulating effect on the car entry, and in 1934 a record entry of cars out of a total of 364 took up the challenge. Old man Simms was still in fighting form, however, and 212 cars made the acquaintance of the tractor's wire hauling rope, whilst the total of 1st Class awards fell to 13.

Feeling that the hill had more than earned its keep, in 1935 the Committee offered a special Simms Hill award for successful ascents. The contractors who annually carried out road repairs at the Club's expense must also have had a soft spot for competitors. Although 98 were marked "failed," 102 collected the special Simms Hill award—a nasty jar to the Treasury! A Veteran Class was included for those who had competed in the first "Exeter" (in 1910) 25 years previously, and Geo. Brough, H. F. S. Morgan, L. A. Baddeley, B. Alan Hill, W. Cooper, Sam Wright, N. C. Dear, Rex Mundy and George Griffiths turned out. All had ridden motorcycles in the 1910 event except H. F. S. on his 3-wheeler Morgan; this year only Geo. Brough and H. F. S. Morgan were faithful to their old loves, the remainder preferring something with a wheel at each corner.

In the 1936 event (held January 1st and 2nd, 1937) the three starting points arrangement came into force: Stratford-on-Avon, Virginia Water and Penzance.

The transfer of the finish (January 7th and 8th, 1938) to the Grand Hotel, Bournemouth, was a very popular move. The hotel was booked solid by M.C.C. members, who enjoyed a thoroughly good week-end.

The last pre-war "Exeter," January 6th and 7th, 1939, was notable for an influx of Army motorcyclists (on War Office recommendation for its excellent training value) and for the first time for many years, motorcycle entries exceeded car entries with 208 to 151. Simms Hill was made optional for a P.A., with a Special Award for successful climbs, and 66 collected the latter.

Owing to petrol restrictions it was not possible to organise the first post-war "Exeter" until January 1st, 1949, when a modified route of some 60 miles west of Exeter was used. Windout, Simms, Fingle Bridge and three new sections—Stonelands, Knowle and Green Lanes—were included. The entry totalled 90.

A similar route and arrangement was adopted for the 1949 Trial on December 31st, 1949, the entry being 96.

1950 saw the pre-war long distance "Exeter" revived after a lapse of 12 years and the entry of 256 in that year, 263 in 1951 and 325 this year is a good indication of the great interest taken in these long distance events.

A reversion to pre-war practice is the inclusion of a hill on the outward journey before competitors arrive at the breakfast stop at Exeter.

To our many new members (several of whom had their first experience of competitive motoring in the recent National Rally) we extend a hearty welcome and a similar greeting goes out to those members of long standing—many of whom competed pre-war.





