List of Hills and approximate time of arrival of first competitor

Start: 9.30 a.m. **Finish:** 2.35 p.m. The Union Inn, Denbury Green. 3½ mls. from Newton Abbot. Take Totnes Road A.381, Right at Two Mile Oak.

Eastern Circuit.

Bluewaters: 10.32 a.m. (Steep, tricky bends). From Newton Abbot take A.382 towards Bovey Tracey. Left at Pottery. Left at X.

Dunbar: 10.10 a.m. (several short, tricky climbs) A.38 to Bickington then take road opposite The Toby Jug Inn. Left to hill.

Steeper: 10.44 a.m. (steep, good sidecar hill). A.382 and A.38 to Liverton. Park by bridge on Ilsington road; take track by Woodgate Cottages.

Camp: 11.06 a.m. (grassy lane). ½ mile from Denbury on Woodland road.

Meadow Splash and Clennons: 11.14 a.m. (watersplash and steep, rocky paths). Denbury-Broadhempston road; Left at first X; bear Left at fork.

Orley (Solos only) 11.22 a.m. (rocks). Near Torbryan off Ipplepen-Broadhempston road.

Hollacombe. 11.28 a.m. (mud and grass). as for Orley, then follow dye; or from Red Post Garage on A.381 take Broadhempston road.

Gatcombe (solos only) 11.40 a.m. (rocks). From Red Post Garage (A.381). Left at Shadrack X

Central Control (all day). Follow signs to Landscope from Broadhempston or from Totnes, take A.384, right to Staverton and follow signs to Landscope.

Western Circuit (Solos Only).

Deancombe: 10.10 a.m. (rocks). Buckfastleigh-Plymouth road (A.38) for 1 mile. Follow dye Right to foot of hill

Watery Lane: 10.36 a.m. (rocks). From South Brent on A.38, go through Aish, left to Higher Badworthy Farm.

Ewing's Delight: 10.58 a.m. (mud). From Totnes take B. 3372 Right towards Rattery. Right thro' gateway.

Millbrook and Venton Mill: 11 a.m. (mud). B.3372. After Tigley, Right to Venton Farm. Caution—Competitors.

Harpers' Hill. 11.20 a.m. off Totnes By-pass. (rocks). Right off A.381 going towards Kingsbridge.

Clapper: 11.38 a.m. (shale and mud). Follow dye from B.3372.
