



TODAY'S

CHAMPIONSHIP SCRAMBLE

WITH today's National Inter-Centre Scramble Championship, the 1958 season draws to a successful close. It has been a significant year. There is not the slightest doubt that the sport is becoming increasingly popular. Record crowds have been attracted to all the big national and international events.

In the ideal setting of Muswell Hill Farm, today's meeting should prove

equally attractive.

The first Inter-Centre Scramble, in its present form, was held in October, 1954, at Hawkstone Park and sponsored by the Daily Herald. It was a great success, and has now become an annual meeting held in high

regard by fans and riders alike.

For the purposes of administration by the General Council of the Auto-Cycle Union, England and Wales have been divided into 20 "Centres," each of which incorporates several counties. The Inter-Centre Scramble is a competitive event between these Centres in which the pick of the country's riders take part. Therefore, one has giants of the sport like Jeff Smith, Johnny Draper, Dave Curtis and Derek Rickman representing different Centres.

The present holders of the championship title and Daily Herald trophy are South-Midland, whose riders last year were Dave Curtis, Andy Lee, Geoff Ward and Pat Lamper. They will be in the difficult position of defending their title this year against at least three other

Centres who could snatch victory from them.

This thrilling, fast sport of the "rough-track" is perhaps seen at the best where a combination of team-work and individual performance is the

basis of the racing as in the Inter-Centre Scramble.

This is, of course, only one of about 350 scrambles held in this country every year. They range from the big national and international meetings to smaller scrambles organised by some of the 800 motor-cycling clubs. During the Twenties that rough-riding steeplechase, the Scott Trial, may have been regarded as "the annual Yorkshire joke," and the first Southern Scott Trial, run in 1924 by the Camberley Club, was certainly taken lightheartedly, since no-one had then heard of a trial that was also a race. Yet these two events had a deeper significance than even their first organisers could guess. They produced the modern scramble.

Exciting as that may have seemed, the present mass start as 20 or 30 riders roar away and vanish into the "roughs" is equally compelling, and there is always that tremendous thrill, which every enthusiast feels, as the

riders complete their first lap and the race is really on.

Today's event should provide all the usual hard and skilful riding we have come to expect from our champions—many of whom have made great reputations for themselves on the Continent in recent years.

The Daily Herald, in sponsoring this event, follows its policy of giving encouragement and wide publicity to a first-class sport.

CORRECTION—Although chosen, Geoff Ward was unable to ride for the South Midland team. His place was taken by Joe Johnson.




