THE WESSEX SCRAMBLE

The Wessex Scramble was first held in 1929, and every year thereafter until 1938. After the war, the series was re-started in 1947 at Farleigh Castle, near Trowbridge; held in January under Arctic weather conditions, with half frozen mud, it was a truly frightful affair. The event was not run in 1948 due to petrol rationing, and in 1949 the Centre decided to entrust the organisation of the Scramble to the Tor Club, and the first of a run of very successful meetings was held at Glastonbury. In 1950 the "Wessex" went to a new course at Hinton Charterhouse, near Bath, but was poorly supported. Another attempt to put the event on as a National meeting at Hinton Charterhouse in 1951 failed completely, and the Scramble had to be cancelled owing to lack of entries.

Rather than see the name of the "Wessex Scramble" disappear completely, the Centre decided to ask the Tor Club to run it in 1952 as an Open-to-Centre event. This proved highly successful, and the club continued to organise the "Wessex" in 1953, 1954 and 1956. By this time other clubs in the Centre were finding suitable courses and in 1955 the Shepton Mallet Club ran the event at their course at Westbury-sub-Mendip, and in 1957 the Bristol M.C.C. put on a fine meeting at Henley Quarries, Yatton.

In 1958 the Wessex Scramble returned to the National calendar and to its favourite venue at Glastonbury. The meeting was an immense success and like the 1959 event it attracted a wonderful entry and crowds of 11,000 and 12,000 people respectively turned out to watch exciting racing. Let us hope that today's "Wessex" will be in the same tradition!

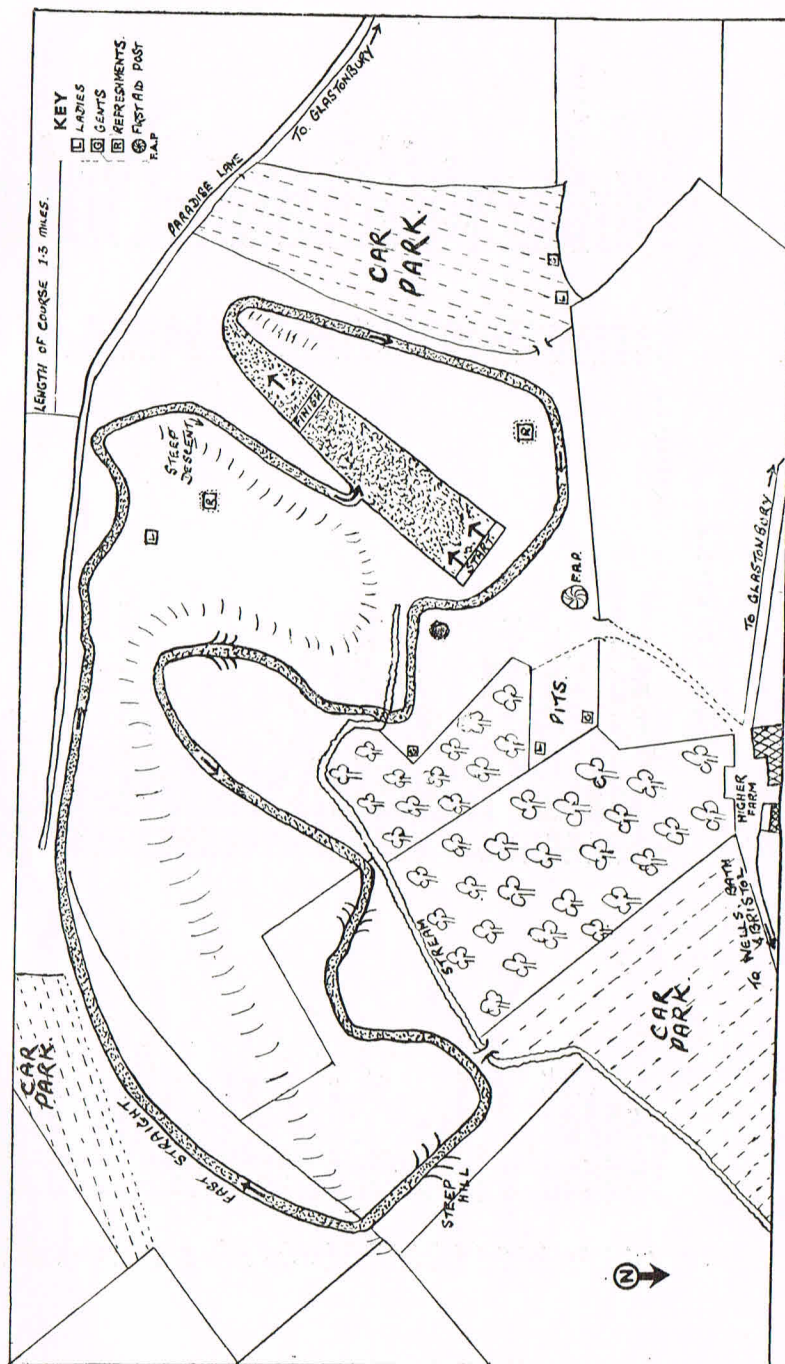

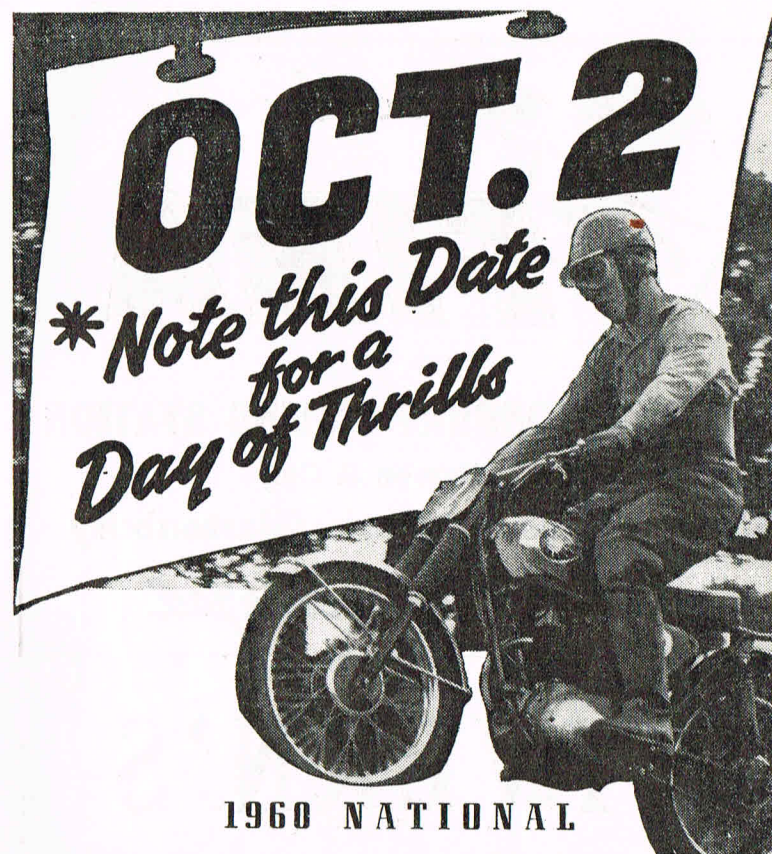

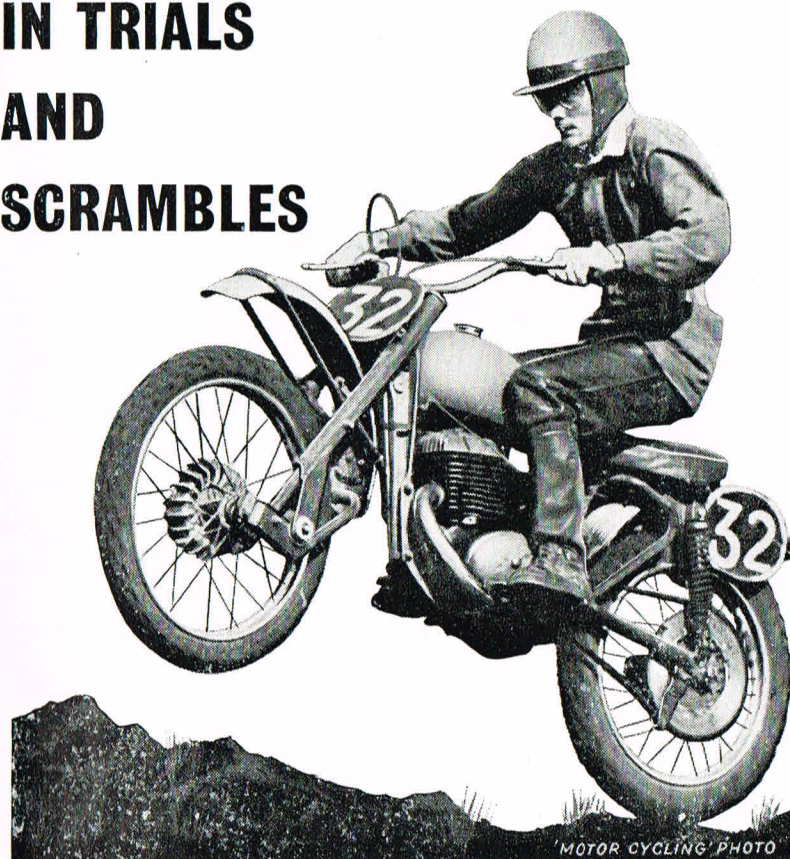
