# List of Hills and approximate time of arrival of first competitor

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**Start** (9-30 a.m.), (**Finish** (3 p.m.), and **Central Control**: all at The Union Inn, Denbury Green, 3½ miles from Newton Abbot. Take Totnes road A.381, right at Two Mile Oak Inn and Filling Station. (Note:—This is the last petrol station before the start). Even-numbered competitors take Eastern Circuit first, odd numbers Western Circuit. Side-cars use all hills (or parts of them) except those marked \*

## Eastern Circuit

- 9-35 a.m., **Wotton**. Water and mud. 2 miles N.W. from Denbury village.
- 9-55 a.m., **Hadrian's Wall**. An awkward climb. Inside intersection of A.38 and A.385 roads at Bickington.
- 10-20 a.m., \***The Creek**. Long stream bed. Beside Drumbridge—Liverton—Ilsington road before Ilsington village.
- 10-35 a.m., **Steeper**. A very steep track. Take track past cottages from Millhouse Farm, Liverton. Park by bridge at Millhouse.
- 10-45 a.m., **Dunbar**. Old quarry. A.38 to Bickington, then take road opposite The Toby Jug Inn, and then left.
- 11-20 a.m., \***Orley**. Very rocky. Near Torbryan off Ipplepen—Broadhempston road.
- 11-35 a.m., **Gatcombe**. Steep rock. From Red Post Garage on A.381, left at Shad-rack X.
- 11-50 a.m., **Meadow Splash and Clennons**. Watersplash and winding climb. Denbury—Broadhempston road, left at Wrenwell Cross, bear left to woods.

## Western Circuit

- 9-35 a.m., **Tripe's Copse**. Water and mud. 1 mile S.W. from Denbury Cowards, Broadhempston.
- 9-55 a.m., **Harper's Hill**. Narrow rocky path. Totnes By-Pass, A.381 towards Kings-bridge, first right after crossing A.381.
- 10-20 a.m., **Millbrook and \*Venton**. Long and muddy, with water. Totnes—Marley road B.3372, after Tigley right to Venton Farm. Park here and take track on right from farmyard.
- 10-50 a.m., \***Diamond Lane**. Very long rocky climb. South Brent on A.38, pass beside railway station, follow signposts for Shipley Bridge and Avon Dam.
- 11-20 a.m., \***Deancombe**. Rocks. Buckfastleigh—Plymouth road A.38 for 1 mile. Right at Dean, right again.
- 11-30 a.m., **Shortway**. Long and narrow rocky climb. As for Deancombe; right and then left to top of Deancombe (facing competitors coming down), continue for 1 mile and right into woods.



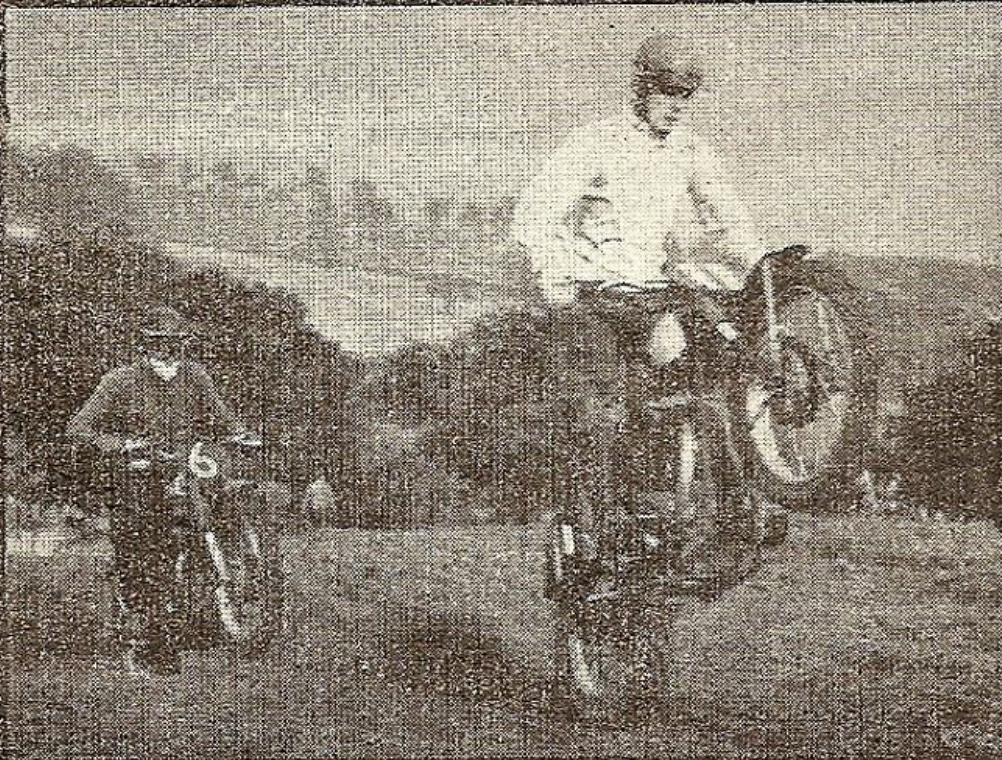

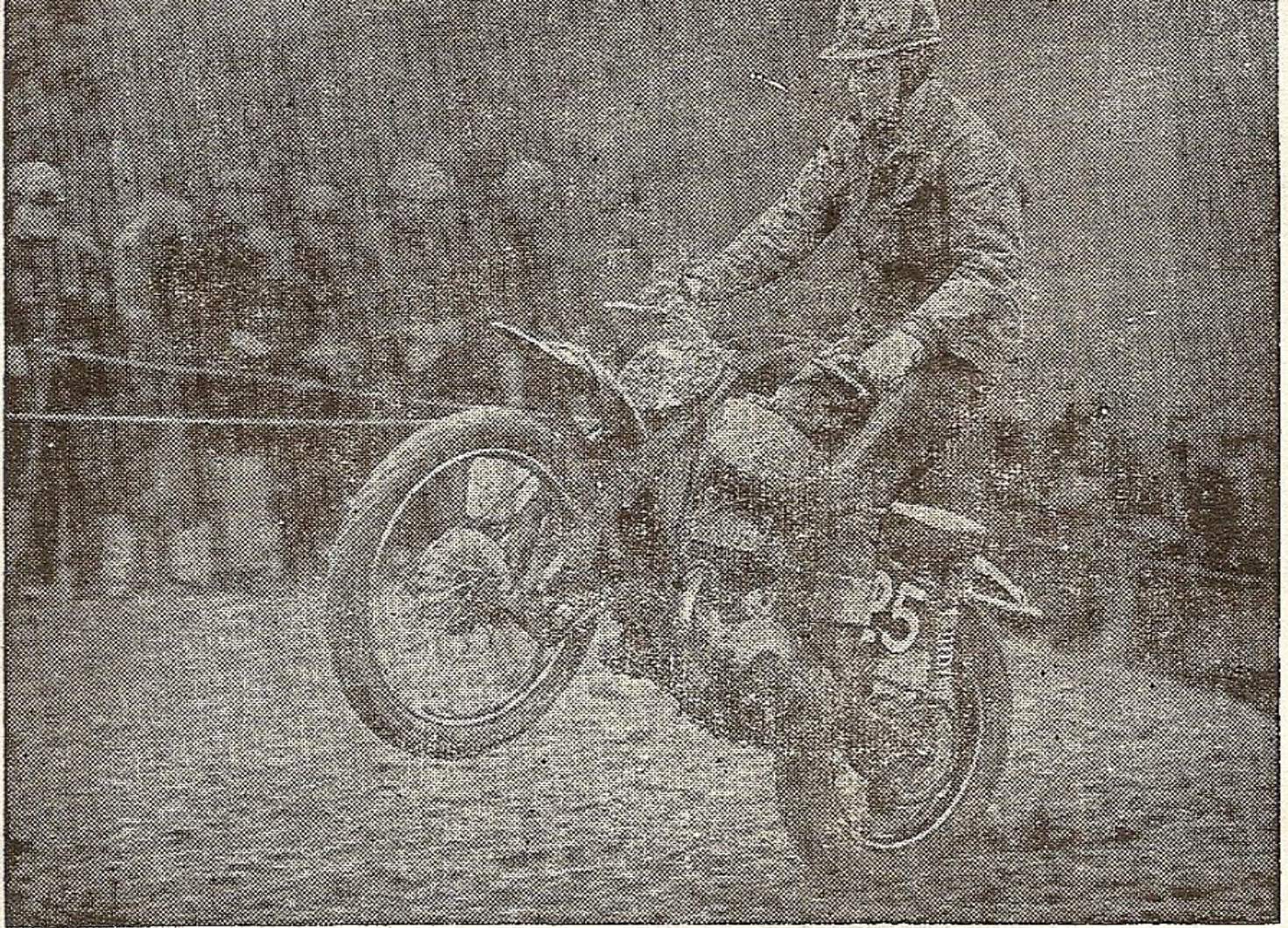
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
