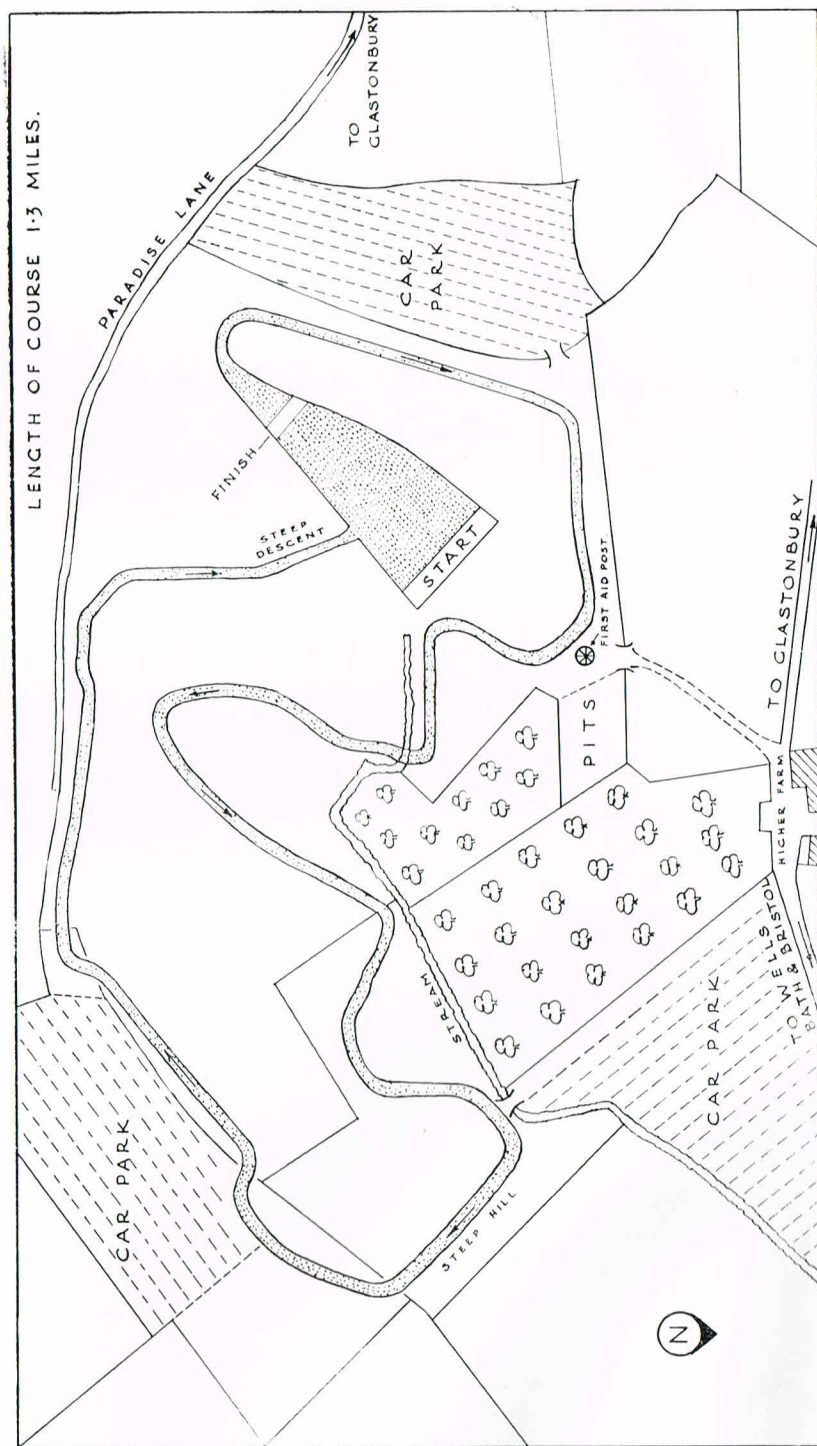

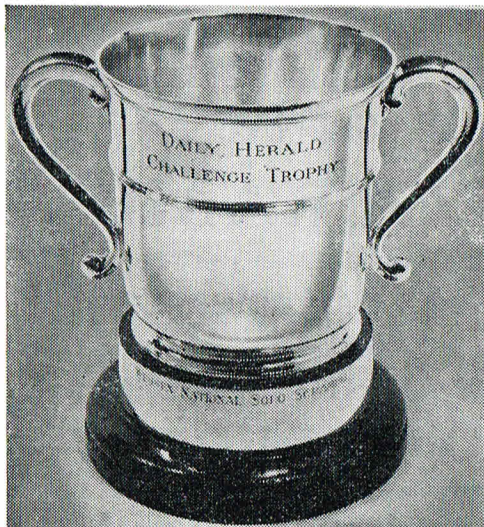

The 1963 A.C.U. Driver's Star

The main event of today's meeting, the Wessex Lightweight Scramble, offers more than the "Daily Herald" Challenge Trophy to the winner. It is the first race counting towards the 1963 A.C.U. 250 c.c. Scrambles Driver's Star—the most coveted of all lightweight class awards in this country.

Five races make up the championship and they are spaced fairly evenly throughout the scrambling season. The other four meetings this year are: May 19, Lancashire Grand National; August 5, Shrubland Park; September 29, Thirsk Grand National and October 6, Inter-Centre Team Championship.

As with the world moto-cross series points are awarded at each of the meetings on the 8-6-4-3-2-1 scale for the first six finishers.

Over the past three seasons enthusiasm for ownership of these Star awards has snowballed. Everybody wants to win one! And that, at least, means good, hard, competitive riding all down the line. It also means you've got to be quick off the mark to get accepted for these events. The lists for this meeting closed nearly two months before the final closing date—surely a record for a national meeting.

Last year's winner was former European and world 250 c.c. moto-cross champion, Dave Bickers (Greeves). But one point that struck me about the series, and seems to emphasise the openness of the event, was that not one of the top 19 riders in the final championship table had succeeded in collecting points at ALL five meetings. Here's the final table:
