The route has been considerably altered from last year, Gatcombe being brought back. There are five completely new sections. Wotton and Cape Horn, which have been used for 15 years, are given a rest.

We are very grateful to the proprietors for the use of Waye Country House Hotel as headquarters and for the start of the trial, and would also like to thank the landowners, tenants, police, and friends, whose willing co-operation makes this event possible.

Please drive carefully and with consideration for others. We hope you will enjoy your day in the West-country and come back again next year.

1. **Hadrian's Wall** 09.38 3 subs. Map Ref. 792 724. Follow route marking from Start Junction (A.38/A.383). Steep rock outcrop.
2. **Longstone** 09.44 3 subs. Join A.383 from A.38, follow route marking to section. Mud and tree roots.
3. **Elliscombe** 09.50 3 subs. Map Ref. 782 706. Follow route marking from start to A.38, where S.O.; pick up route marking again; follow to section. Steep stream bed, rocks and mud.
4. **Down Climb** 09.56 Map Ref. 784 715. Follow route to junction of A.38/A.383, R. on A.383 for 300 yards, R.L.R., S.O. for 1 mile; pick up route marking, follow to section. Progressive section. Very steep; loose shale.
5. **Buckeridge** 10.04 3 subs. Map Ref. 802 604. As for Elliscombe, S.O., S.O. past Rising Sun Inn, L. by barn at cross roads, R.L. to section. Stream, followed by rocks.
6. **Al's Design** 10.15 3 subs. Map Ref. 812 679. As for Elliscombe, S.O., S.O. past Rising Sun Inn, S.O. to Yeat Cross where R.L. down track to section. Steep woodland with rock outcrop.
7. **Keevils** 10.30 3 subs. Map Ref. 830 700. Newton Abbot-Totnes road, R. at Wolborough Cemetery, L., S.O., R.R., S.O. (track passable for all vehicles), L.R. into woods. Woodland, tree roots and rocks.
8. **Mortimer's** 10.45 3 subs. Map Ref. 830 687. Denbury-Newton Abbot road, first R., follow route marking to section. Steep woodland track with rock steps.
9. **Sunderland** 10.50 2 subs. Map Ref. 825 687. Take road from Denbury past Union Inn, first L. to Halwell Farm. Rocks and tree roots.
10. **Halwell** 10.52 As for Sunderland (Map Ref. 825 687). Mud and steep grass bank.
11. **Gatcombe** 11.12 2 subs. Map Ref. 825 625. Shadrack Cross on A.381, 4 miles from Newton Abbot, follow route marking to section. Rock slabs.
12. **Tidwell** 11.36 4 subs. From start R. on A.38 to Buckfastleigh on to A.384 (Totnes road), first L., R., S.O. for 1 mile, L. into wood at bottom of hill. Stream bed followed by long steep climb.
13. **Shortway** 11.56 5 subs. Map Ref. 711 658. R. on A.38 to Buckfastleigh, follow route to section. Steep rocky hill.
14. **Jordan** 12.30 6 subs. Map Ref. 701 750. L. on road at Waye House Hotel, S.O., L. at four cross roads, S.O., S.O. at Cold East Cross, S.O., S.O., L. at Esso garage, R.L. signpost Jordan, L. into field; follow flags to section. On extremely difficult rocky hill.

15. **Talickter** 13.10 2 subs. Map Ref. 766 752. L. on road at Waye House Hotel, S.O., L.R. at Halshanger Cross; follow route marking to section. Rocks and water.
16. **Ruby Rocks** 13.15 10 subs. Map Ref. 766 752. As for Talickter, but $\frac{1}{4}$ mile farther on. Long rocky stream with several large steps.
17. **Waye House Hotel** 13.45 Final section.

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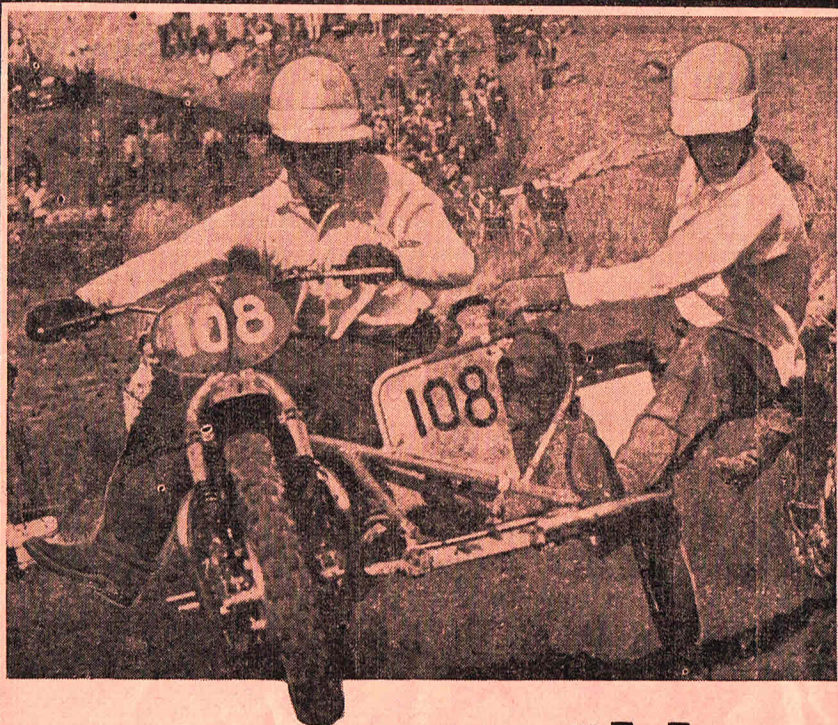
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
