OBSERVED SECTIONS

1. COBBLEDICKS (126965). Follow route-marking from start.
2. CRINK 'UM (167963). Proceed to Ottery St. Mary, where turn left along B3174 and continue for 5 miles, then sharp left. Park car in half mile and walk across field on the right, down "Staircase" to section. Sidecars only.
3. STAIRCASE (166963). As for "Crink 'Um" above.
4. SALLICOMBE (168954). As for previous two sections, but after taking the sharp left off B3174 take first right and park at Sallicombe Farm. Then walk on down lane.
5. JUNGLE (168954). As for "Sallicombe" above.
6. RASPBERRY RIPPLE (171945). As for previous four hills, but do not turn off B3174. Continue for half mile further and park at road junction. Walk across field on left.
7. JIM'S JOKE (171945). As for previous section but bear right across field. Solos only.
8. GEORGE'S GOYLE (161934). As for previous two sections but continue a little further along B3174 and first right down Sidbury road. Sections are on left. Solos only.
9. RIVER RISE (156931). As for previous section but walk across field on right of road opposite "George's Goyle".
10. TUCKER'S MUD (156931). As for previous section.
11. LANGWORTHY (153970). About 1½ miles south of the A30 just east of main Honiton-Seaton road (A375). Park clear of road and walk across common. Leave "The Climb" on left and continue for a further five minutes.
12. THE CLIMB (154977). As for previous section. In the same area are THE DITCH and BARRY'S DELIGHT.

The figures in brackets after each section are references relating to one-inch Ordnance Survey map, sheet no.176.

It is recommended that spectators should not visit the 4th or 5th sections, where parking space is very restricted.

FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

The start is at Alfington, just under a mile along B3177 (leading south off A30, three miles west of Honiton) and refreshments will be available all day at the "Alfington Inn" (also petrol and oil at the nearby garage).

The first solo will start at 10.01 a.m. and the remainder at one-minute intervals. There will be a penalty of one mark per minute for late start, up to 15 mins., then out. All sidecars will start together at 10.01 and will be escorted to three sections (The Ditch, Barry's Delight and Langworthy), after which they will join in behind solos at Cobbledicks. Their last section is Tucker's Mud.

There will be 40 observed sections for solos and 33 for sidecars. There will be no penalty for failure to follow the recommended route, but this route will be marked with the usual cards and arrows for the convenience of riders.

This is almost the shortest day of the year and observers have been instructed to enforce Regulation 8: "Failure to attempt an observed section when called upon to do so by the marshal in charge - penalty 5 marks." Anyone failing in an observed section must re-start from within the sub-section in which he has stopped. Only one attempt to re-start will be allowed.

Ties will be decided by a Special Test as follows: Start with dead engines, front wheels on Line A. At the signal start engines (by any method) and ride to Line B (flying finish). Times will be taken from signal to start until front wheels cross Line B.
