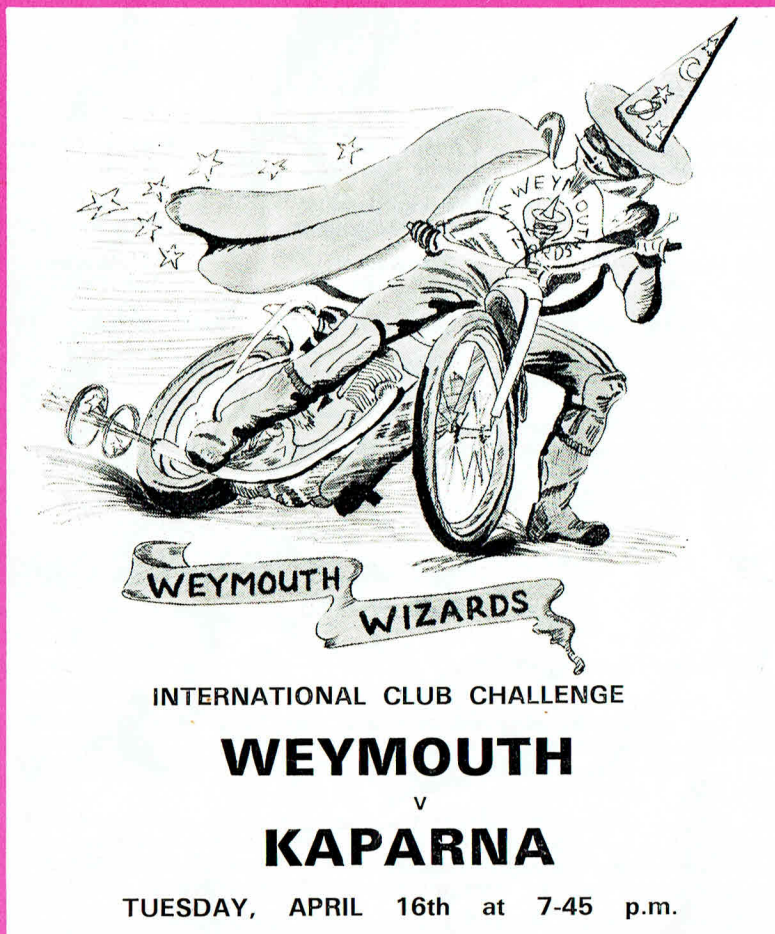

DOT'S JOTTINGS

Tonight we welcome Kaparna, a Second Division team from Sweden currently touring this country. About three years ago they were big news in Sweden, with big name riders. They then hit a bad patch and were relegated to division two, so now, they are building a new team with talented young riders, a similar policy in fact to that being employed here at Weymouth.

The English translation of "Kaparna" is "Pirate", but unlike the Poole team who proudly wear the skull and crossbones on their team colours, Kaparna endeavour to look much more ferocious by having crossed yellow cutlasses on a blue background.

On paper, this team looks very impressive. To start with, their team manager is a gentleman from Gloucestershire by the name of Roger Jones. He is a close friend, and former mechanic to Ove Fundin the Swedish ace who won five World Championships.

Riding at number one is 22-year-old KENNY SELMOSSON he is accompanied by his brother who also acts as his mechanic. I have it on good authority that both these boys are unmarried, good looking and have a high opinion of English girls.

Number two is BENGT BRANNEFORS, who is the captain and senior member of the team. His main interest away from speedway is the night club that he runs in Gothenburg in partnership with Ingemar Johansson, the former world heavyweight boxing champion.

Bengt is no stranger to British tracks as he has had short spells with New Cross, Ipswich, Newport and Wolverhampton.

ROY DANTARIUS is riding at number three and I for one will be watching him with keen interest as he learnt his speedway from Ove Fundin. Up until now, Roy has always had to ride as second string to Ove Fundin and other world class riders, so he really deserves a share of the limelight. Roy is married and his wife is with him on this trip.

SVANTE SAND rides at number four. He is, I understand, blonde, good looking, sports a small beard, and also has a very attractive wife. This young man is a former road racer who has been converted to speedway. He has a nice style and should do very well.

I am not sure whether or not SOREN KARLSSON will be riding here, but if he does, some of you may recognise him as a former Coventry team member. He is another of the married men in the team, and is interested in all forms of motor cycle sport.

TOMMY STRAUSS is the youngest of the visitors, being 18-years-old. He is a local lad from Gothenburg with a great future in speedway. With the surname of Strauss he should have very little trouble "tuning" his engine!!

Last but not least, we have STEFAN HJORT. Like Tommy, he is a local lad from Gothenburg and lives up to the reputation of being a good looking, blonde Scandinavian.

I do not usually write notes of appreciation in the programme, but I must thank Mr. Roger Jones for his help at a time when I know he must have been very busy, also a young lady named Linda, somewhere in London who was also extremely helpful.

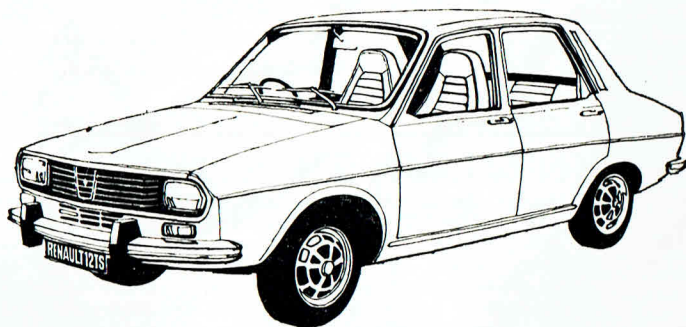
