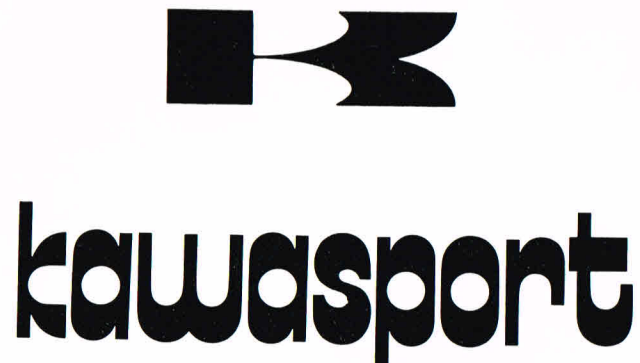

250 cc British Moto Cross Grand Prix

from Martin Christie

Moto Cross Editor of Motor Cycle

Once again the big guns of the 250 cc World Championship return to the tough Grand Prix course at Chalton, and what a sensational battle it promises to be, in this, the most competitive class in moto cross.

Four men set the tortuous, rocky track alight last year. Tenacious Czech Jaroslav Falta (CZ), and our own little tiger Vic Allan (Bultaco) tried so hard, only to be deflated by punctures, and have the day stolen by the flamboyant Swede Torleif "Ali" Hansen, (Kawasaki), and shy Belgian Harry Everts (Puch).

All of them must be likely winners today. Falta, stalked by mechanical unreliability on the flash new CZs, desperately wants the title robbed from him last year by Russian Gennady Moisseev (KTM). He needs the points. But no British rider has won a home grand prix for more than seven years, and Allan wants that honour perhaps more than he wants to retain his British title. He comes here to win today.

Two men who could upset the applecart have never ridden Ladies Mile before. Former World Champion Hakan Andersson (Yamaha), and one of the men most likely to, West German Willi Bauer (Suzuki). Along with Adolf Weil (Maico), they are the fastest men in the class.

But this superb chalk circuit needs caution as well as speed. Will we see some surprises from evergreen Joel Robert (Suzuki) or his former teammate Sylvain Geboers (Husqvarna)? Then there's colourful American Jim Pomeroy. Can Bimbo upset the form book by winning more than one grand prix a year?

Anything can happen. And with our own line-up incorporating a combination of experience and determination in Malcolm Davis (Bultaco) and Bob Wright (Montesa), it could be a day to remember for British moto cross.

As Vic Allan said after last year's race, the one thing that carried him on above all else was the sight of you, the fans, urging him on. So it's up to you too, and with John Mould at the mike, you couldn't wish for a better cheer leader.
