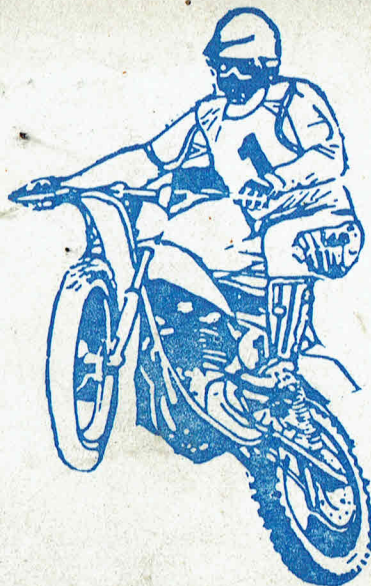

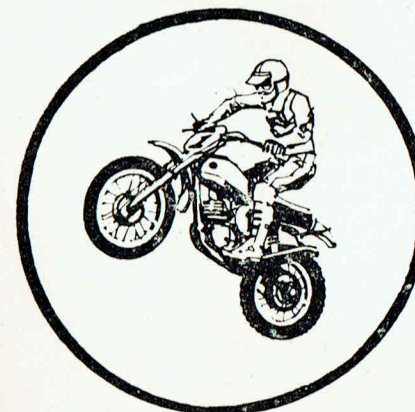
Best overall in Events 2, 4 and 5 to also hold the Patchquik Trophy (Holder: B. Wright).
