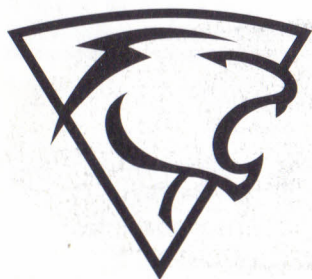

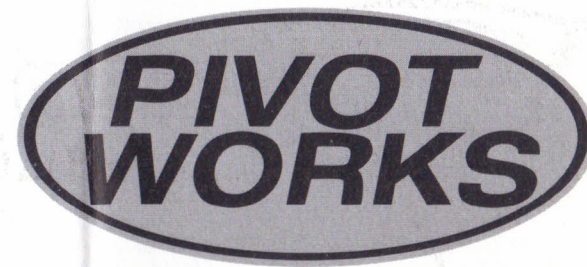

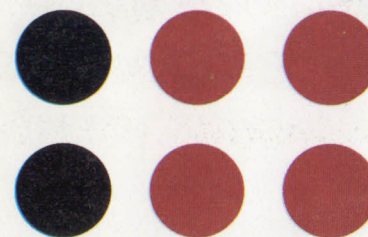

POLICE NOTICE

Owing to the increasing number of thefts of and from motor vehicles at meetings similar to that which you are now attending, the Police strongly advise you to lock your car, or immobilise your motorcycle, and to remove all articles of value. If your vehicle is stolen you may be reimbursed for its loss, but you will get no compensation for the months of inconvenience suffered whilst awaiting the results of your claim. It is also a condition of admission to any event held under an ACU permit that no part of the meeting can be filmed or video recorded and/or transmitted in any way without the written consent of the promoters/organisers and/or the ACU, except for the sole purpose of private enjoyment.

FLAG SIGNALS

RED: Danger, all riders to stop

BLACK WITH RIDER'S NUMBER: That rider to STOP immediately.

BLACKBOARD WITH "NOISE" AND NUMBER DISPLAYED: That rider to STOP and repair silencer.

YELLOW MOTIONLESS: Danger, take care, drive slowly.

YELLOW WAVED: Great danger, prepare to stop. No overtaking.

BLUE WAVED: WARNING: You are about to be lapped.

WHITE FLAG RED CROSS: First aid personnel required.

GREEN: Course clear.

YELLOW WITH DIAGONAL BLACK CROSS: Last Lap.

CHEQUERED: Finish.
