#### POLICE NOTICE

Owing to the increasing number of thefts of and from motor vehicles at meetings similar to that which you are now attending, the Police strongly advise you to lock your car, or immobilise your motorcycle, and to remove all articles of value. If your vehicle is stolen you may be reimbursed for its loss, but you will get no compensation for the months of inconvenience suffered whilst awaiting the results of your claim. If you have left your vehicle insecure, spare a few minutes to immobilise it. It could save you hours in the weeks to come. Under no circumstances are dogs allowed within the precincts of the Course. This ruling will be strictly enforced.

A clutch start in conjunction with a mechanical starting gate will be employed in all races.

Your attention is drawn to the serious consequences which could arise following an accident caused by unauthorized riding in the paddock. Liability for any claims could rest with the owner of the machine being used (or the parents of a minor).

#### COPYRIGHT

All literary matters in the Official Programme, including the list of competitors and their racing numbers is copyright and any person making illegal use thereof will be prosecuted. It is also a condition of admission to any event held under an ACU permit that no part of the meeting can be filmed or video recorded and/or transmitted in any way without the written consent of the promoters/organisers and/or the ACU, except for the sole purpose of private enjoyment.

#### **FLAG SIGNALS**

RED: Danger, all riders to stop

BLACK WITH RIDER'S NUMBER: That rider to STOP immediately.

BLACKBOARD WITH "NOISE" AND NUMBER DISPLAYED: That rider to STOP and repair silencer.

YELLOW MOTIONLESS: Danger, take care, drive slowly.

YELLOW WAVED: Great danger, prepare to stop. No overtaking.

**BLUE WAVED: WARNING:** You are about to be lapped. **WHITE FLAG RED CROSS:** First aid personnel required.

GREEN: Course clear.

YELLOW WITH DIAGONAL BLACK CROSS: Last Lap.

CHEQUERED: Finish.


