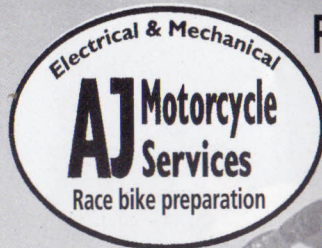

Riders Notes

• Riders Representative

The Twickenham Committee have appointed a rider, No 55 Nick Batten, to be the riders rep for Rusper. Nick will listen to any constructive points anyone may wish to make regarding track, race format etc. and will pass on your comments to the club committee for consideration. Nick can be found today parked next to the signing on marquee.

• **Running of Engines:** The running of engines is prohibited except during official practice and actual racing and for a period not exceeding five minutes prior to the start of each race. A breach of this regulation may involve exclusion from the meeting of the rider of the motorcycle concerned.

• **Control of exhaust sound level:** The Clerk of the Course may exclude any machine which exceeds the maximum permitted sound level, or which in his opinion is deemed to be excessively noisy. Sound checks will be conducted by an official throughout the meeting.

• **Riding in the pits:** There is to be no riding of machines in the pit area, all machines will be pushed with dead engines. Failure to observe this rule will result in offenders being reported to the Clerk of the Course who will exclude them from the meeting. No further warning will be given.

Course Length 1 mile

Abandonment or Cancellation

The organisers reserve the right, subject to the approval of the Stewards of the Meeting, to cancel, postpone or abandon the competition if circumstances should arise which, in their opinion render such action necessary.

8.30 a.m. Scrutineering

10.00 a.m. Practice commences

Practice passes - these will be issued by machine examiners after scrutineering. You must produce your pass before practising.

Order of Practice: Experts, Junior Open Nos. 51-104, Junior 125/250F, Juniors Nos. 106-198.

All sessions will be of 15 minutes and the first lap of each group will be **UNDER A YELLOW FLAG** situation following the travelling marshal. **NOBODY MUST OVERTAKE THE MARSHAL ON THE FIRST LAP.** Once you pass the green flag held by the finish marshal you may proceed at your own pace.

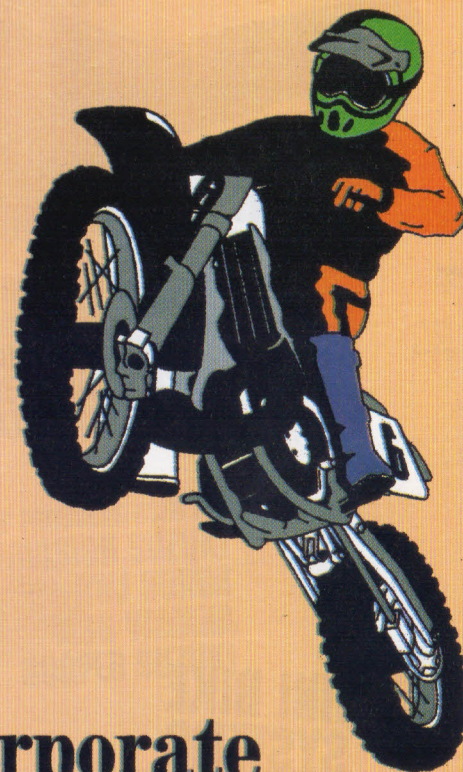

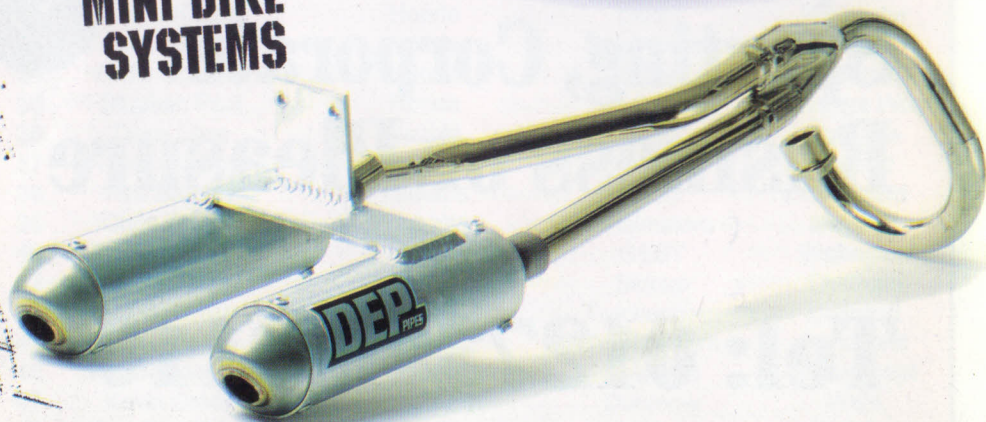

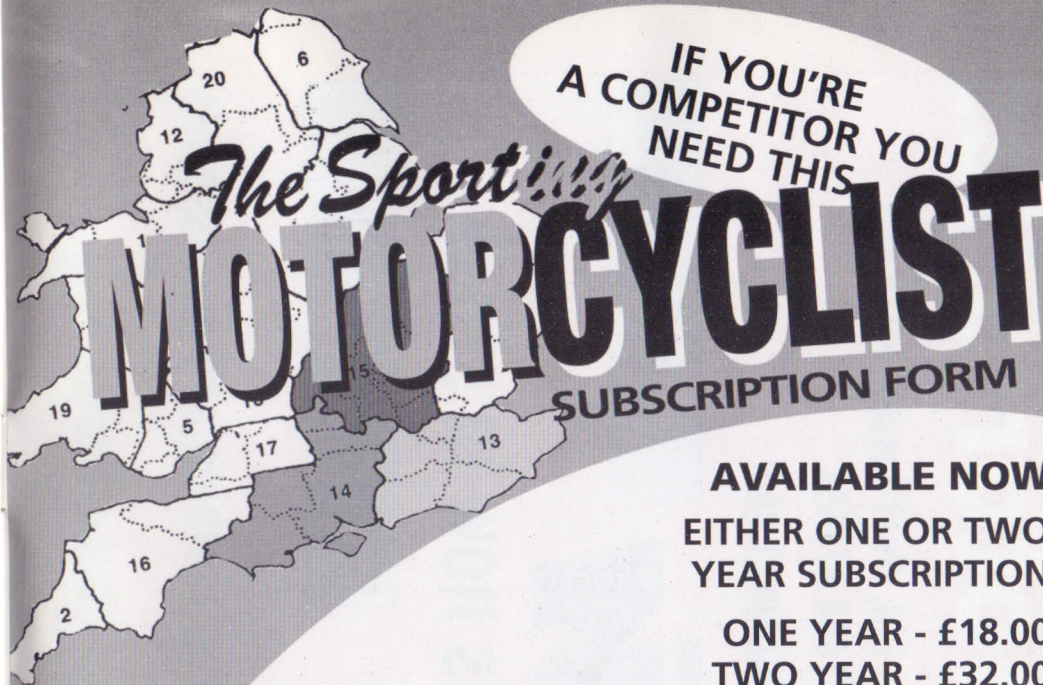
