Another reason has been safety – the big table-top jump into the bomb hole section has been removed after several nasty incidents and a new banked turn has been put in its place. We will watch with interest to see what these changes will make to the racing.

We will have red hot weather and hopefully some red hot racing — as for the former do please look after yourselves and use plenty of sun block and drink plenty of water. A note too If you have been balloted to marshal please make sure you take something to shade you i.e. an umbrella etc and again plenty to drink. Our wonderful Dorking Division of the St John Ambulance have enough to do looking after everyone without having to treat sunburn/sun stroke etc — so please take care of yourselves.

Finally the Twickenham club would like to thank everyone who has helped us in any capacity to put on this meeting. Most of all we would like to sincerely thank the Frost family who have extended their hospitality to us at various venues over the last 35 years.

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Crossing the Course

Under no circumstances should anyone (other than marshals) cross the course whilst racing is in progress. At such points where it is permissible to cross the course, a marshal will indicate when it is safe to do so.

- Running of Engines: The running of engines is prohibited except during official practice and actual racing and for a period not exceeding five minutes prior to the start of each race. A breach of this regulation may involve exclusion from the meeting of the rider of the motorcycle concerned.
- Control of exhaust sound level: The Clerk of the Course may exclude any machine which exceeds the maximum permitted sound level, or which in his opinion is deemed to be excessively noisy. Sound checks will be conducted by an official throughout the meeting.
- Riding in the pits: There is to be no riding of machines in the pit area, all machines will be pushed with dead engines. Failure to observe this rule will result in offenders being reported to the Clerk of the Course who will exclude them from the meeting. No further warning will be given.

The organisers reserve the right, subject to the approval of the Stewards of the Meeting, to cancel, postpone or abandon the competition if circumstances should arise which, in their opinion render such action necessary.

#### **FLAG SIGNALS**

Danger all riders to stop Black with riders number. That rider to stop immediately Yellow Static Danger, take care. drive slowly **Yellow Waved** Great danger, prepare to stop, no overtaking Green Course Clear Yellow with diagonal black cross Last Lan Chequered. Finish

#### **RIDERS NUMBERS**

Make sure your numbers are readable, of regulation size with one in front, plus one each side - remember the lap scorers.

125 cc - White on Black 250 cc - White on Green 350 cc - White on Blue 351-500 cc - Black on Yellow Over 500 cc - Black on White
