Section Marking As follows,

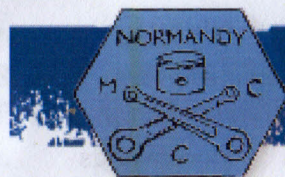

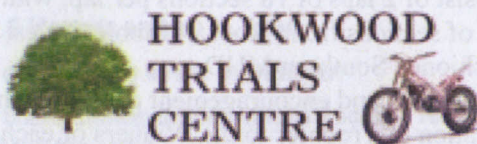
