



The 'Classic Bike' Magazine Championship is for four-strokes from before 1973 and two-strokes before 1968, and sets out to capture the atmosphere of racing in the Classic era. With sponsorship this year from De Dietrich Heating Division, Oertli Burners of Bromsgrove and Selkirk Chimneys of Banstead, it offers a prize fund of £10,000 for the world's leading classic championship.

Competitors include stars with TT and Manx Grand Prix wins, like Dave Pither, Bill Swallow and Les Trotter. Bill is a great favourite at Aberdare, and is switching from his sponsored ride on Fred Walmsley's Seeley this year, to race his famous Velocette Special in the 500cc Championship race. Another man with the giant-killing habit is Alan Edwards, whose 250 BSA has won the smallest classic class three times on this circuit; Alan will be on his BSA and a 350 Ducati today.

Aberdare sees a new idea in classic racing this year. The Welsh King of the Classics race is for the fastest riders in the three Classic races, regardless of engine size. On the tight bends, a good man on a 350 stands a chance of beating the bigger bikes to take the £125 first prize and the King's crown. Whoever wins, he will not have an easy ride, that's for sure, because Aberdare produces some of the closest racing of the eight rounds of the Championship.


