

IMBA SIDECARS - FINAL POSITIONS

lan Osbaldiston and Michael Stones took 7th place in the final round of the IMBA's European Championship ion Switzerland and moved up to 8th place in the Championship. In the opening race they finished 5th behind the four Belgium outlits with Eddy and Ludo Somers non starters and his replacement Mark Goovaerts and Sven Verbrugge won all three races.

Ossie was 10th in the 2nd race and 8th in the 3rd scoring 47 points in total which was

their 2ns best performance over the six rounds.

Other AMCA crews to score were Craig Edwards and Chris Whatmore with 11 and

Ken Norbury and passenger Mick Cunningham who scored 6.

Belgium riders dominated the series taking the first four places with Marco Cremes and Alfons Eggers winning by 106 points from Walter van Calster and Benny Cle with former champion Eddy Nuyts and Danny Gothals 3rd while Somers brothers still finished 4th despite missing the final round. Belgium riders won 16 of the 18 races run with the German Paul Lorne and Detlef Lenz winning two of the three races held in Germany and taking 6th in the championship behind Dutchman Willie van Hal and Coen van de Heuy.

Final positions of the AMCA riders were Ossie and Michael Stones 8th, David and Stephen Smith who missed the Swiss round 19. Ken Norbury and Mick Cunningham who missed the Czech round were 29, David Millward who used two passengers Paul Baker and Chris Whatmore and who missed two rounds were 34th while Craig Edwards and Pete Smith only rode in the Swiss round. 42 outfits competed representing 6 countries, with only 11 riders attending every round.

The Annual IMBA Nations Cup moto cross was held in Switzerland on Sunday which classed with the AMCA's Super Class opening round.

Representing the AMCA were Roy Wells (Dursley) who suffered a knee injury in the first race when Swiss riders fetched him off. Roy was unable to ride again due to the injury. Richard Main the AMCA's 4 stroke champion scored 50 points, Tim Mallard (Northants) scored 59 and John Randle (Uley) scored 66 points, the points corresponding to the finish positions. Winners were Belgium, 2nd Holland, 3rd Austria with the Swiss teams 4th and 5th, Czech 6th and France 8th. The Germans did not compete due to a national championship round, with rain most of the day the meeting did not attract a big crowd.

BMCA - Classic Trials

The second of the weekly series of winter classic trials was held at Daventry on Sunday (October 4th) and 30 riders competed over 4 laps of 10 sections riding British bikes. No licences are required, nor membership of clubs. Entry forms are available at each event. The trials start at 10.30 am and usually finish by lunchtime and are all closed circuit so the bikes do not need to be taxed and insured. 
