


The Morgans are not strangers to the VMCC meetings and will follow us to Cadwell Park next month for round two of their series.

Well let's have a look how things are shaping up so far this season. The Historic Racing circus' last meeting was at Snetterton in Norfolk and this is how the races ended after the two races in each event

In the Tuers Garage Championship it was Tim Johnson taking the win in both rounds with Toby Smedley hot on his wheels again so Toby will have his work cut out here to try and close the gap on Tim.
