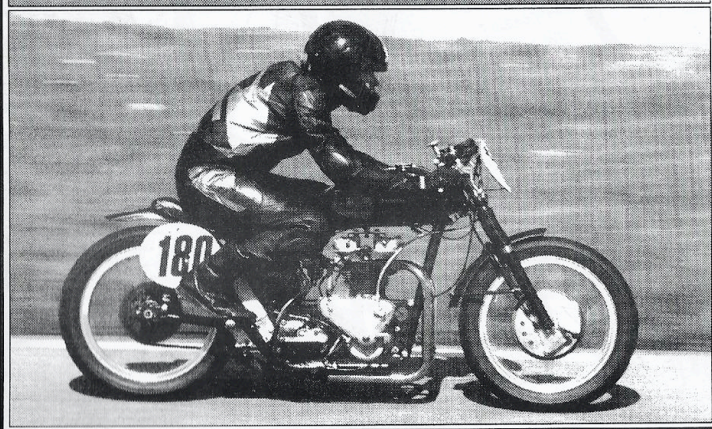
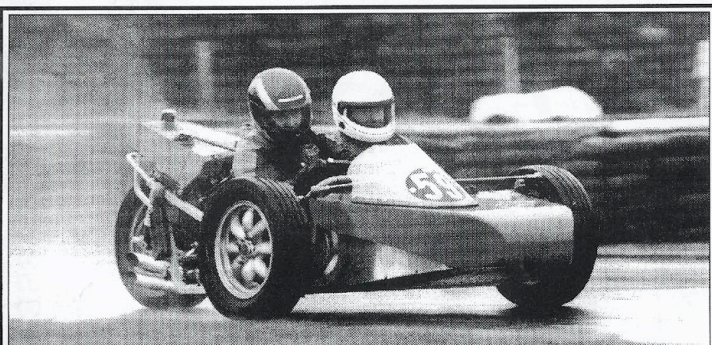
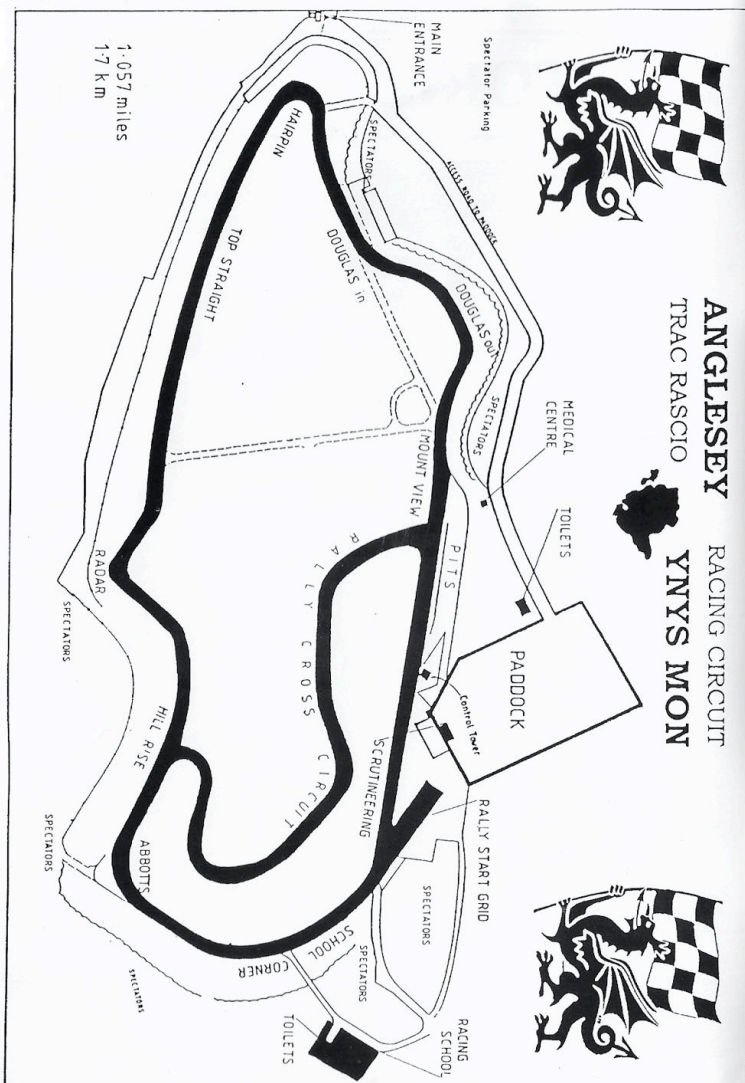

## Round 3

Welcome to Anglesey for round three of the VMCC Historic Racing season. This circuit is very popular with our riders with a beautiful view of the bay being seen from the paddock. The circuit is very demanding and will put to the test riding ability for all riders entered. We also say welcome again to the Morgan Three Wheeler Club who start their season off with us this weekend with round one of the Morgan Motor Company Challenge Series. The Morgans are not strangers to the VMCC meetings and will follow us to Cadwell Park next month for round two of their series.

Well let's have a look how things are shaping up so far this season. The Historic Racing circus' last meeting was at Snetterton in Norfolk and this is how the races ended after the two races in each event.

In the Tuers Garage Championship it was Tim Johnson taking the win in both rounds with Toby Smedley hot on his wheels again so Toby will have his work cut out here to try and close the gap on Tim. In the M.A.N Flying Systems Championship for Formula Bantams Mike Powell took the flags with Peter Tibbitts finishing second, Pete is absent this weekend so Mike hopefully will be able to increase his lead over Pete.

In the Old Bike Mart Championship Toby Smedley was there again to take two wins this time and Ian Bain settling for two seconds. The Edwards Christiansen Championship for the 250's saw last year's championship winner Stu Noble battling with Merv Stratford. It will be interesting to see who finishes where this weekend.

The Ossie Neal Championship (event 8) saw Nick Weston and passenger Kerry Williams roar to the front of the field and take the chequered flag. In the Consort Ltd Championship which was also on the circuit at the same time as event 8 it was David Wells and passenger Paul Mann that took one win and Dennis and Christine Etheridge who took the second race.

In the Bennetts Championship Mark Capewell, Phillip Wade and Graham Buller battled against one another round the twisty corners of the Esses and Russells trying to get the better of each other. In the GB Motor Company Championship Phil Jobborn came out tops taking both wins. Some are here this weekend others are not so this championship will change somewhat over the four scoring rounds..

The Dresda Autos Championship saw the invited Classic machines take first, second and third so we shall have to see who the championship scorers make winners as the invited machines are not eligible for points. Stu Tonge and Phil Jobborn were joint leaders before the Snetterton round so we shall hopefully have a clearer picture ready for Cadwell.

The Janic Antiques championship saw the Morgans battle together with Bill and Maggie Tuer taking yet again two wins from Greg Bibby and Paula Heaney. In the Big Shots Championship John Butcher and Bob Hoellen both went down the track giving it all they had to get the better of each other and even managed to fall on the same corner in virtually the same part in separate races. Spooky or What! So they ended up with a win a piece.

The Pertemps Recruitment Partnership Solo Champion of Champions saw Phil Jobborn take the win he deserved. He battled from the back of the grid with his knowledge of the circuit allowing him to work his way through the pack to the flag. The Bonham & Brooks Sidecar and Three-wheeler Champion of Champions race was won by Bill and Maggie Tuer after their battle with Chas Reynolds and his passenger (It must be scary not being able to see what is happening as a passenger in those Morgans).

The Norvil Motorcycle Championship for the Novice riders was won by Robert Walker with Martin Ellis coming a close second.
