

Welcome again everyone to this lovely little circuit on the Isle of Anglesey, The Historic Racing Club are set to hold their second round of the season this weekend and welcome the Morgan Owners Club and The Forgotten Racing Club, both clubs holding their own championship rounds over the course of the weekend.

Quite a few of our regular riders are missing this weekend so here's a chance for those who have entered to add a possible four sets of points to the championship tables making those riders who are absent having to fight to catch up on their return.

Although the machines between the FRC and VMCC are immensely different, the enthusiasm and aims are identical – to preserve racing machines of their respective periods and maintain their use on the tracks for the benefit of the public – therefore such bridge building can only be good for the future of the sport.

Regarding the Historic teams, the Mallory Park opener was not a good start for Morgan stars Bill and Maggie Tuer, Bill dislocated a shoulder when the trike rolled several times when it siezed on entering Gerards Bend. Whether he will be present today depends on both his fitness and the damage sustained to the car. His absence will be appreciated by his rivals no doubt, fellow Morganisers Greg Bibby and Debbie Bain will intend to add to their Mallory honours and Roly Mettam's Mogvin was on the pace in second place.

Keep an eye out also for the superb Halec Specials of Ewan Cameron and his father Tim. The appearance of the mighty 1000cc JAP V twin powered MK I in particular, at Mallory, went down very well with the crowd and they are a truly terrific spectacle. Likewise the Mini engined Berkeley of John Lorriman should make for interesting duels with the outfits.

In the Old Bike Mart pre '49 Unlimited Series, it's Toby Smedley who has set the early pace, his 1934 Sunbeam proving too fast for even reigning champion Graham Buller and the HRD Meteor. Others to note in this class may be Richard Cornish with an indecently quick model 18 Norton, lan Bain on the ex Jimmy Guthrie Manx and Big John McMahon aboard his oversized 5T Triumph.

Hart McLeod Print Production start their sponsorship this weekend of the 250 Class, this class saw a surprise at Mallory when Stu Noble blasted his C15 BSA onto the pace more normally associated with Mervyn Stratford's Rudge. The unit single is surely going to be a championship contender this year. The Jim Lidgate Memorial 350 Series looks like continuing as a Gold Star benefit with Steven Radakovic and Martin Page making the running. Likewise, Doug Jones should have the GB Motor Co. Senior class all his own way, his Manx so much faster than anything else on the grid. This was proved in the premier event at Mallory, the Fujitsu Computers Champion of Champions Handicap, when Doug Jones started last, almost a lap behind eventual winner Lee Moore (350 Manx) but scorched through the field to finish just seconds adrift at the flag. The Bantams will be out in force too, their M.A.N. Flying Systems Championship races throwing up some superb dices between Mike Powell, Keith Woods, Peter Tibbitts and the very fast mark Carkeek. Let's hope Carkeek takes in the handicap because he has, without doubt, No. 1 plate potential. The three wheelers are catered for, courtesy of the Richard Adams Photography Champion of Champions Handicap. The principle is the same, top finishers in the Langham Engineering sidecar class do battle against their three wheeler counterparts on a handicap basis, the overall season champion eventually taking the No. 1 plate.

With all the entries this weekend it promises to be a great weekend's sport. Don't forget the next round is at Snetterton on June  $\theta^{th}$ .

#### The 1999 Morgan Motor Company Challenge Series
