## RIDING IN THE PADDOCK

Once again attention is drawn to the serious consequences which could arise following an accident caused by unauthorised riding of any sort of machine in the Paddock.

All too frequently at meetings children are allowed to ride machines in the mistaken belief that because a race paddock is on private property and outside the jurisdiction of the Road Traffic Act, no insurance is necessary. It cannot be stressed too strongly that **liability for a substantial claim could rest with the owners of the vehicle and the driver.** (Or the parent in the case of a minor.)

The Union's insurers will quite legitimately repudiate any claim on them for damages arising out of the accident caused by an unauthorised driver.

## Round 2 British Sidecar Qualifying Championship

**D**avid Whitbread and Alan Henton, No. 96 from Bristol, are the in form crew at the moment, heading the series by 10 points on 34. They should however be expecting stiff opposition from the No. 45 team of Malcolm Collins and Simon Meaton of Hampshire who managed to score 23 points from only 2 finishes in the muddy conditions of Binsted in round 1. With only two other teams managing to score in all three round 1 races, Dave Millard currently 2nd with Steve Conner passengering and Gary Wolff/Dave Henton the championship is wide open. Strong challenges should also be expected from Luton based driver Gareth Thomas, who is still looking for a regular partner, and ex championship contender Kim Logan of Slough with the experienced Andy Shields in the sidecar. Both these crews failed to score in the first round after failing to get past the heats due to mechanical breakdowns. With the sandy conditions at Canada Heights contrasting to the mud at Binsted, this weekend's racing should be extremely hard fought.



**The ACE Fourstroke Association** was formed five years ago by a group of enthusiasts who wanted to compete on fourstroke machinery, without the need to travel all over the country to pursue their chosen branch of the sport. The aims were to promote the class and to encourage younger riders to compete in the class. As most of the founders were resident in the South

East, most of the rounds in the first year were held in the South Eastern Centre, with only a couple in the South Midland and one in the Eastern Centre. As with most good things, word soon spread and we had members joining further afield, which was good for the sport, and for the organisers, who were looking for riders with which to fill their programmes.

However as the membership grew, we had requests, from riders and clubs, to run meetings outside of our original area. We have tried to stick to the guide lines of the founders. Of the 20 rounds scheduled for 1996, 12 are in the South Eastern Centre, 7 South Midland, and 1 Eastern.

Membership for riding members is £10.00, non-riding members £5.00. For this we try to get you a newsletter with details of future meetings, and results of past rounds; I have put "try" as they are not on a regular basis, usually more as and when someone has time to put one together.

The next meeting is 28th April at Culham, run by the Oxford Ixion Club, followed by 6th May Castle Colchester Club at Marks Tey, 12th May Twickenham at Rusper, 19th May Northampton Club, then 27th May Luton Club at Haughton Conquest.
