**Welcome** to the start of the 2017 SEMX Motocross Championship here at Canada Heights. The Junior entry is a sell out and the gate boasts some quality riders all eager to pile on the points, watch out for #721 Jake Deacon with his main goal to collect valuable Expert points so he can progress to the top in the sport, the battle for that elusive SEMX Junior Championship title starts here and will be fast and furious in all of the 12 race series.

The Expert field has some notable riders including the #272 of Neville Bradshaw the 2016 MX Nationals MX2 Champion. Mark Eastwood #3, the ex GP, National and AMA rider has been unbeatable around the Heights lately he will be on the 2017 brand new spec CRF Honda 450. The 2016 SEMX Champion Shaun Springer along with #7 Mitchell Lewis (Jnr), will be keen to show the "old boys" the way home.

The Veterans who must be at least 35 years old to compete in this class and line up in a race that was designed to be a calmer battle field, and they have all been officially downgraded from Lunatics to slightly bonkers.

Our thanks as always to Edna of the St Johns medics and her dedicated crew, Marshals, and all the volunteers who make these race days possible. On a sour note we keep getting visited by undesirables, please please lock up your bike and genny if left unattended. Finally please take all your rubbish back to the bins or home with you as whatever litter is left has to be picked up by a volunteer who would much rather go home early after a good days Motocross racing.

Thanks for racing with Sidcup MCC and we hope you have a safe and enjoyable day at Canada Heights.

**Flags** - The rules changed a few seasons ago, waved yellows means "Great Danger, prepare to stop, no overtaking. A significant reduction must be seen, therefore jumps should not be attempted" - we haven't gone to all the effort of getting marshals out there for a sun tan, they are there to help you the riders have a safer day. Observing flag signals is there to help you all; we as officials and marshals try very hard to only use waved yellows where necessary so please help us to help you by observing the rules.

**Fire extinguishers** - This rule has been about for some time, but in today's health and safety culture we need to be seen to be proactive. The rules state each rider shall have at least a 2kg dry powder fire extinguisher. Riders will need to present their fire extinguisher at technical control in the future.

**Numbers** - It's always a moan about this but we try very hard to help you. The numbers on your bike, let us the race officials, but also your fans / family / rivals /etc know who you are. We do have a permanent number scheme for those that want to look "nice", but if you chose not to use this scheme don't be upset that we give a different number than you currently have on your bike. When you stick a bit of duct tape along side a giant number, shockingly the rest of us can't always tell who you are. We've got some vinyl to hand to cover number plates and Off Road South East have numbers for sale if you can't make your number plate clear yourself.

**Security** - Many of you will be aware that there had been a spate of thefts early last year. Please do all you can to keep your bikes and possessions chained up when unattended - overnight and during the day.

**Marshalling** - It's a pain but as we've said above its there for you, the riders, safety. We at Sidcup operate a scheme over the two club members race days (ie today and July) - we pick at random from the entry list enough of you to cover the marshal points for half a day. Once you've done your duty you won't do it at the other meeting. We operate the same scheme over the 4 open meetings (April, May, June and October) - thus everyone marshals once for the club days and once for the open meetings. Theoretically you could be lucky you don't get picked, but we only ask you to do it once in each set of meetings during the year. In an ideal world we might have an army of paid persons to do the marshalling, unfortunately we don't and this is the least worst system we have come up with. We are all aware that it is not easy to get someone to do this, all riders are in the same situation, appeals on social media in advance have been successful for many of you. Please be reassured we actively monitor who does marshal and try very hard to ensure that no one "gets away" without doing their bit.

### Junior Qualification

Practice will be timed to decide the qualifiers for the A, B & C groups.

The fastest 33% from heats 1, 2 & 3 will comprise the A group, the next 33% the B group and the remainder the C group. The Veterans class will remain the same for all races.

### Unauthorised Riding

The riding of machines of any sort in the paddock and areas surrounding the circuit is totally forbidden. Because the event is on private property it does not place it outside the Road Traffic Act in terms of insurance. It cannot be stressed too strongly, that liability for a substantial claim could rest with the owners of the vehicle and the driver (or parents in the case of a minor) in the event of an accident.

### Course Length 1.8 Km

### Points System

The following scoring system will be used for all races today. 25: 22: 20: 18: 16: 15: 14: 13: 12: 11: 10: 9: 8: 7: 6: 5: 4: 3: 2: 1.

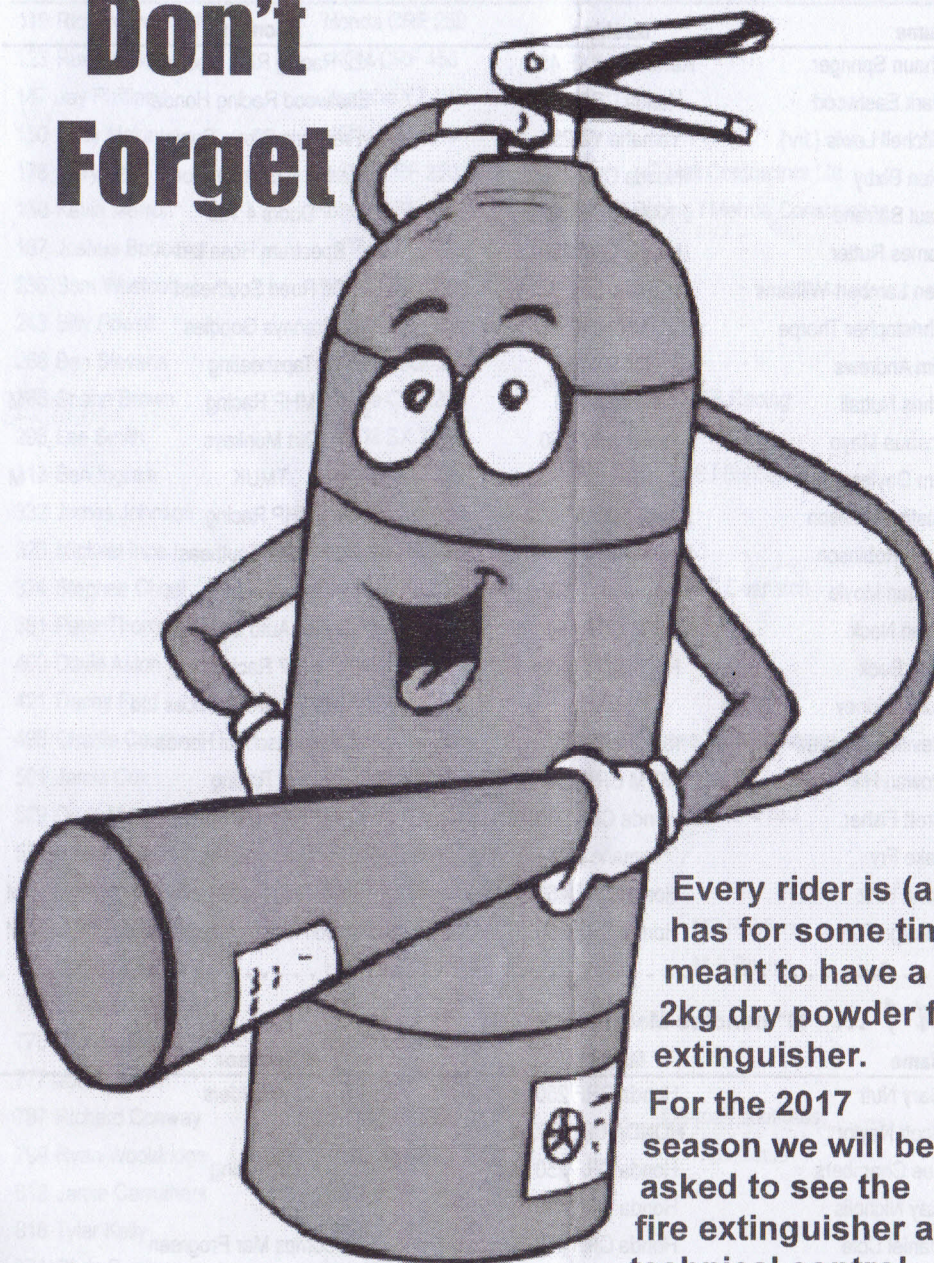



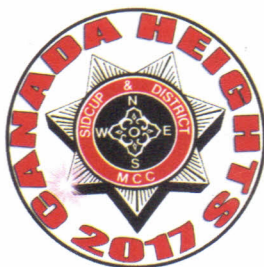
