

SUPER CLASS

Congratulations to Mike Church from the Avon Group who has won the 82 Super Class Championship and so takes the No. 1 plate for 1983 plus a useful piece of cleaning equipment from K'A'cher who are supporting the 82 A.M.C.A. Championships.

Demonstrations of the cleaning equipment can be seen at the Championship events throughout this season

A.M.C.A. CHAMPIONSHIPS

The new format for the Championship has caused some problems but is is perhaps early days to draw any definite conclusions. It is quite evident that many of the clubs who voted for the new system did not study the implications and are not happy when they realise home group riders are not able to ride at the events unless the events are turned into a two day meeting with the local riders competing on one day with the championships events on the other day.

Several groups are already planning on this type of event and some group co-ordinators chose early dates in the season when not all the championship qualifiers had been sorted out which enabled some home group riders a chance to ride.

GROUP CHAMPIONSHIPS

A reminder that group championships should be held on the same day as the A.M.C.A. Championship are held, this only applies to the 250's and 750's and it is

up to each group to decide how many rounds will count. This system is the start for sorting out the qualifiers for 83, riders who are in the 250/750 championships classes this year automatically qualify for the 83 area qualifiers along with the top riders from each group this season.

RIDING IN THE PADDOCK

The recent ruling by the Executive Committee to stop riding in the paddock and to and from the track needs some explanation.

The reasons for bringing in this measure follows several successful claims last season by people injured by riders off the track. The company who covered the events last season for Third Party Insurance refused to even quote for the business due to the losses paid out. Several companies have also refused to quote when they knew of the claims and the company who have taken on the cover want to know what improvements the Association are putting into effect to try and stop the accidents from which the claims have arisen.

It should be pointed out that the 3rd party Insurance has come up for renewal in March so the facts are not available in December at the AGM time. What other rules have been made to help with this problem, the distance between the ropes was increased to 5 metres minimum and a minimum of 6 metres when sidecars are present.

Many times clubs and officials state that without First Aid the meetings cannot be held and perhaps the question of the 3rd Party Insurance never queried which for many years has not been a problem as there has never been any claims.

Several clubs and groups have implemented this rule for sometime and clubs are asked to help the riders by roping runs to and from the track so riders do not have to push up hills especially after the races.

Anyone who has attended two meetings on one day and seen non riding at one event and riders able to ride through the paddock at the other even; cannot help but notice the difference and how much safer one feels despite the warnings over the years to riders, it is a minority who have caused this new rule.

FREEDOM OF CHOICE — June 27th should have been the day when riders would be given a chance to ride outside their own group, every group had an event planned, no championship events were to be run and what happens.

On the closing date 38 clubs had not sent in their entries, wait another day and we are still short of a fifth of the entries. In fact three days after the closing date there are still a dozen outstanding. To be able to sort out which riders can go where depends in having all the entries in. For example 38 Yorkshire riders wanted to go to the North West event at Cuerdon Park but no one from the North West wished to ride elsewhere so it would be impossible to fit the riders into the meeting. Two clubs from the North West had not sent in their entries, perhaps 30 of these riders may have wanted to go to Yorkshire so an exchange could have been on.

Another problem was the cancellation of the Chester event in the Greater Manchester group after the sheets had gone out to clubs.

The next date for "Freedom of Choice" is planned for August 1st but it is essential every club helps by returning the entry sheets. A list of the clubs who were late for June 27th have been sent out to clubs and co-ordinators.

LAYOUT OF CIRCUITS

A high number of riders are suffering injuries and several recommendations are being formulated to try and make tracks safer. This is an extremely difficult matter to resolve but it is hoped that man made jumps which are appearing in ever increasing numbers should have "run offs' or "roll overs" with no sheer drops and riders should be able to see the landing point. Also the angle of the jump should not throw riders up into the air, some jumps have been described as take offs for harrier aircraft.

LIMITED COMPANY

The A.M.C.A. Office has now circulated to clubs a draft paper for making the A.M.C.A. into a limited company and members are asked to study these and hopefully the Annual Meeting in December will adopt the proposal.


