

1983 CENTURY OILS BRITISH MOTO CROSS CHAMPIONSHIP

Foreword by Dave Smith

With the dust hardly settled from the 1st round of the Century Oils British Championship the top 35 riders in the U.K. move to the most northerly circuit in the 1983 competition here at Barfield.

The 1st round at Hawkstone Park was predominantly a battle of the works Hondas with Graham Noyce tucking 2 victories under his belt and at one stage well on his way to a hat trick of wins, but fate was to interfere and it is now history that the reigning British Champion Neil Hudson nosed his way through to record his first victory in the 1983 campaign. This victory leaves him just 1 point behind Noyce's team-mate Dave Thorpe who more than ably backed up Noyces overall victory.

The battle of the 250 cc Grand Prix runners continues today with Yamahas Dave Watson trying to shake off the threat of Suzuki youngster Jem Whatley. They go into to-days event in equal 4th place tying with 35 points each from their first outing.

Jonathan Wright now reunited with the Kawasaki team after a twelve month relationship with Suzuki moves into this round with 27 points under his belt to lead the Kawasaki charge for points, with team-mate Kurt Nicholl only 2 points behind. Splitting the Kawasaki duo is Scotsman Willie Simpson who also after a twelve month break away from his beloved Swedish Husqvarna machinery is very much to the fore in this years championship and will be looking to climb further up the league table today.

Behind this close ranked trio is veteran of British Championship battles Roger Harvey. Once again campaigning standard machinery for the U.K. importers of Yamaha he will be looking for another fist full of points to show that his number 5 plate is just reward for such a marvellous campaigner.

Just 2 points behind Harvey is East Anglian resident Geoff Mayes. The 1980 British Champion racing Kawasaki machinery for Ely dealer Stuart Nunn (a former member of the top 35 himself) has started the 1983 season with better fortunes than a year ago when he failed to score in the opening round.

Other riders expected to show form to-day are Maicos number one Brett Steele, Suzuki's Stephen Russell and the Honda (U.K.) teamsters Paul Hunt and Perry Leask who will continue to campaign their 250 cc machinery throughout the championship.

The The support championship this year as usual is not a class to miss for excitement. Leader after the 1st round Kevin Froud cannot relax, with Midlander Rob Andrews and Honda's exciting youngster Tony Craig lurking close behind.

Once again, thanks to our sponsors and just as important thank you the general public for backing this Bootle Scrambles Club presentation by honouring us with your attendance. I hope it is worth it. Have an enjoyable days racing!
