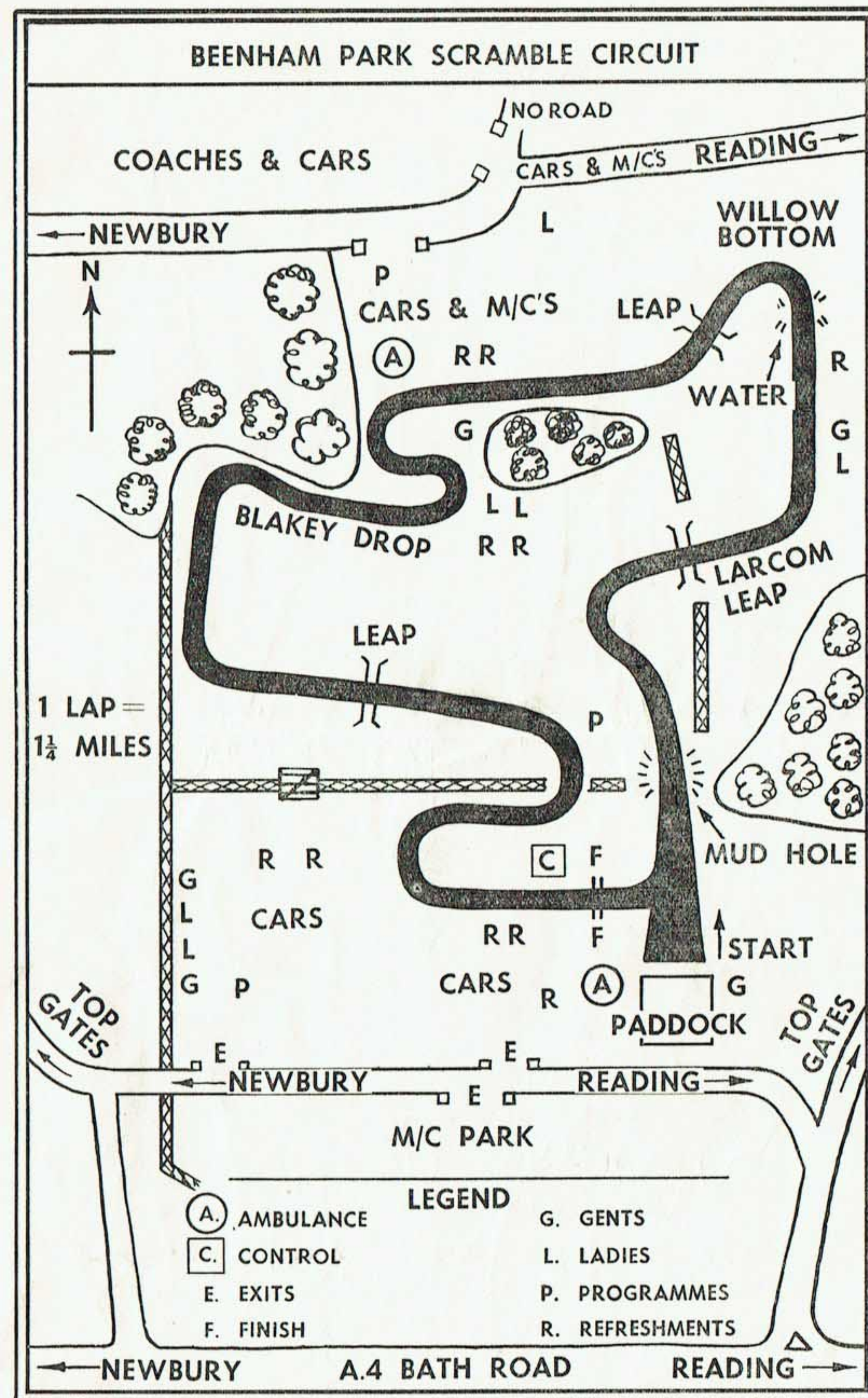

WE RECORD PROGRESS

APRIL 13 of the 13th year that we have been promoting Scrambles at Beenham and it is the start of the most exciting season that we have ever undertaken. During 1958 we will be presenting Open to Centre, National and International meetings.

This is the first time that one of our own Club events has rated a "National" permit. We are very proud. Let us recall the steady progress; remember the four 125's of Vic Turner, Dave Cookson, Derek Wright and Leo Shepherd when we first established "tiddler" racing. How patient we all were when they disappeared into the woods and we were never quite sure that any of them would finish the race. Lightweight racing is an integral part of all Scrambles these days. Remember the two sidecars of Jack Stocker and Freddie French. It used to be "Passenger Bill Turner" in the Stocker "chair". Those races were the start of the revival of Sidecar Scrambling.

We seem to have been the first to try many things, some succeeded and some failed but support for our events grew and grew, our experience as organisers enlarged so that today we are recognised "National" promoters.

And so today . . . many will be surprised at the reduced entry for a "National". There is a simple explanation. Only Expert Riders are involved. We have assembled a Solo entry of 50 Experts to contest the races today. Our policy for this top flight "expert" racing is fewer races, longer races and a quality entry.

For your diary our other Beenham Park dates :—

May 11th — Bargepole Scramble.

June 15th — International Moto-Cross.

October 12th — Beenham Park Championships.

INTERNATIONAL BEENHAM

THE COUPE d'EUROPE MOTO-CROSS Championship Series was established for 1957 by our International Federation, the Silver Cup being awarded to the rider gaining the most number of points at the various International Events. The winner also taking the title "Champion of Europe".

We in Britain took little interest but on the Continent things were very different. The Czechs with their Jawas; German Maicos; Austrian Puchs; they all saw this new series as an opportunity to undermine the British supremacy in the field of Moto-Cross. Keen competition developed which ended with German F. Betzelbacher (Maico) becoming the European Champion. Some idea of the performances put up by these "unknowns" is that Brian Stonebridge took his very potent Greeves to the Swiss event and was beaten by the Czechs.

This year we are out to catch up with this Series and for the first time Britain is promoting a meeting to count for the Coupe d'Europe. This Beenham Park Circuit has been selected as the venue and Mortimer & District are promoting the event on behalf of the Auto-Cycle Union. Right now we are in negotiation with the leading Continental Riders who are pursuing the European title. We are dealing with Germany, Sweden, Belgium, Holland and France, all of whom have riders who wish to ride at Beenham. Additionally Mr. H. R. Taylor on a visit to Warsaw is hoping to obtain representative riders from behind the Iron Curtain. All this adds up to some very exciting competition for the best of our British Riders. Also appearing in the programme will be two sidecar races and two 500 c.c. races for our National Stars. The whole event being supported by our British Manufacturers. There will only be two International Scrambles in Britain this year and this is one of them, it is obviously the most important meeting in the South. Get a big red pencil and underline the date :

JUNE 15th BEENHAM PARK

For an event of this nature which is not held on a Sunday it is normal to charge 4/- admission and 2/6 — 5/- car park, i.e. £1.1.0d. for a car load of four people. There are big costs involved in obtaining Continental support. We at Mortimer maintain that faith must be kept with our regular supporters and that we must not take advantage of this big event by charging excessive fees for programmes, etc. In any case the event is on a Sunday therefore admission will be free. The parking charges will be Cars 7/6 and Motorcycles 4/-.
