TODAY'S EVENT

We welcome you our public and friends to the last event of the year. We have for your pleasure the Final Round of the British Sidecar Championships with Nick Thompson in the lead with 20 points, Mortimer Club men John Turner with Mick Meredith in the chair, and John Elliott with Andy Greenhorn in the chair tying for 2nd place with 18 points, Ken Logan from the north with 9 points and Bob Spencer with 7. Mortimer Club men will fight to keep the British Champion, who is at present John Turner, in the club, but Nick Thompson with Dave Beavis are very determined and fearless riders and we can expect some fierce battles, so those with nervous dispositions should have their tranquillisers at the ready.

There is also the Final Championship of the Shell under 21 with Rob Hooper with 50 points who cannot be beaten but Rob Donaldson from Basingstoke with 30 points, Peter Mathia with 26 points, Terry Dyer with 24 points, K. Ferris with 22 points and David Drake with 20 points, so there will be a battle for 2nd and 3rd place with these young riders which are the stars of tomorrow.

Lastly we have the championship of the 125 solo class with Brian Wade with 55 points, Malcolm Davis with 43 and Vic Allan with 13 points. If Brian Wade should not get any points and the new 250 c.c. Champion, Malcolm Davis, should win both races he could still beat Brian Wade.

There is also the Jackpot Race which stands at £100 first prize for the solo. An/ly Robertson, who is going to America to race afterwards for the year, could easily scoop up the gold, but Brian Wade, who is going into hospital for a knee operation afterwards could make a firm challenge with Malcolm Davis, the British 250 Champion, Jimmy Aird, Jimmy Stuart and Vic Allan all from Scotland and the Scots are very canny about money, not forgetting the man from Cumberland, Norman Barrow, who we think is one of the most underestimated riders in Moto Cross. May the best man win and your support and enthusiasm will spur them on.

I am sure you would all wish to join me in wishing Andy Robertson a successful and happy year in America, Andy, over the years, has been our most loyal rider. We would like to take this opportunity of expressing our

appreciation and **Please Come Back Andy we shall miss you.** Also Brian Wade a speedy recovery from his leg operation in hospital and a wonderful holiday afterwards. Moto Cross Sport would not be the same without you both.

Our grateful thanks to Mr. Stone, our timekeeper, who will be retiring after this meeting after many years with us. One of the Motor Cycling World's real Gentlemen.

Our grateful thanks to the club's Dr. Wray and the Theale St. Johns Ambulance Brigade for taking great care of us all. To landowners Miss Marjorie and Miss Sheila Waddell and the Farmers Hary and Tommy Lurcom, to those from other clubs who marshal, to the riders and most of all you the public who have kept the Mortimer Club at the top so that you today have the unique pleasure of watching three new crowns to be won.
