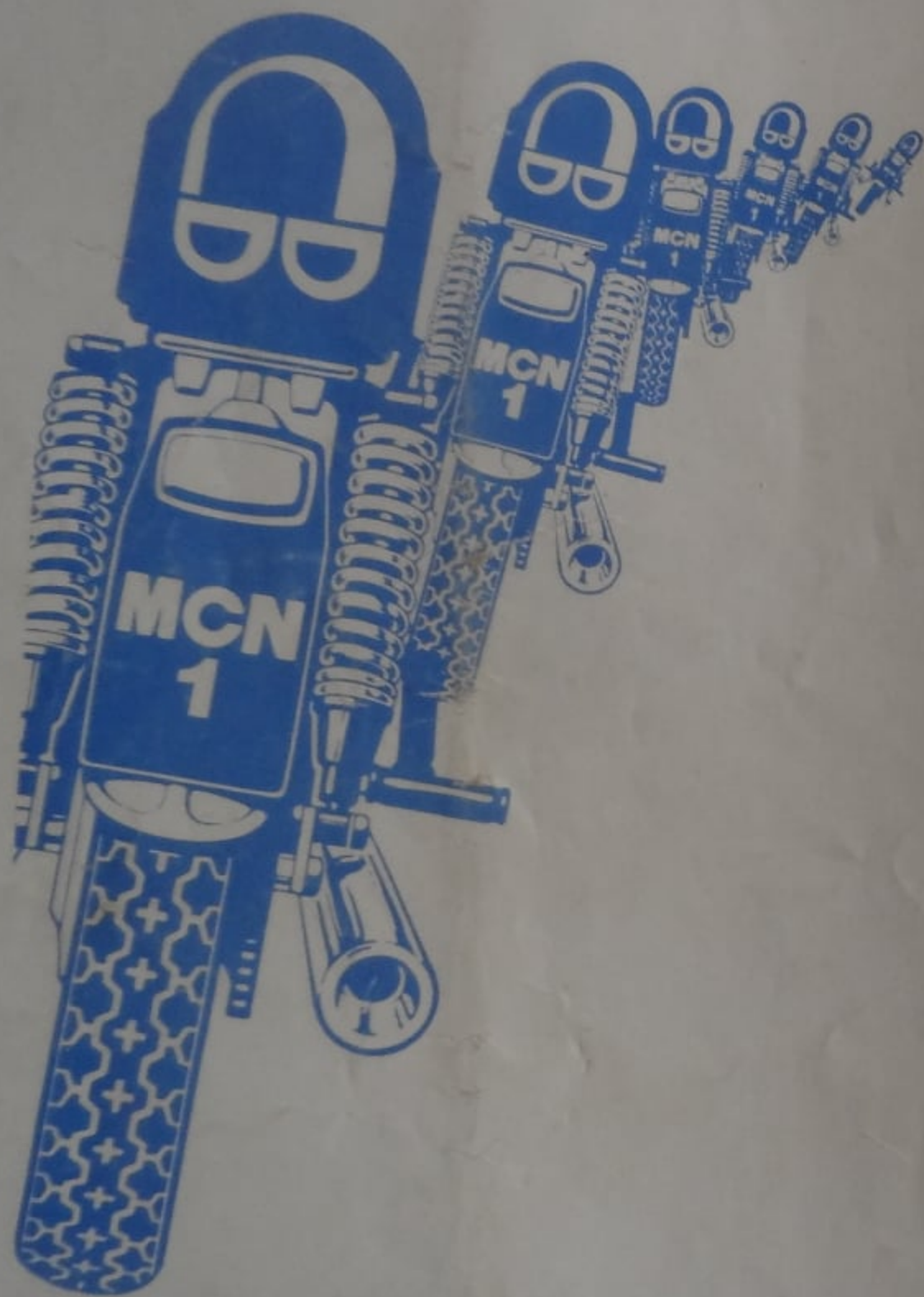

### NORTHUMBRIA MOTO-CROSS CHAMPIONSHIPS

This years event looks like being a carve up between Jimmy Aird (400 K.T.M.) from Barnard Castle and Ian Charlton (360 Bultaco) from Tow Law, they should provide a real battle for the Big Shield, won previously by BOB WRIGHT and ANDY ROBERTON.

We do hope you like the New Circuit which is layed out French Style so that the spectators can get a good look at all the action. Its design should provide closer racing with the fast straights followed by tight turns giving the riders every opportunity to show their skills.

### MOST EXCITING RIDERS

£5 each has been donated by Quinns of Gateshead and Scooter Services of Chester-le-St. This will be awarded to the most spectacular solo and sidecar riders respectively, not necessarily the fastest. Points are awarded for wheelies, falling off, performing somersaults etc. Results will be announced after race 9.

### MOTO CROSS

In all Moto Cross events, drivers score points equal to their positions at the finish of each leg, 1 for 1st, 2 for 2nd, 12 for 12th etc. Riders must complete 3 laps to be classified in a leg. The driver with the least number of points after three legs will be considered the winner. In the event of a tie, the positions in the final leg will act as a tie-breaker
