## PEGASUS MOTOR CYCLE & LIGHT CAR CLUB

The Pegasus MC & LCC was founded in 1945 by a group of dedicated despatch riders and enthusiasts. In those days they organised trials scrambles and grass tracks, the great Brian Stonebridge was a regular contender at the scrambles and in later years Jeff Smith and the works BSA. Then came the decline of scrambling and the Club promoted Road Races at Cadwell and Fulbeck to fill the gap, and since those days in the late sixties, has not looked back.

To the Future: The Club promote reliability trial and are expanding this to cover sidecars. On the Road Race scene, the Cadwell events are very successful and it is hoped to obtain dates at an additional venue in 1980. Finally, our greatest aim is to bring top class solo & sidecar Motor Cross to the East Midlands on this very fine course here at Belton.

Ironically this link with Belton has roots back in 1945. The Club was formed in the British M.A.R.Co. wartime factory under the Presidency and guidance of Denis Kendal, the Managing Director, who now resides in Beverly Hills, USA. The Board Chairman at that time was the late Lord Brownlow.

## FORWARD BY ALEX HODGKINSON

### Motor Cross Co-ordinator for Trials and MotoCross News

In America they say "There ain't nothing like the mile". In Europe there is nothing more spectacular than top class sidecar-cross.

The sight of twenty crews thundering (two-strokes are rare in sidecar-cross) towards the first corner can set the strongest heart quivering. No wonder the French and German crowds rate the sport on level terms with, if not higher than, the solos.

Yet in this country the sport has never had the same esteem despite the fact that all the top crews use British Wasp and Hagon frames, most use Norton and Weslake engines and British crews have always figured prominently in the European Championship.

Many top organisers have shied away from promoting sidecar-cross but there has always been a nucleus of hardened fanatics who believe that motocross comprises both solos and the chairs. The Newbury club ran them together successfully for many years and a survey of spectators showed that most of their large crowds actually preferred the chairs.

Today's course is ideal for sidecar-cross. Fast open undulating grassland and sand gives the riders the chance to show their daring skills to the full and a tremendous day's racing is in prospect.

Certain to be right in the thick of the battle for supremacy are reigning champions Nick Thompson and Gary Withers on the Ken Heanes Norton Wasp. Nick has been there or thereabouts in both British and European championships throughout the seventies and Gary has been his partner since mid-1976.

1977 champion John Elliott had a disappointing season last year, being dogged by injury, but has already shown his determination to reclaim the title in early season meetings with new passenger Paul Mossman and a one-off lightweight Nourish Weslake Wasp.

Thompson and Withers were challenged all the way last year by Doug Fox and John Cooper who also won the 1978 Swiss Grand Prix on their Norton Wasp and have already shown great form on the continent this year.

Top men on British soil so far this season have been Terry Good and Jess Rixon, the 1976

British champions, whose Norton Wasp is sponsored by Biggles, a Reading discotheque.

Veteran Mike Holloway showed he is still a star in the mud by winning at Frome last year and John Turner, now passengered by Mike Ripper, has the consistency to figure in the title chase.

Less consistent are the "wild men of the north" Kim and Peter Logan; their problem has always been getting to the finish in one piece.

Very many men to watch this year are eighteen year olds Colin Philpott and Dean Ray and last year's stars of the of the support class (in their first season of sidecar-cross) Geoff Stokes and Graham Martin.

Sit back and enjoy a great day's sport but be warned. The excitement will be too great for you to relax.

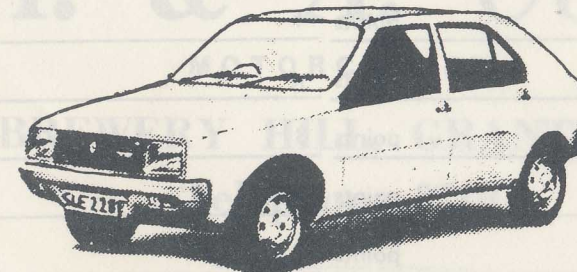
