

#### **HAWSTONE 2000**

Last Sunday's 125 IMBA International proved successful despite a few problems, mainly the weather, which on Saturday was bad with the famous hill impossible to walk up and the descent practically impossible. So the decision was taken to cut the hill out. After the rain on Saturday night the weather dried and even the sun came out during Sunday.

#### BELGIUMS BAN

Last Thursday (June 1<sup>st</sup>) the Belgium rider Danny De Baets who held second place in the Championship was banned following incidents at a motocross meeting which involved the Championship leader Jimmy Verburgh. He was told he could not ride again this year by the Belgium Federation BLM. He arrived at Hawkstone and did not attempt to ride but caused panic in the Belgium camp as they wondered why he had come.

Despite several worries the racing passed off without any further incidents.

#### DAVIES CHOKED

After a good first race local favourite Gary Davies tried to improve the performance of the bike for the second race with disastrous results which saw him slower and just managed to finish 9<sup>th</sup> which made it impossible for him to gain an overall win. With everything back in place on the bike he showed his true form in the 3<sup>rd</sup> leg to take second spot and 3<sup>rd</sup> overall behind the two Belgium's Glen Dempsey and Jimmy Verburgh.

#### WHY HAWKSTONE?

Several comments were expressed about the choice of the Hawkstone circuit for the 125's British IMBA round due to the sandy nature of the course being popular with the Belgium's and Dutch riders. Gary Davies, who is in the leading AMCA rider in the Championship lives locally and has ridden the circuit many times, so hopefully more people would come to watch him. North Shropshire club did not apply and only ran it with help from outside the club. No other club except Bridgnorth applied for an International and they ran the sidecars in April.

#### 250/750's

Both the 250's and 750's rode Hawkstone for the 3<sup>rd</sup> round of the AMCA Championship with James Cumber winning two of the races and a 2<sup>nd</sup> place behind Richard Du'Feu gave him the overall result with Yorkshires Danny Blakeley taking 3<sup>rd</sup> with three, 3<sup>rd</sup> places. Richard Du'Feu leads with 171, 2<sup>nd</sup> James Cumber 146 and 3<sup>rd</sup> Chris Jones from Gloucester.

Gary Parker from Preston won the 750's at Hawkstone without winning a race. Simon Gower won 2 but chain problems stopped him in the opening race, but he still took second overall with Christian Payne 3<sup>rd</sup>. Farker leads on 142 from Barry Holley on 134 and Simon Gower 132.

#### SIDECAR

The 'Open' Championship round due to be run on July 23<sup>rd</sup> at Shobdon cannot be a Champior ship as several riders will not be available.




