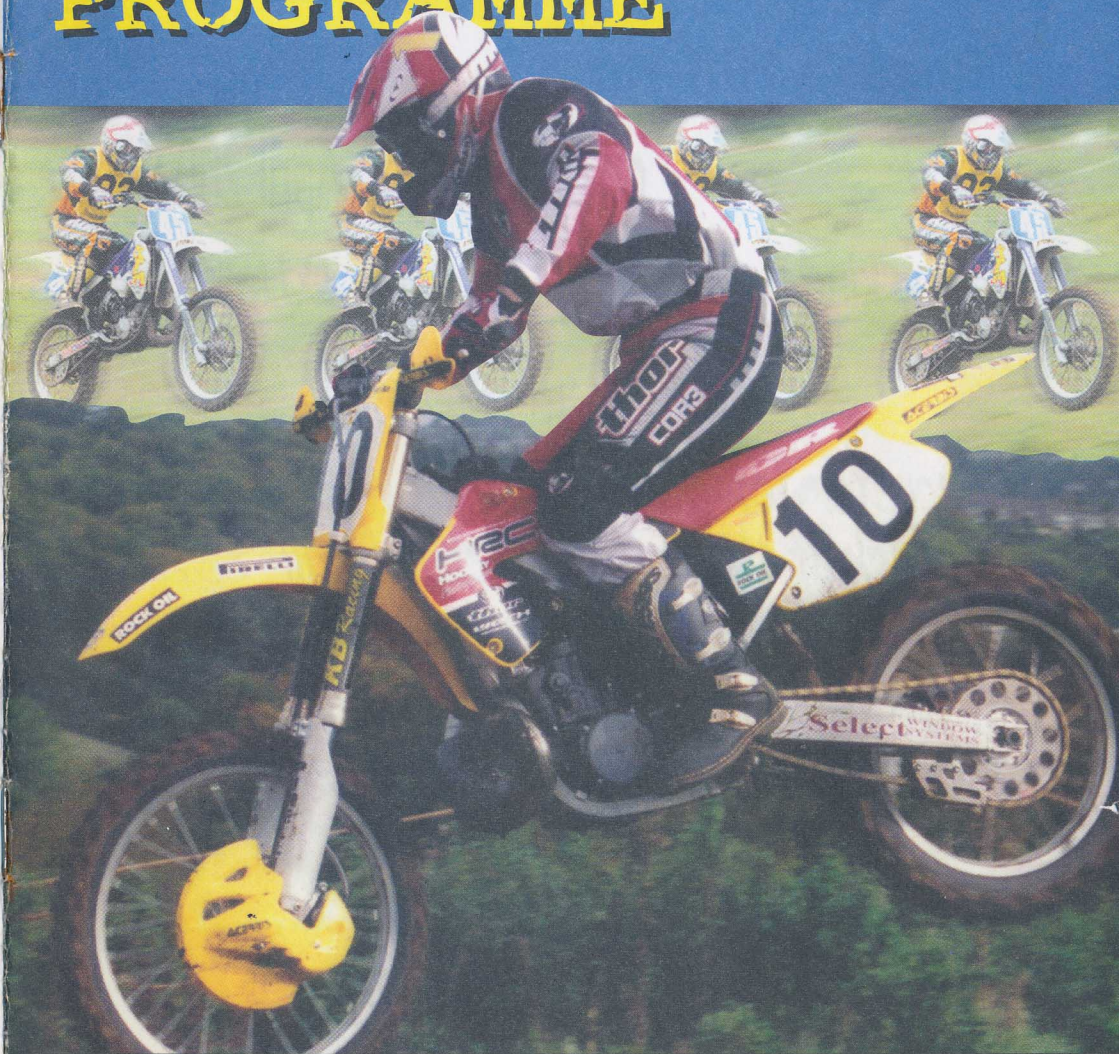

# AMCA NEWS

W/C 8<sup>TH</sup> APRIL 2002

**REVISED CHAMPIONSHIP DATES** - Several changes have had to be made to the Moto Cross Championships announced last week and these include the 4 Strokes now having the 1<sup>st</sup> round on May 26<sup>th</sup> at Shobdon, the original 1<sup>st</sup> round on April 21<sup>st</sup> is to soon and the Bridgnorth event due on the 2<sup>nd</sup> June is not being run. The Gloucester club is unable to include the 125 round on June 23<sup>rd</sup> so its being offered to the Polesworth club on the same day. When ever possible the dates as listed below will be kept to even though some venues may change, this is to help riders planning holidays etc.

**125s** are May 5<sup>th</sup>, May 19<sup>th</sup>, June 23<sup>rd</sup>, July 28<sup>th</sup>, August 18<sup>th</sup> and September 29<sup>th</sup>.

**250's** May 5<sup>th</sup>, May 26<sup>th</sup>, July 14<sup>th</sup>, August 4<sup>th</sup>, September 1<sup>st</sup>, September 29<sup>th</sup>.

**Open (750's)** May 5<sup>th</sup>, May 12<sup>th</sup>, July 14<sup>th</sup>, August 4<sup>th</sup>, Sept 1<sup>st</sup>, Sept 29<sup>th</sup>.

**4 Strokes** May 26<sup>th</sup>, June 16<sup>th</sup>, June 30<sup>th</sup>, July 21<sup>st</sup>, Aug 11<sup>th</sup>, Sept 8<sup>th</sup>, 22<sup>nd</sup> Oct 13<sup>th</sup>.

**Sidecars** April 28<sup>th</sup>, May 12<sup>th</sup>, June 3<sup>rd</sup>, June 9<sup>th</sup>, July 7<sup>th</sup>, July 21<sup>st</sup>, July 28<sup>th</sup> Sept 8<sup>th</sup>.

**Fixture Changes.** - Several changes with Stockport cancelling both the events due on May 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>, the new Mold club hope to run on the Monday 6<sup>th</sup> for the West Pennine group, the York club are running an additional event on April 28<sup>th</sup> and also Ross Falcons have an event that day for the Wessex group. Problems seem to be arising with several events due on the Jubilee Bank holiday, June 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>. These are mainly due to difficulties with obtaining 1<sup>st</sup> Aid cover. Warley club have cancelled the Moto Cross on May 26<sup>th</sup> but the Shobdon club have stepped in to take the date but need help if they are to run the following weekend on June 2<sup>nd</sup> as they have several sidecars who will be going to the Pennine meeting the same day. The Dursley club cannot confirm that they have 1<sup>st</sup> Aid for June 3<sup>rd</sup> at Nympsfield and may run on August Bank Holiday Monday 26<sup>th</sup> if they have to cancel the June date.

**Revival in Yorkshire.** A recent meeting of the Yorkshire clubs voted to organise more events as they are having problems fitting into other groups due to the heavy demand from riders in those groups. Last weekend over 50 riders from the Yorkshire clubs travelled down to the Walsall club's event at Aldridge as the meeting in Coalville was full, again this weekend the Ollerton club in Trent Valley group are refusing out of group riders so the lads from Yorkshire without a home event will have to travel to the Rugby meeting at Long Bucky for a ride and there could be over 80 of them willing to do it. The Yorkshire group are arranging more home group events making a total of 21 events this year, anyone able to help on the day would be most welcome at these meetings. The 7 clubs in the group have already signed up 150 riders this year which is as many as they had all last year, the York club alone has over 40 riders.

**AMCA LICENCES THE HIGHEST FOR 8 YEARS.** Over 2250 MOTO CROSS Licences have been issued up to the end of last week which for the same time over previous years is the highest for 8 years, its over 600 up on last year which may have been affected by the 'foot and mouth' but is still over 448 higher than at the same time in 2000. Licences are still continuing to arrive at the AMCA Office and several clubs are requesting more licence forms, whilst the clubs are trying to arrange more events to satisfy demand.

Recently the AMCA have spent a considerable amount of money on advertising for members, clubs need help to find better tracks which again will attract more riders and what other organisation is trying to run more events to cater for the increase in demand. Over 500 off road events are scheduled for this year under the AMCA banner including around 300 Moto Cross events. If anybody wants to advertise in the programmes to reach these riders, they all receive a free programme at each event then contact the AMCA office. Any other offers of help for the clubs would be welcome, remember there are not enough promoters to run sufficient events for the number of riders in this country so it may be old fashioned but the clubs are the people organising the meetings, no good having World Champions etc, if there are no customers buying the bikes, spares clothing etc. Maybe next week we'll list those firms who are supporting the AMCA and perhaps those who are not, and maybe those who say they will but don't pay.
