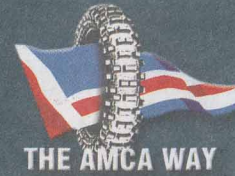

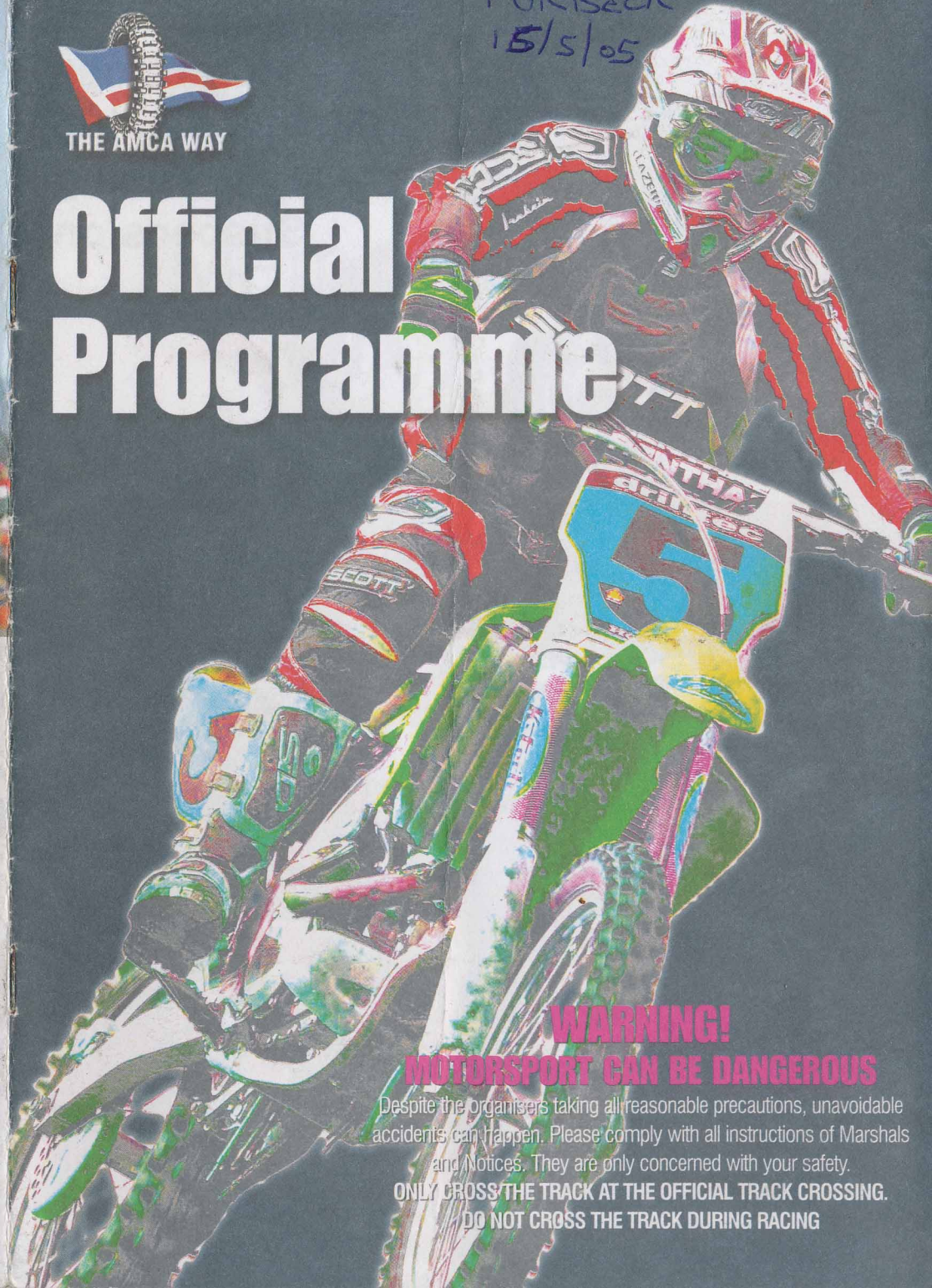

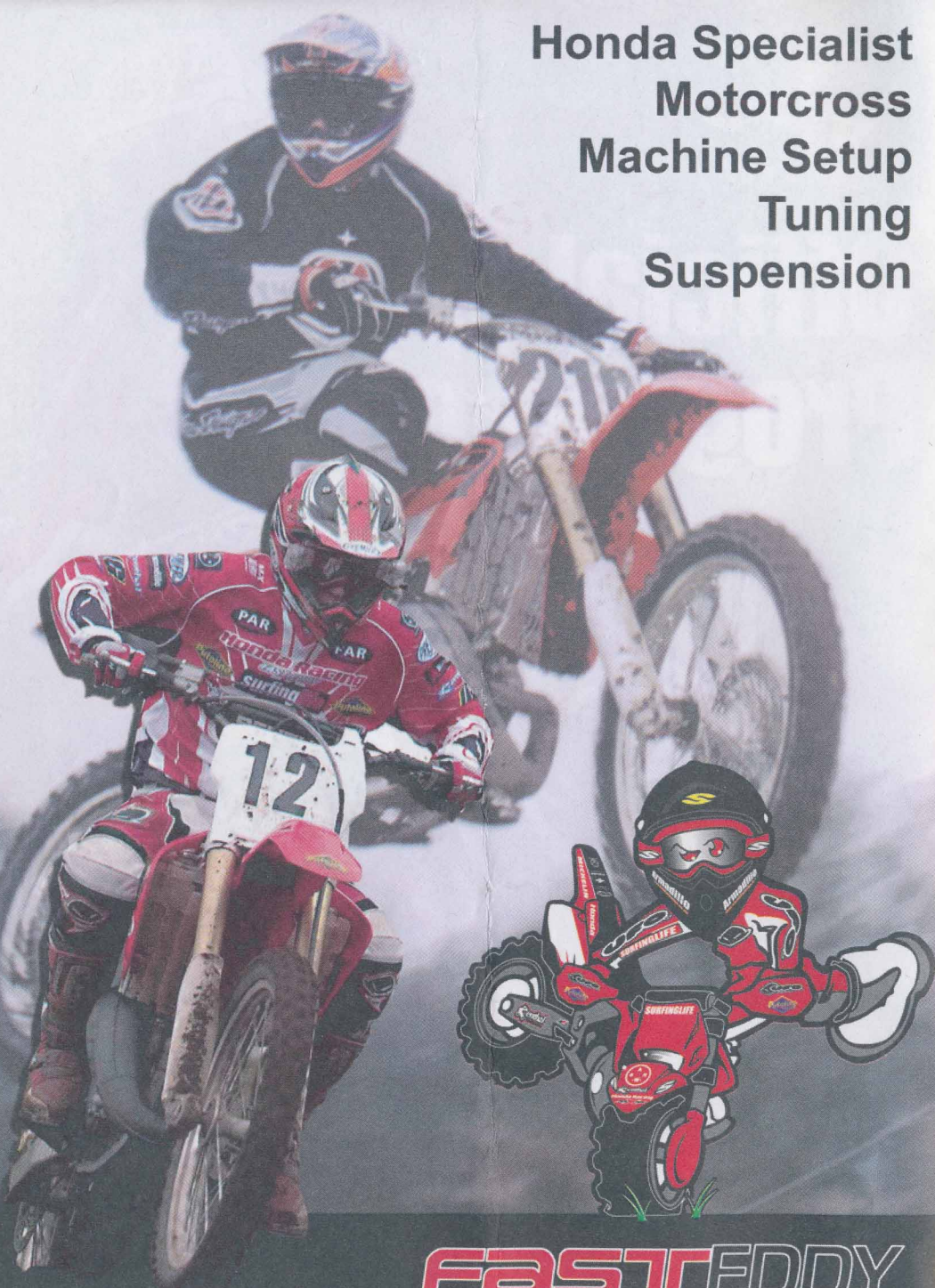

Tommy Shedwick

I am sorry to report the death of Tommy Shedwick of the Ashton Vale Club who died last week after a short illness. Tommy was a stalwart of both his club and the AMCA during the 80's and 90's and supported his son Martyn, who rode in the first scramble, which the club ran on the 24th May 1981 finishing fourth in the Juniors at the Brown Cow circuit near Scammonden.

Tommy acted as Chief Marshal in the early days when the club was running three or four meetings per year and then took over as Clerk of the Course. Behind the scenes he was also the Club Chairman from 1983 before taking over as Club Secretary in 1986. He spent a lot of time at the clubs track and was also helping the AMCA's Greater Manchester Group, which involved attending Committee Meetings at the AMCA offices. Tommy was typical of the people at that time who were a great help to the AMCA and he himself always assisted us to organise events at the old Brownhills circuit and was without a doubt one of the major players behind the success of the Association at this time when they were running up to 20 events per week during the Season. "A true AMCA Clubman".

Tommy was 65 years of age and retired last November, he was diagnosed with cancer in the New Year.

All at the AMCA send their deepest sympathies to Tommy's wife Hazel, son Martyn and his wife Tricia. The funeral was held at 10.15am on Thursday the 12th May at Overdale Crematorium, Bolton.

AMCA Donate £10,000 to LARA

The AMCA have already donated £10,000 to the LARA fighting fund in view of the recent DEFRA rulings, which is having some effect on the availability of land for the sport.

The Lincoln AJS Club who run Classic Trials have lost five of their venues in the last few days and other clubs are reporting similar problems. The LARA fighting fund is to help offset the legal costs involved in taking DEFRA to court to get the ruling, which they have made, over turned and the AMCA was the first to make such a contribution several weeks ago.

The Clee Hill Club have lost the use of their circuit at The Llan, near Craven Arms due to the DEFRA ruling but they are hoping to borrow another circuit for their two remaining fixtures this year.

The Matchams event on the 12th June requires an extra £3 entry fee. There is a charge for camping of £5 per day and the gates will close at 10pm. No inters will be allowed. No dogs.

Freedom of Choice - 15th May 2005

This is the first week we have implemented the freedom of choice. Unfortunately, two of the groups were unable to hold an event, so we were restricted on venues. However, we are pleased to report that the majority of riders were entered into their first choice, the remainder being entered into their second choice. Unfortunately, a very small percentage have been sent their money back; however considering we did not have a full choice of venues we have accommodated 2047 riders.

Overall we feel that this has been successful and we hope to continue this system in the future.

Bradford and Morgan win in Germany

Congratulations to AMCA Sidecar crew Simon Bradford of the Shobdon Club and Simon Morgan on a stunning win at the first round of the Sidecar IMBA European Championship, which was held at Kleinbau in Germany. The pair dominated proceeding taking three wins from three starts.

Outfits from five countries competed with Dutch riders taking 2nd and 3rd places. Mark Banks and Peter Girling of Midland Social finished 8th overall after finishing 5th in the 2nd race. Nic Davies and Jason Davies from Teme Valley Club took 17th spot after finishing 15th in the 1st race. John Grahame and Scott Grahame, also from Midland Social finished 24th.

This was the best result by an AMCA Sidecar Team for over 30 years and with 4 more rounds to be held including the 'home' event on the 11th September at Boraston.
