The machines you will see racing are the types raced during the Golden Age of Motorcycle Scrambling during the 1950 and 60s, over the type of open wide and fast tracks we are using this afternoon. The machines were basically road bikes converted by riders and mechanics to cope with the rough and tumble of scrambling, and the crowds flocked to watch the action. Some of the riders this afternoon were competing in the Golden Age and they have been joined by new converts to the sport making one of the fastest growing motorcycle sports in Europe. After the interval the races will be arranged into groups depicting the the age of the riders, each group will have one race each. During the second short interval some of the past masters of Scrambling will be introduced and we will attempt to get them to do a circuit of the track. Immediately after the second interval the fastest 30 riders on pre -1967 machines will race it out for the Devon Classic Grand National. Finally we will round the meeting off with two allcomers races. (These two races may be run as one

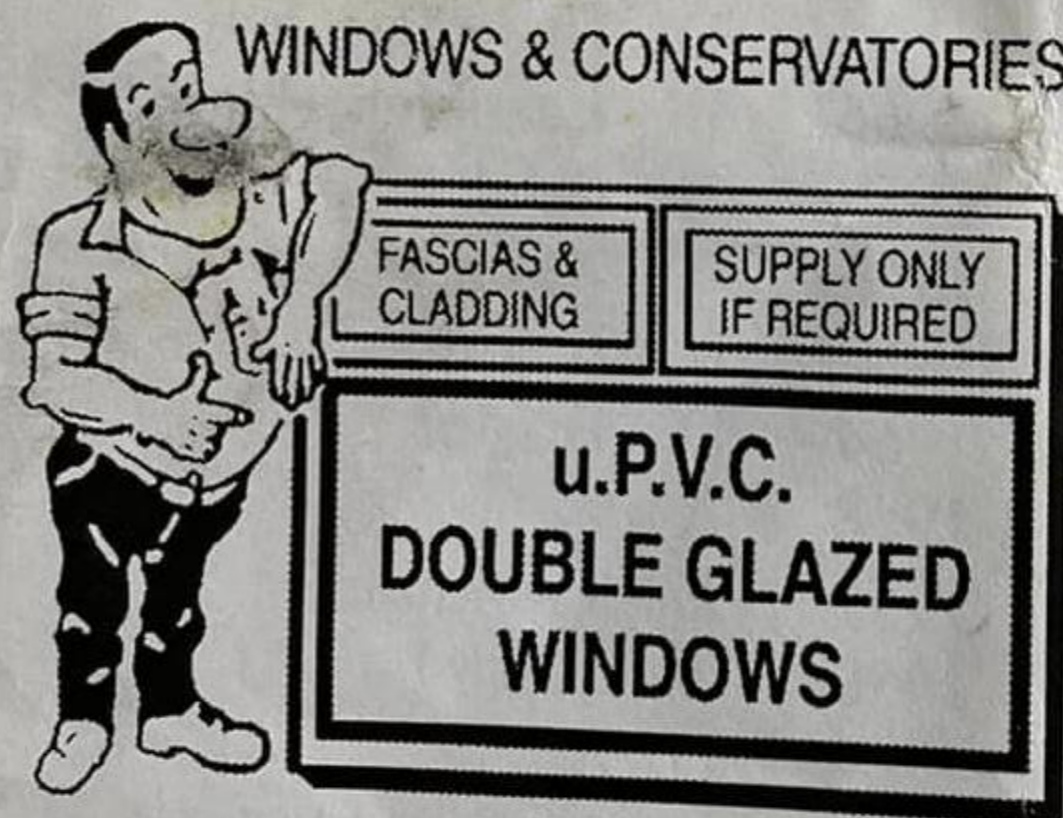

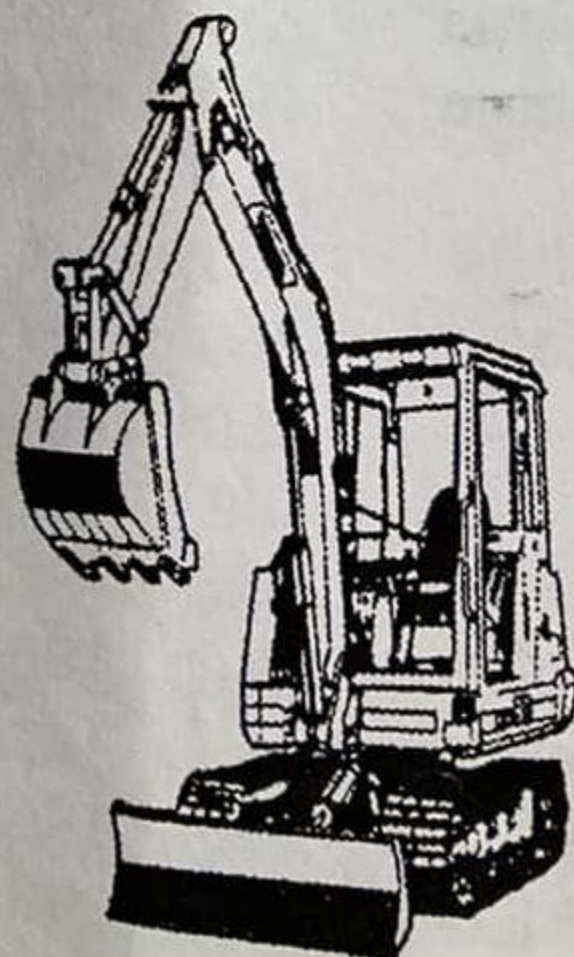

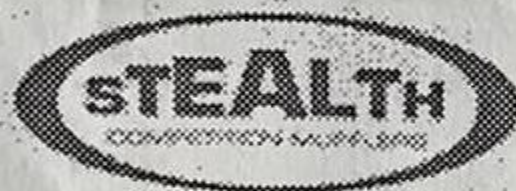
