

Flag signals

Clerk of the Course or his deputy and displayed only at

Yellow plus yellow with red stripes held crossed These two flags shown crossed diagonally and held aloft, indicate the race has been stopped and is

Yellow (waved): Great danger in section of track ahead slow down, proceed with caution.

Yellow (motionless): Danger in section of track ahead take care, no overtaking, maintain positions until clear

of section displaying yellow flag. Green: Course clear. Used on marshals' posts to indicate their position to riders on first lan of all practice sessions. Also shown immediately after the post where a yellow flag has been shown to indicate circuit now clear ahead.

Black: Accompanied by riders number on separate

board. That rider to stop in pits next time round. Always shown at start/finish line on special instructions from

Clerk of the Course. Yellow with red stripes: Oil flag. Displayed when oil has been dropped on the circuit in that section, displayed until the hazard has been dealt with. Also

denotes slippery surface ahead. White: Ambulance or course car on circuit

Yellow with black cross: Denotes start of last lap. Black/white chequered: Denotes finish of race, usually waved at the winner and held motionless until every other rider has passed.

NB: Races at all MCD circuits are started using a

system of red and green lights

This is just the sort of challenge to bring the best out of TT record man Joey Dunlop who will line up for Heat two on the semiworks supported Honda RS500.

Tough opposition can be expected from the still sadly under-financed - it seems -West Countryman Chris Guy who has sunk everything into a GP specification Honda in a "make or bust" bid. Naturally the £101,000 Grand Slam would not go amiss for the young privateer and in any case Chris ought to be among the individual £2,000 pay-out for each round of the Transnational.

Heron Suzuki teamster Rob McElnea has established himself strongly since being snapped up by headquarters to replace Roger Marshall. McElnea has managed to grapple past Marshall in two British Formula 1 rounds so far this season but has had to settle for runner-up spot to Aussie ace Wayne Gardner.

Former Honda 125 Champion Ray Swann, plus James Wells add further strength on their mighty four strokes, while top ranking privateer Trevor Nation and Norfolk rider Andy Bond cannot be discounted.

Kenny Irons won a hard fought Pro-Am round and will be hoping to switch to his slick-shod full race Yamaha with equal success, while Heat two also sees a return to two wheels for Damon Hill, son of former World Motor Racing Champion Graham Hill

Red: Immediate stop by all riders. Only used by the Clerk of the Course or his deputy and displayed only at the start/finish line.

Yellow plus yellow with red stripes held crossed These two flags shown crossed diagonally and held aloft, indicate the race has been stopped and is accompanied by a red flag (see above) at the start/finish

Yellow (waved): Great danger in section of track ahead: slow down, proceed with caution. Yellow (motionless): Danger in section of track ahead:

take care, no overtaking, maintain positions until clea of section displaying yellow flag.

Green: Course clear. Used on marshals' posts to indicate their position to riders on first lap of all practice sessions. Also shown immediately after the post where a yellow flag has been shown to indicate circuit now

Black: Accompanied by riders number on separatboard. That rider to stop in pits next time round. Always shown at start/finish line on special instructions from Clerk of the Course.

Yellow with red stripes: Oil flag. Displayed when oil has been dropped on the circuit in that section, displayed until the hazard has been dealt with. Also denotes slippery surface ahead.

White: Ambulance or course car on circuit

Yellow with black cross: Denotes start of last lap. Black/white chequered: Denotes finish of race, usually waved at the winner and held motionless until every other rider has passed.

NR: Races at all MCD circuits are started using . system of red and green lights.
