



children for over £9 normal value.

You can also purchase, at a guinea less than the public rates, low-cost car race spectator season brooches for yourself, one other male, and up to four ladies and children, at one or all of the three circuits involved. A Background to Karting . . .

IN the autumn of 1959, a small classified advertisement appeared in one of the motoring magazines to the effect that a demonstration of karting would be taking place at Brands Hatch. The man behind this move was Albert Zains, manufacturer of the Azum kart, and he invited all and sundry to come and see what this new sport was all about. For some reason the idea of the demonstration appealed and thousands of eager spectators poured into the circuit to watch a selection of the very first British karts putt-putt their way around a simple straw-baled circuit in front of the Grandstand.

Amongst the crowd were many who were so enthusiastic about the potential of karting that they have remained with it ever since and can be numbered as some of the mainstays of the sport.

Over the next six years karting steadily grew in Britain until the stage has now been reached where those original class 1 motors developing a wheezy 2½ h.p. now give 15 h.p. and the class IV motors have climbed from 10 h.p. to 28 h.p. As the total weight of the kart is now also about 10% less than in 1959 one can see that any connection between karting then and now is solely that at first appearance the two machines have the same basic layout. Such enormous increases in power output have made karting a genuine part of motor racing and developed the early rather primitive equipment into sophisticated machinery.

Faster speeds have encouraged the use of wider and longer tracks

until eventually the inevitable happened - somebody tried a kart on a full size motor racing circuit. No longer being limited to a 100 yard straight imposed problems on gearing, wheel balance, port timing, engine cooling, ignition advance, exhaust length tuning and many other items but soon all were overcome and the joy of big-circuit racing was discovered. Brands Hatch is obviously an ideal circuit for karts because there is still plenty of challenge from the tighter corners, variety from camber and gradient changes and because of the splendid setting offering such a fabulous view.

With either a 100 c.c. or 200 c.c. tiny two-stroke engine running on pump petrol, the karts you will see today will be reaching speeds of around 100 m.p.h. and lapping in times that would make race fans of '50s go apoplectic. Their cost is just a mere fraction of a similarly performing car and they have the advantage that kitchen table maintenance is perfectly practicable. The charge is sometimes levelled that the price of a new racing kart at about £170 is too expensive but it must be realised that because of the thousands that compete in the sport, there is a large source of good secondhand machinery which is perfectly raceworthy at a reasonable cost.

Karting brings those of you who daydream in the Grandstands a chance to fulfil that long felt desire to go motor racing — come and join us!






