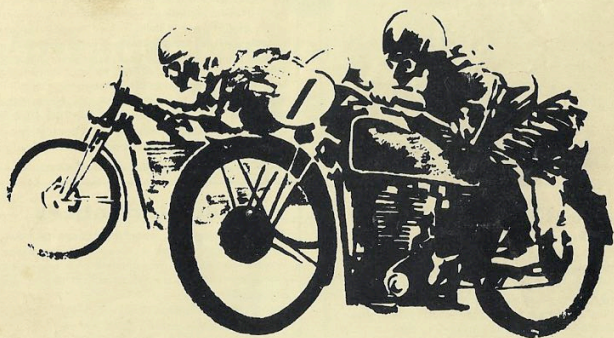

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Motor racing is dangerous and persons attending the meeting do so at their own risk.

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Flag signals

Yellow flag: Danger ahead; drivers must slow down and not overtake. When waved, signifies greater danger; drivers must be prepared to stop.

Yellow & red flag: Oil on course. When waved, signifies oil slick is particularly hazardous.

Green flag: Danger area passed; drivers may overtake.

Black flag: Instructs driver whose competition number is shown alongside to call at his pit at the end of the lap.

Black flag with orange spot: Indicates to driver whose competition number is shown alongside that there is a mechanical defect with his car. He must visit his pit.

Black & white diagonal flag: Last warning to driver whose competition number is shown alongside that, for reasons of unsportsmanlike behaviour, he will be 'black flagged' for further similar behaviour.

Blue flag: Warns driver that he is being followed closely. When waved, indicates that driver behind is trying to overtake.

White flag: Service vehicle on course.

Red flag: Used only under instructions from the Clerk of the Course. Warns all drivers to slow down, be prepared to stop, and make their way back to the pits or the startline at reduced speed. Simultaneously, black flags will be shown at all marshals' posts around the circuit.

Chequered flag: End of race.

NB: Races at all MCD circuits are started using a system of red & green 'traffic lights'.

Spectator notices

Please do not leave litter about the grounds—take it with you. Remember to drive with care and caution when leaving the grounds. To safeguard both competitors and public—animals are not admitted. This is most important.

Prohibited Area Notices: The public are not permitted in the areas where these notices are displayed. The fences are there for protection, and any person or persons found trespassing, or wilfully damaging trees, fences, etc., will be prosecuted by Brands Hatch Circuit Limited.

The promoters reserve the right without notice to make any alteration in the race programme.

Police Enquiry Office

The above is situated at the rear of the Main Grandstand building and is signposted Police Enquiries. All enquiries relating to property lost or found, children lost or found wandering, theft from cars or other signs of tampering, emergency messages for spectators and other serious problems relating to persons or property should be directed to this office. This applies only to major meetings.

May we ask spectators, officials and competitors to approach and leave the circuit by way of the A20, M25 and not drive through Fawkham village whenever possible. Thank you for your co-operation.

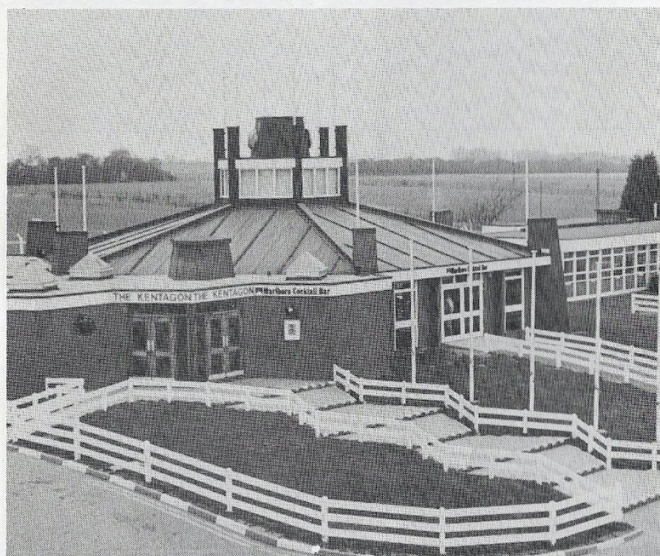

THE TAIL-ENDERS

What an honour to do the introduction to a Brands programme! Why me; I'm not famous. Simple really, all the stars were busy working on their machines.

Who is he, anyway—I hear he's not even riding.

If I was riding I would be an also-ran; but I'm not riding. I'm deftly waving the spanners over the oldest sidecar outfit in vintage road-racing. That must be some claim, anyway. Actually all I do is kick the tyres to see if they're inflated and look to see if there's any oil in the tank. So reliable, these old bikes.

I first started racing myself in 1971 with a pre-War Ariel Red Hunter and sidecar. I wasn't very good and the outfit wasn't very quick but we had fun. My only claim to fame was that I once got in the results in the weeklies. I finished fifth at Cadwell and there was my name in print! Not very surprising though—there was an entry of only seven, a very different story today with its full grid and list of reserves.

The nice thing about starting vintage racing then was that it wasn't very scientific. Take one good sports bike, take off the lights, silencer and stand then turn the handlebars upside down; comply with a few A.C.U. safety regulations, get some second-hand leathers and you could have a good season's racing. Tuning was not to be encouraged as it might affect the reliability.

After a couple of seasons my wife Celia decided she would like a go at racing, to make the numbers up. Unfortunately for me she didn't have the right mentality at all; she wasn't content with a fast day out to fill the programme. No, she was competitive and wanted to race.

After coming to terms with the ignominy of the situation I decided to concentrate on machinery for her and in 1977 we acquired the 1932 Rudge. Why a Rudge? Simply because it was available (in one of those five-way deals involving very little hard cash—£5, if I remember rightly). Six years later she is still using the same machine though it is now totally uncompetitive. She has been offered later machines to ride but as she says "I like my little Rudge, I've had some good rides and so I'll stick with it."

Having come to terms with the performance of the Rudge, Celia and her passenger Caroline Faiers can now concentrate on the racing at the tail end of the field. The leaders of any race undoubtedly get the interest, but the racing doesn't stop with the place men. As you descend the field small groups of competitors are dicing just as fiercely each with their own private battle, and each group struggling to find a winner. The tail-enders in any vintage race are usually the older machines or the more unusual ones and for a spectator well worth looking at. This seems to be so especially just after a race when quite a few people will come to see the Rudge. People seem to be charmed by the simplicity of the older machines and often impressed with their speed. "Not bad for 50 years old" or "Nice to see these old ones being used".

Which is as it should be; motorcycles are meant to be used especially now. After all in a few years all the fossil fuels will be exhausted so you might as well enjoy motorcycles while you can. Ride them, race them, thrash them, it doesn't matter if they blow up; because when the petrol supply is gone they'll look just as good in a museum with no innards and welded up crankcases.

Motorcycles are meant to be enjoyed, which is what vintage race meetings are all about.

When you look at your next vintage race and marvel at the speed and skill of the leaders, have a look also at the tail-enders; they enjoy themselves just as much. Celia and Caroline still have their target for the race—not to be lapped.

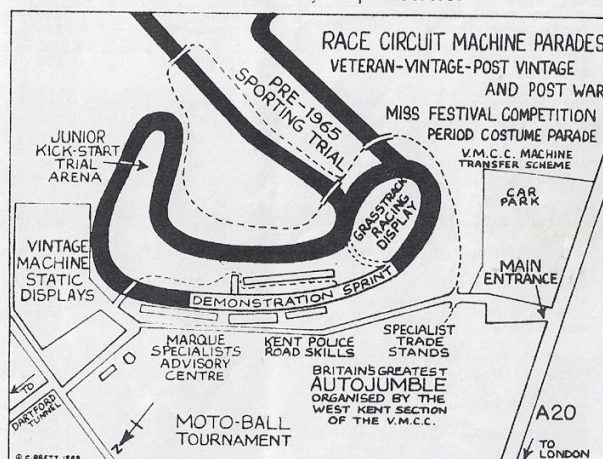

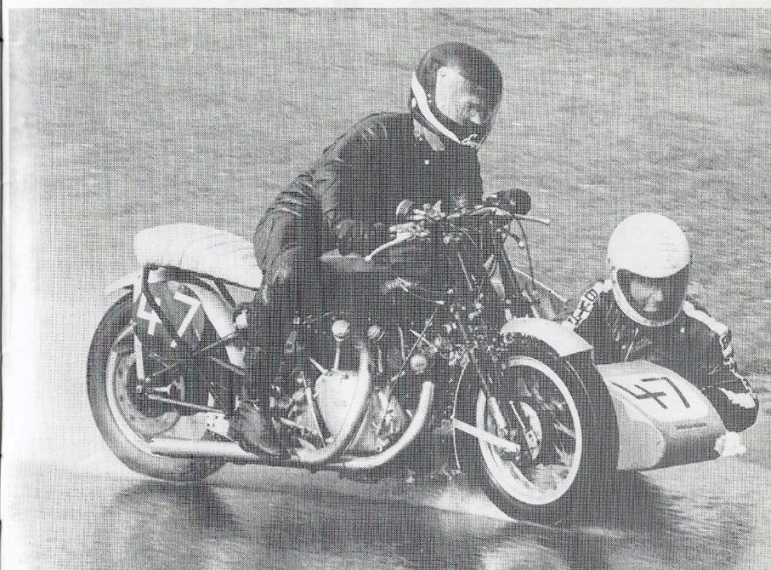

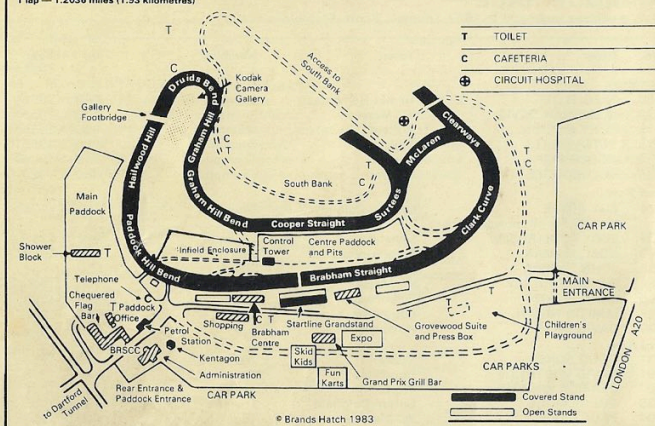
