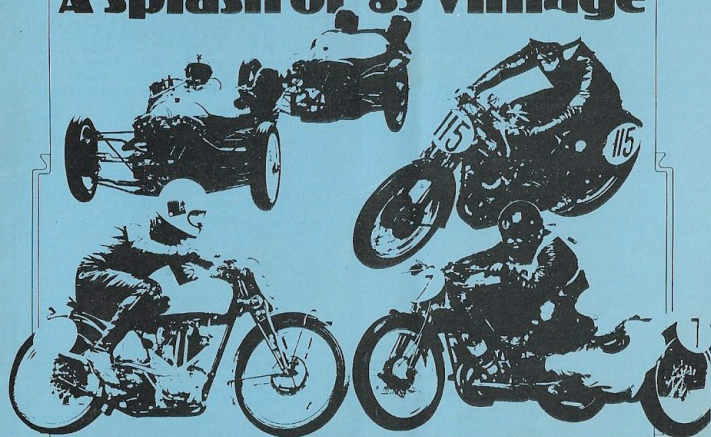

Flag signals

Red: Immediate stop by all riders. Only used by the Clerk of the Course or his deputy and displayed only at the start/finish line.

Yellow plus yellow with red stripes held crossed: These two flags shown crossed diagonally and held aloft, indicate the race has been stopped and is accompanied by a red flag (see above) at the start/finish line.

Yellow (waved): Great danger in section of track ahead; slow down, proceed with caution.

Yellow (motionless): Danger in section of track ahead; take care, no overtaking, maintain positions until clear of section displaying yellow flag.

Green: Course clear. Used on marshals' posts to indicate their position to riders on first lap of all practice sessions. Also shown immediately after the post where a yellow flag has been shown to indicate circuit now clear ahead.

Black: Accompanied by riders number on separate board. That rider to stop in pits next time round. Always shown at start/finish line on special instructions from Clerk of the Course.

Yellow with red stripes: Oil flag. Displayed when oil has been dropped on the circuit in that section, displayed until the hazard has been dealt with. Also denotes slippery surface ahead.

White: Ambulance or course car on circuit.

Yellow with black cross: Denotes start of last lap.

Black/white chequered: Denotes finish of race, usually waved at the winner and held motionless until every other rider has passed.

NB: Races at all MCD circuits are started using a system of red and green lights.

Spectator notices

Please do not leave litter about the grounds - take it with you. Remember to drive with care and caution when leaving the grounds. To safeguard both competitors and public - **animals are not admitted. This is most important.**

Prohibited Area Notices: The public are not permitted in the areas where these notices are displayed. The fences are there for protection, and any person or persons found trespassing, or wilfully damaging trees, fences, etc., will be prosecuted by Brands Hatch Circuit Limited.

The promoters reserve the right without notice to make any alteration in the race programme.

Police Enquiry Office

The above is situated at the rear of the main grandstand building and is signposted 'Police Enquiries'. All enquiries relating to property lost or found, children lost or found wandering, theft from cars or other signs of tampering, emergency messages for spectators and any other serious problems relating to persons or property should be directed to this office. 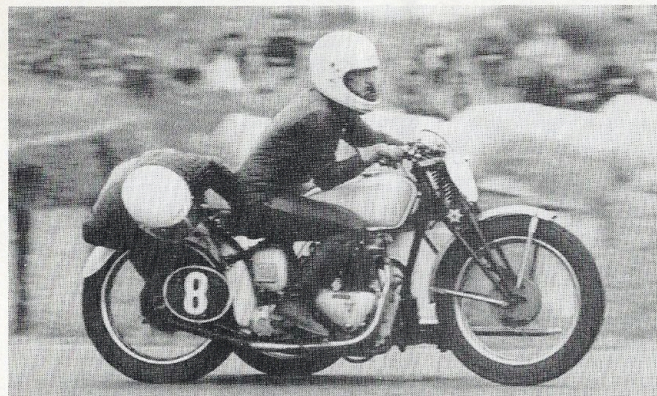
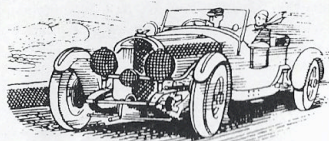

Welcome to another Vintage Brands. It is rather unusual for the Secretary of the Meeting to use this spot in the programme, but as all the likely victims were in the Island for the TT or had done it before, I ran out of ideas. Anyway, as an ex-sidecar racer, I can say that I know the problems both on the track and in the paddock, as well as being inundated as race secretary with minor (and major) hiccups before, during and after the races.

Since retiring from vintage racing, I have been part of the Brands team. It is nice to put a little back into a sport that has given you pleasure and excitement as well as strong friendships with super people.

The job starts in about February and if all the loose ends are tied up by a month after today, it will have been par for the course. This year there are no continental riders so we have increased race laps where possible in place of the Match Races of past events. My aim is always to give everyone as much riding as possible.

The number of new faces on vintage race grids is encouraging and proves that this branch of motorcycle sport is strong and is attracting vintage minded enthusiasts who are keen to try their hand. By Grand Prix standards our old machines are pedestrian but we have a wonderful variety of bikes currently in use and the sounds are to many far more pleasant than the modern universal two stroke. The Vintage Club's founder Titch Allen once said, and I quote: 'It is better to finish last in the most insignificant motorcycle event than to never start'. Vintage races can never be called insignificant when the quality of machinery and riding skills such as are here today are concerned. Couple this with the glamour of Brands Hatch and the sheer professionalism of the Marshals, Timekeepers, Paddock and Race Office staff and Startline Officials, and the result, weather permitting, can only be another Brands Vintage classic.

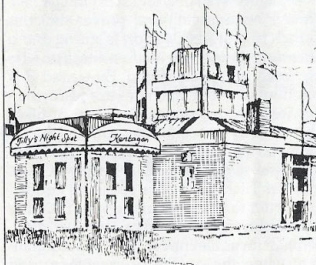

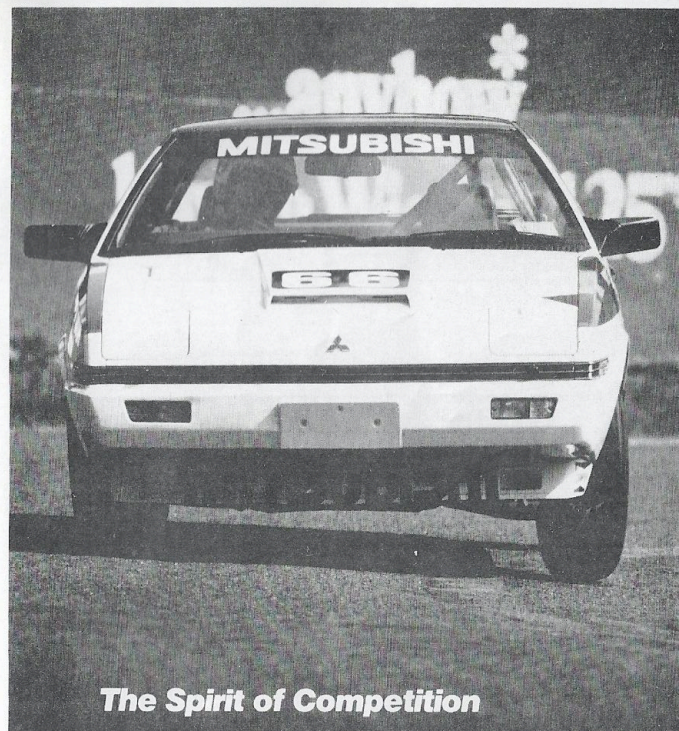

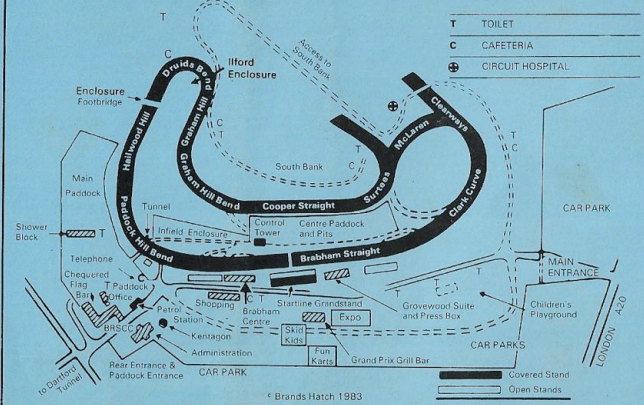
