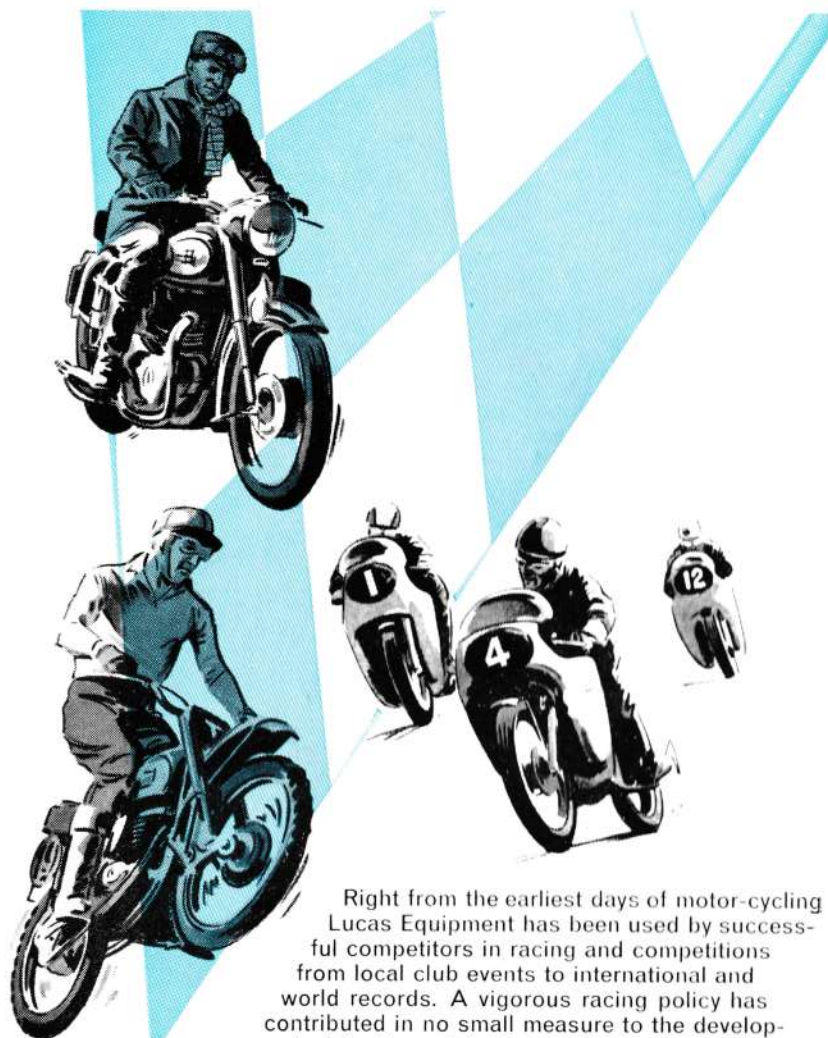

will be awarded to the aggregate winner of the Solo Class for the 1962 season.

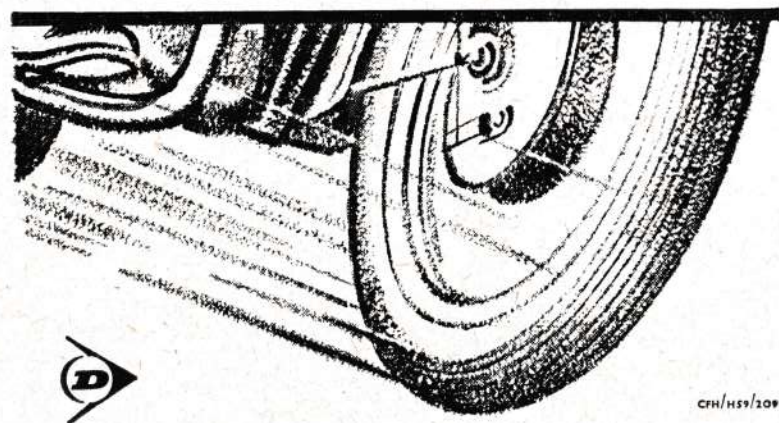

## The BRANDS HATCH Shield Competition

During the 1962 season we shall once again be running the "Brands Hatch Shield Competition."

This Shield is awarded annually to the rider who gains the greatest number of points in any particular class at this Circuit throughout the season.

### The capacity classes eligible are:

1. Solo up to 50 c.c.
2. Solo over 100 c.c. and not over 125 c.c.
3. Solo over 175 c.c. and not over 250 c.c.
4. Solo over 250 c.c. and not over 350 c.c.
5. Solo over 250 c.c. and not over 1000 c.c. (Experts only)
6. Three Wheeler up to 1200 c.c. (Scratch race only)

One of each of these classes will be included at all National meetings run at this circuit this year.

The points to be awarded for the positions in each class at each meeting (International Excepted) are as follows:—

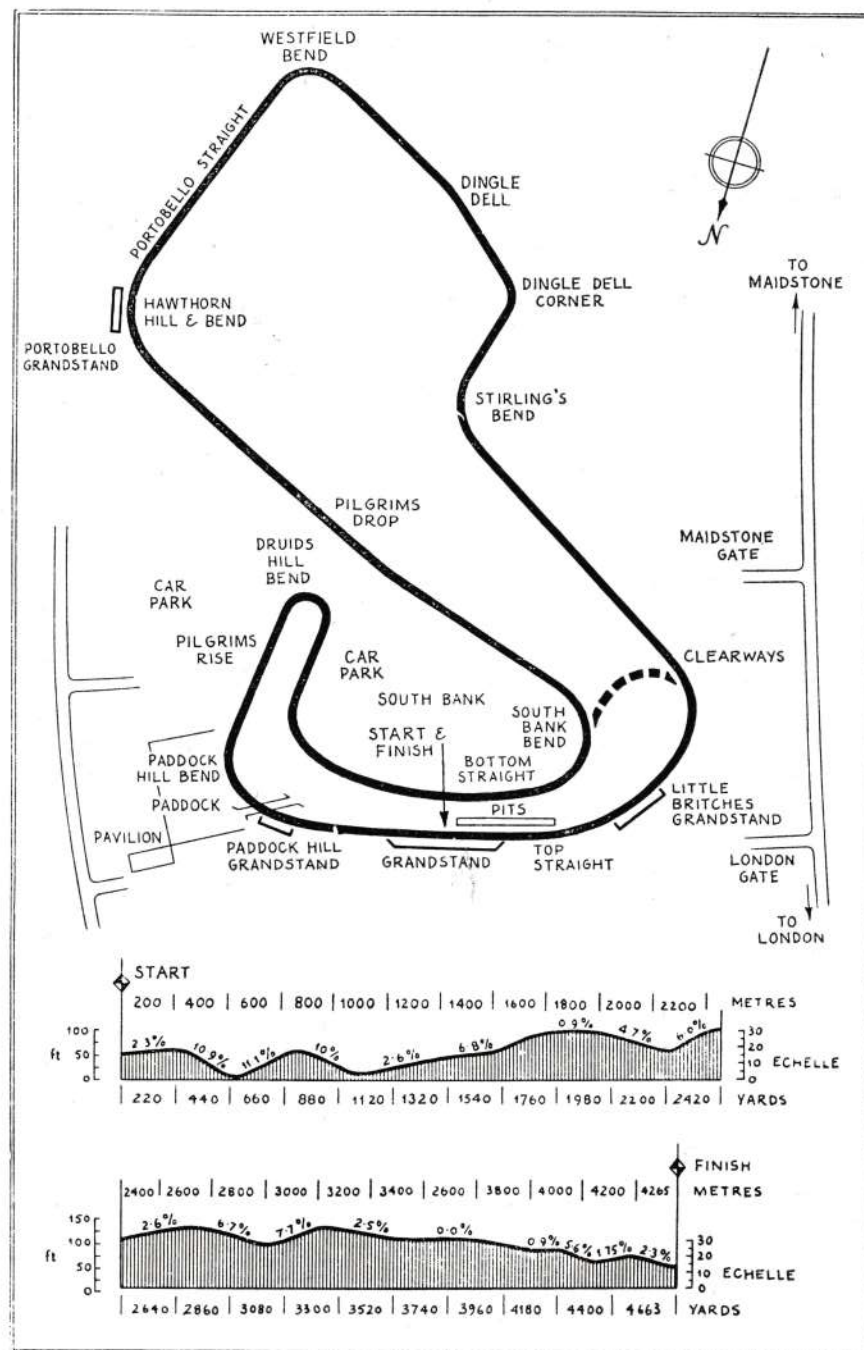
1st—8 points	2nd—6 points	3rd—5 points	4th—4 points
5th—3 points	6th—2 points	7th—1 point	

In addition to the Shield, which is held for 12 months, and a permanent replica for the overall winner of the competition, the owners of the Circuit have generously donated £300 in cash awards to be divided:—

1st—£100	2nd—£75	3rd—£50
4th—£35	5th—£25	6th—£15

Further to these awards there will also be a Trophy for each class winner.

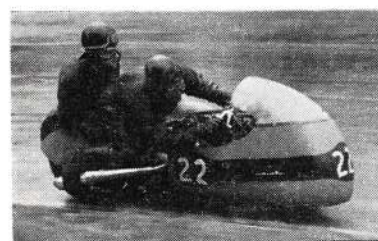

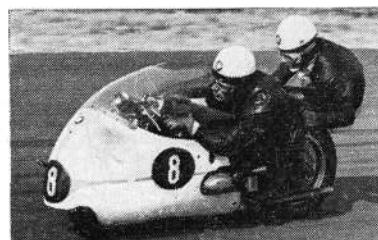
◀ PIP HARRIS

DEREK MINTER

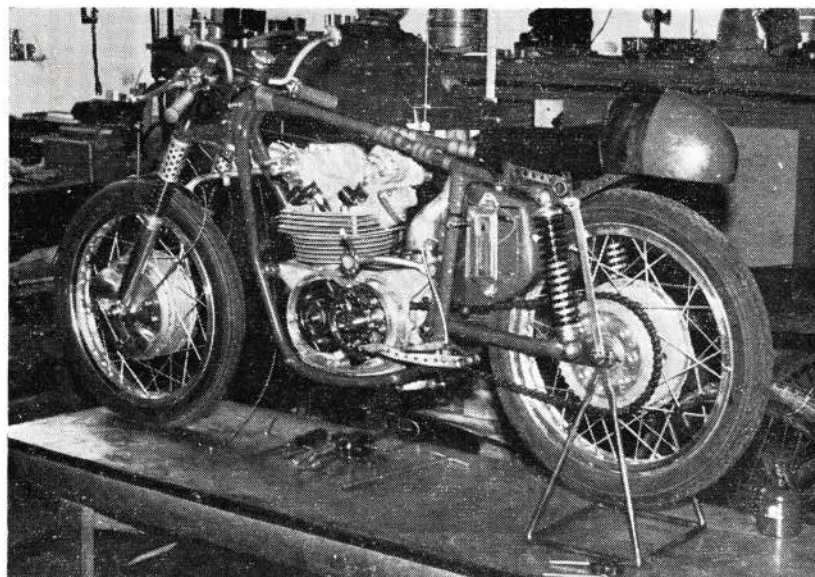

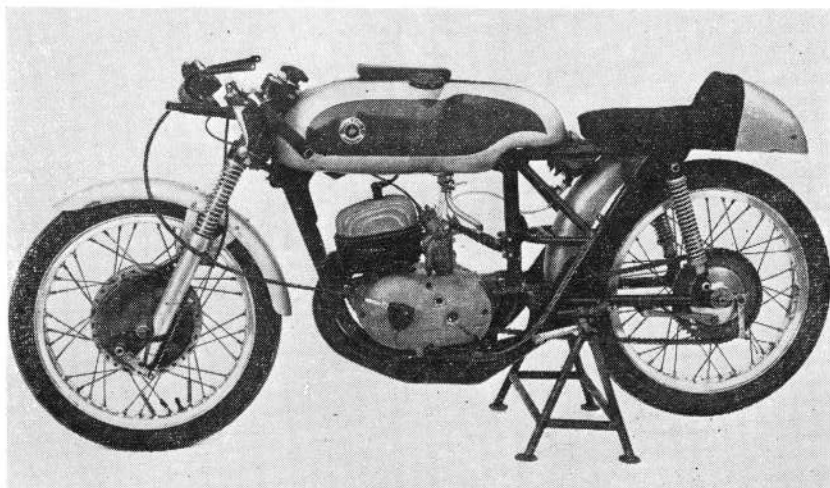
Florian Camathias has narrowly missed the Sidecar World Championship several times.. Aged 38, he tried solo racing in 1954 before turning his hand to three-wheels.
