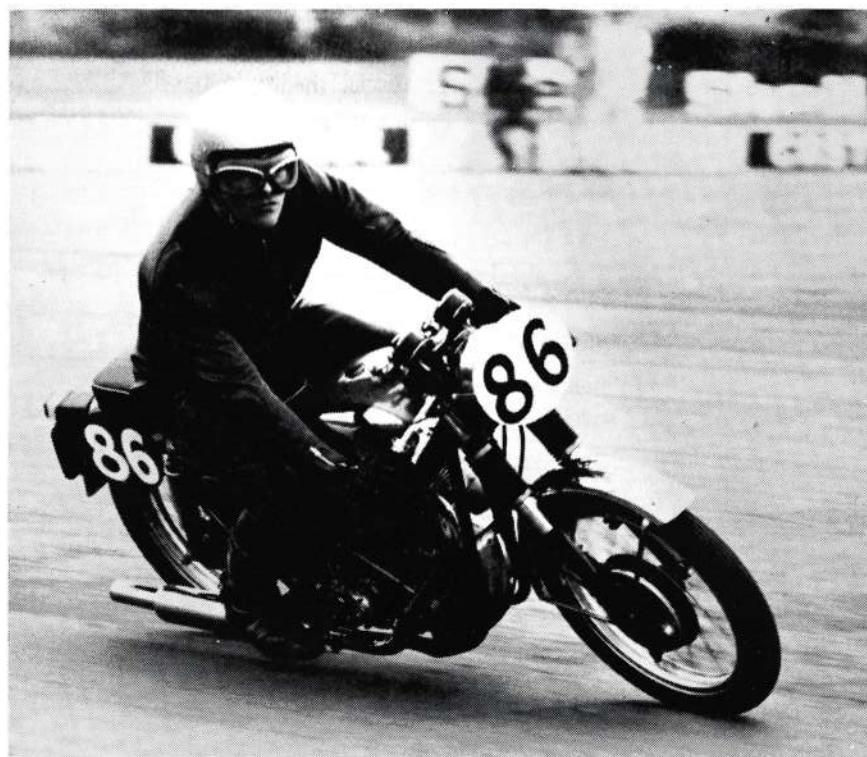

John is a design draughtsman with a firm of specialist engineers in Oxford. Clean living (i.e. can't afford any vices with a hobby like Road Racing), quiet spoken, self effacing and unassuming, John's easy-going manner makes him very likeable and easy to get on with.

Started racing in 1967, and has been a member of the Club since the first meeting. Campaigned the "Goldie" on which he is seen above in production class for several seasons before going over to pure racing on a 350cc Ducati.

No real success to date except the enjoyment of racing. During the past winter, John purchased a 500cc Seeley Metisse on the logical assumption that it would cope better with his six-foot bulk than the rather overworked Ducati.

He hopes to do better on the Seeley this season, which might be his last, since he is engaged to be married early next year if money permits (it's cheaper to keep on racing, believe me! —ED.).

Other interests are vintage bikes, long distance rallies and target rifle shooting. He tells me he cannot afford beer with a Seeley to maintain; that I can believe.

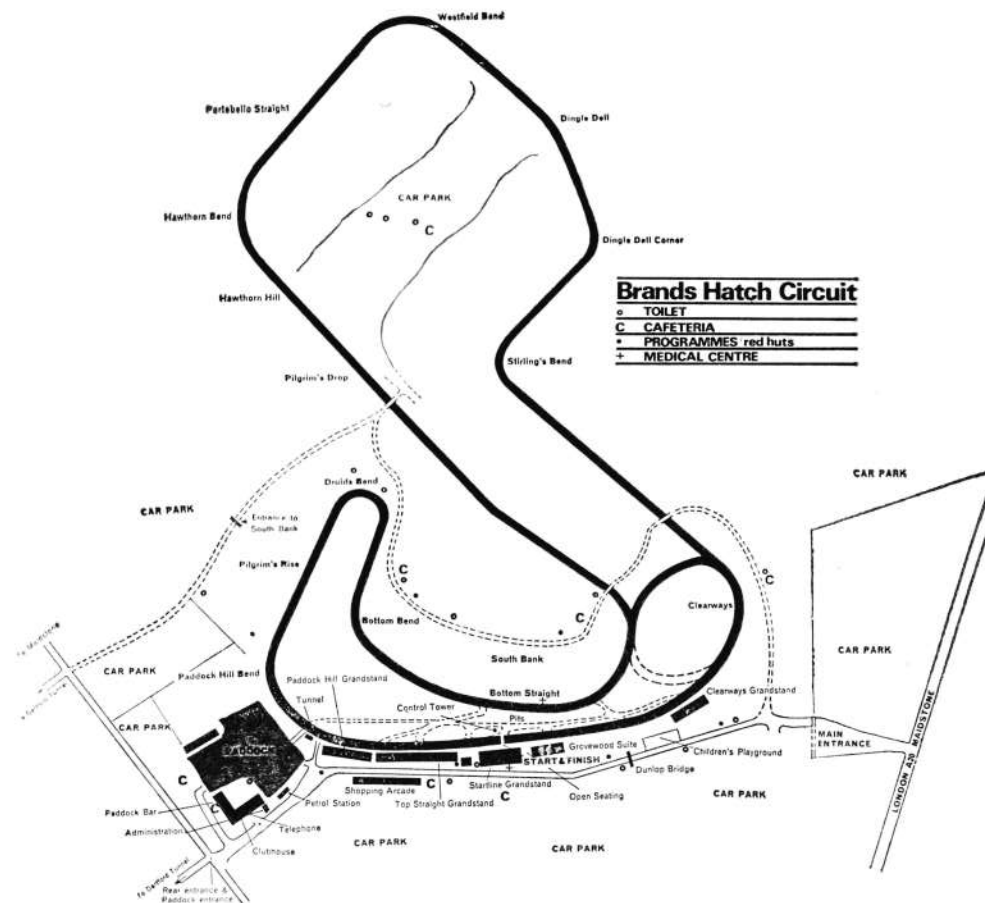

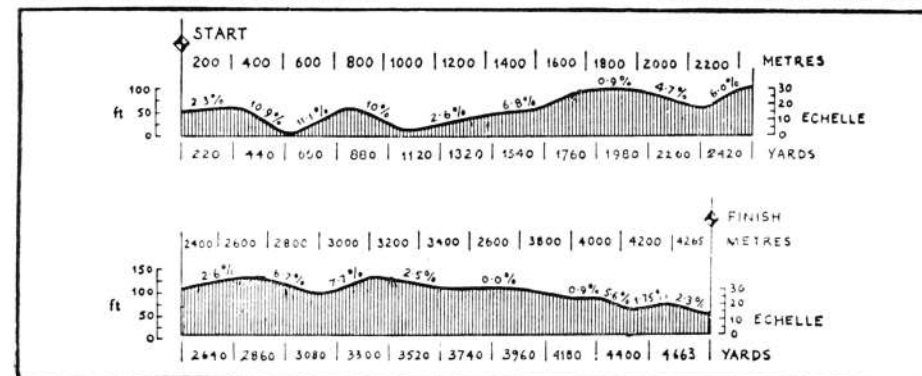
