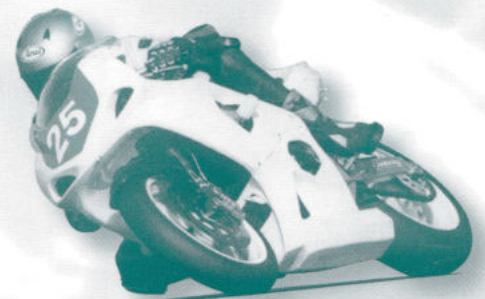

Powerbike Tour **BLAST OFF!**



Aprilia RS 125 Superteen

Last years Superteen series ended up here at Brands Hatch with a thrilling 8 way dice for the race win. If this years new riders can emulate that kind of performance, they'll be setting us up for a cracking season. Pre-race favorite must be Aaron Walker, who finished 3rd in last years series and was always in the battle for podium positions from mid-season onwards. James Hillier joined the series late last season but he quickly showed that he was on race winning pace and must be Walkers main rival today. These youngsters learn incredibly quickly though, so a surprise is always possible.

Aprilia RS 250 Challenge

Andy Whittley is hoping to become the first rider ever to retain the Aprilia RS 250 Challenge Cup. He out-rode his rivals last year, even when he had struggled in qualifying he somehow managed to turn in a good race result. John Lloyd and Daniel Hunter have moved up from the ultra-competitive Superteen series and will soon be looking to challenge the Whittley dominance.

Look out for Samantha Johnson (sister of ex-Aprilia challenge king, Martin) if she has the same level of natural ability, the rest of the field had best watch out.

Aprilia RSV 1000 Cup

This series also went down to the final round last year with Marshall Neill clinching the title here at Brands. John Rhodes could so easily have won the title but for a poor tyre choice at Snetterton mid-season. John has that situation well covered now with the use of a second bike, set up for wet conditions. Steve Booker was also a race winner last year and if he continues to improve at the same rate he will be a championship contender. Dark horses here could well be Stuart Maclure and Darren Jones, both have the ability to win. When this lot head for Paddock Hill Bend on lap one, it will sound like a fly past from the Battle of Britain Flight, such is the earth-shaking roar.

Grand Prix 125

Steve Patrickson and Howie Mainwaring resume their season long battle in this class today. They gave us some thrilling dices last year, but the overall victory went to Christian Elkin, who took the required 16 points at the last round at Lydden Hill.

The presence of the Brands Indy lap record holder, Sam Owens, should spice up the battle at the front. The Red Bull Rookie Team of Midge Smart and Guy Farbrother will be hoping to get their new team off to a winning start as well.

Chester Lusk and Ashley Beech have moved up from the Aprilia Superteens and both have got to grips with their GP bikes astoundingly quickly.

Daniel Coutts became the youngest ever Bemsee class champion last year (taking that honour from it's previous holder Mike Hailwood) and his skill on a motorcycle has now developed to such a stage that he won't be satisfied unless he gets a podium finish. Even in this company he has the ability to do just that, given the rub of the green. This will be a cracking race.

Grand Prix 250

When the decision was taken to drop this class from the British Championships, many of us thought it was a miss-print. 250 GP bikes are some of the most difficult, yet rewarding, machines to ride in the world. The racing is fast, furious, frantic and fantastic to watch. These tiny bikes are not modified production machines, they are purpose built racers. The only consideration when designing a GP bike is how to go as fast as possible with absolutely no compromise given such banalities as rider comfort. These quarter litre bikes will often outperform machines of four times the cubic capacity, but they must be ridden on the limit.....everywhere!

There are a host of riders who could challenge for the championship in this class, but todays race is surely going to set the stage for the series. Rich Grinling, Shaun Brown and Andy Sawford have the recent form to suggest that they will occupy the podium places. They may find themselves involved in a huge scrap to get

there though as Dean Johnson and Ricardo Ballerini are both well capable of taking the victory honours. Watch this race and tell me (with a straight face) that this class won't make a resurgence to the highest levels.

Supersport 600

Always known as the "headbangers" class, the Supersport 600 produces sizzling racing action without fail. Some grids are covered by less than 1 second in qualifying so one little mistake could cost several rows on the grid. In the past 28 races, only Blair Degerholm has managed to win an MRO Supersport race from anywhere further back than 10th on the grid, that's how tight the racing is.

Two former Champions of Brands are on the grid for this race, Chris Bishop and Adam Redding. Although these two have a proven record around this challenging little circuit, they certainly won't have an easy ride with this field of riders breathing down their necks.

Doug Cowie, Peter Baker, Ed Smith, Mark Holton and Declan Swanton have all recorded almost identical times around this venue in the past. All are proven winners and there are no quitters amongst them, if they get overtaken they will just dig deeper into their resolve and go faster still.

Add to this two current Bemsee Champions in the form of Ricky Chadwick and Sam Corke and we have the perfect recipe for the best 600cc championship in the UK, ...BAR NONE!

Powerbike

This one is even tougher than last year. When sitting down to consider the likely podium places for this race, I actually wrote down all the riders capable of lapping the Brands Indy circuit in sub 49 second times. The list ended up containing 29 names and at that point I felt the need for a strong drink!

I don't know of another championship where the competition for places on the grid is so tough that you genuinely could not pick one winner from 30 riders. If anyone wins this by more than a bike length it will be nothing short of a miracle.

Steve Marks won here last summer after Dave Wood had crashed out of his early lead but the quality of the field has increased to such a level that he might find that a difficult act to follow. Francis Williamson certainly has the pedigree and the ability but he will have to hold off challenges from Dave Johnson, Doug Cowie, Nick Chadwick and Steve Tomes.

Tony Waistnage may only be 16 years old but he has shown already that he is ready to challenge all comers. Running in the same pack as riders of the calibre of Jason Davis, Chris Heath and Steve Thompson will only serve to speed up his already impressive learning curve.

Outsiders for a shot at the podium include old stagers Richard Defago and Tom Knight, they will be hoping to teach the youngsters a thing or two about race craft.

Super Sidecars

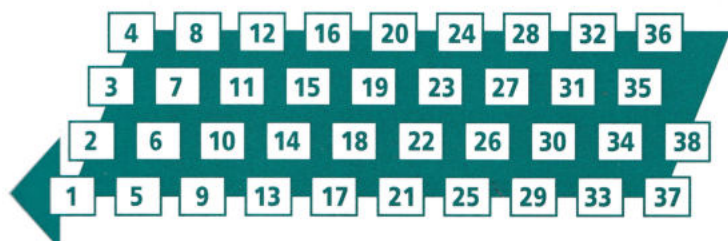
With Tom Hanks away at the first round of the World Cup, it will be up to Roy to uphold the family honour. He may find himself watching the more powerful 1000cc outfits disappear into the distance though as his 600cc machine struggles for outright power. Tim & Tristan Reeves must be the hot favourites as their local rival Trev Stafford has just been discharged from hospital after a bout of pneumonia which has left him too weak to push to the limit.

Look out for the northern challenge in the shape of Dave Holden (ADM 500) and Bryan Peddar (Windle 1000). Dave has finished 3rd and 2nd in the last two years championships and if he wins this year it would be a popular result all round.
