Welcome to Brands Hatch and this the first meeting of 1991 for the Classic Racing Motorcycle Club.

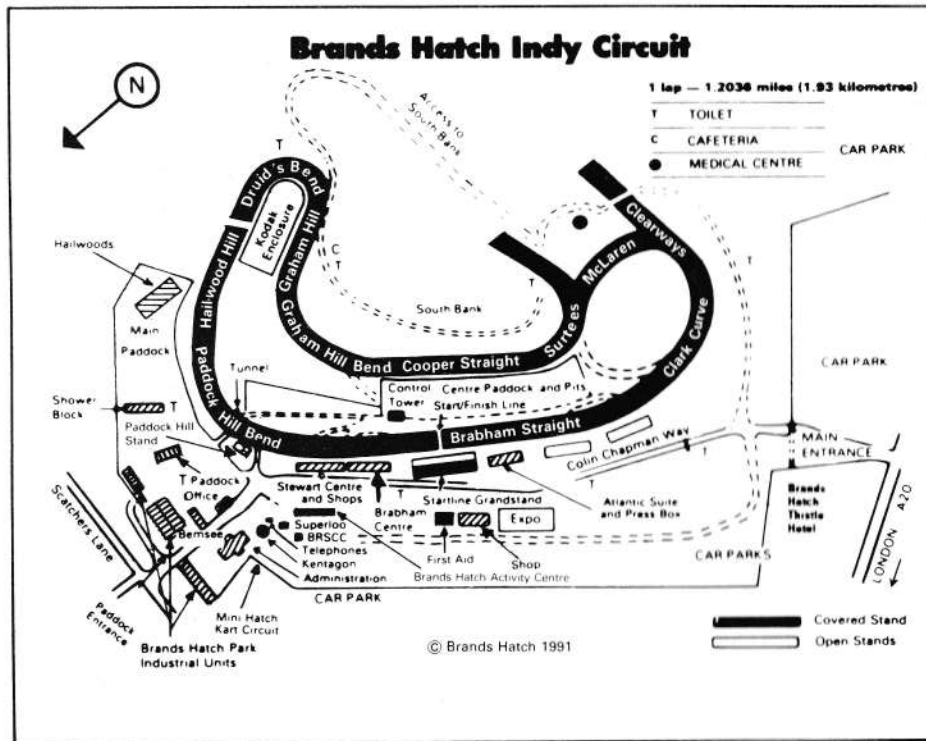
For the first time in its eleven years of racing, the C.R.M.C. are running a championship throughout the year for all the racing classes and from this first meeting championship leaders will emerge.

## Flag Signals

**Blue/Steady:** Another competitor is close. Waved: Another competitor is trying to pass.

**White:** Service vehicle or very slow car on circuit.

**Yellow/Steady:** Danger ahead, no overtaking, slow down.

**Yellow/Waved:** Great danger ahead, no overtaking, slow down, be prepared to stop.

**Yellow with Red Stripes:** Slippery surface ahead.

**Green:** Proceed, hazard indicated has been cleared.

**Red:** Stop racing, proceed slowly to pits or startline as instructed by marshals.

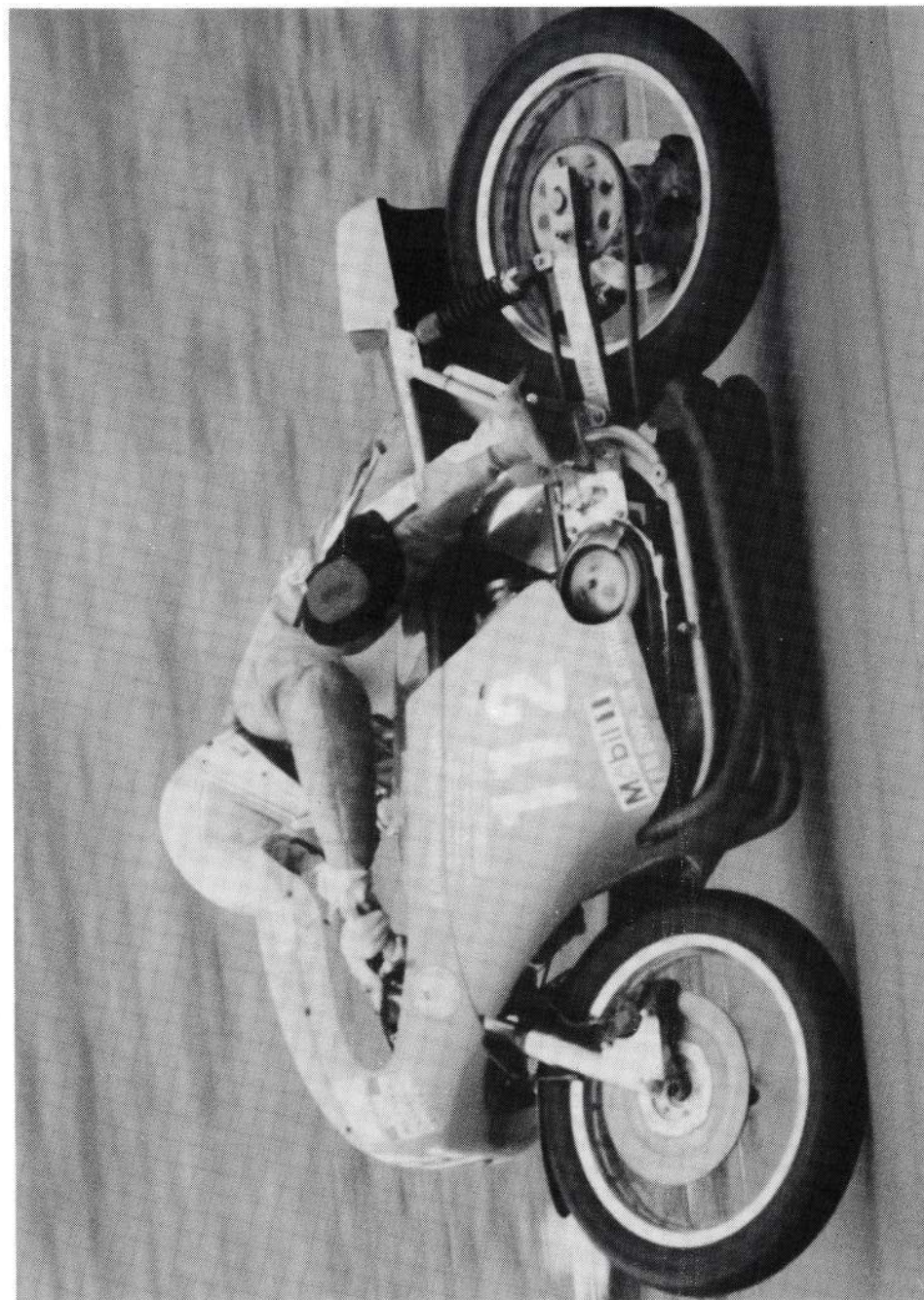
**Black (at individual marshal's posts):** Race stopped.

**Black/Orange Disc displayed with White number:** Warning of mechanical failure which might not be obvious to driver, call into pits immediately.

**Black/White rectangular with White number:** Warning to driver that his behaviour (i.e. corner cutting) is suspect and he may be black flagged.

**Black displayed with White number:** Driver must call in immediately and report to the Clerk of the Course.

**Black/White Chequered:** End of race.

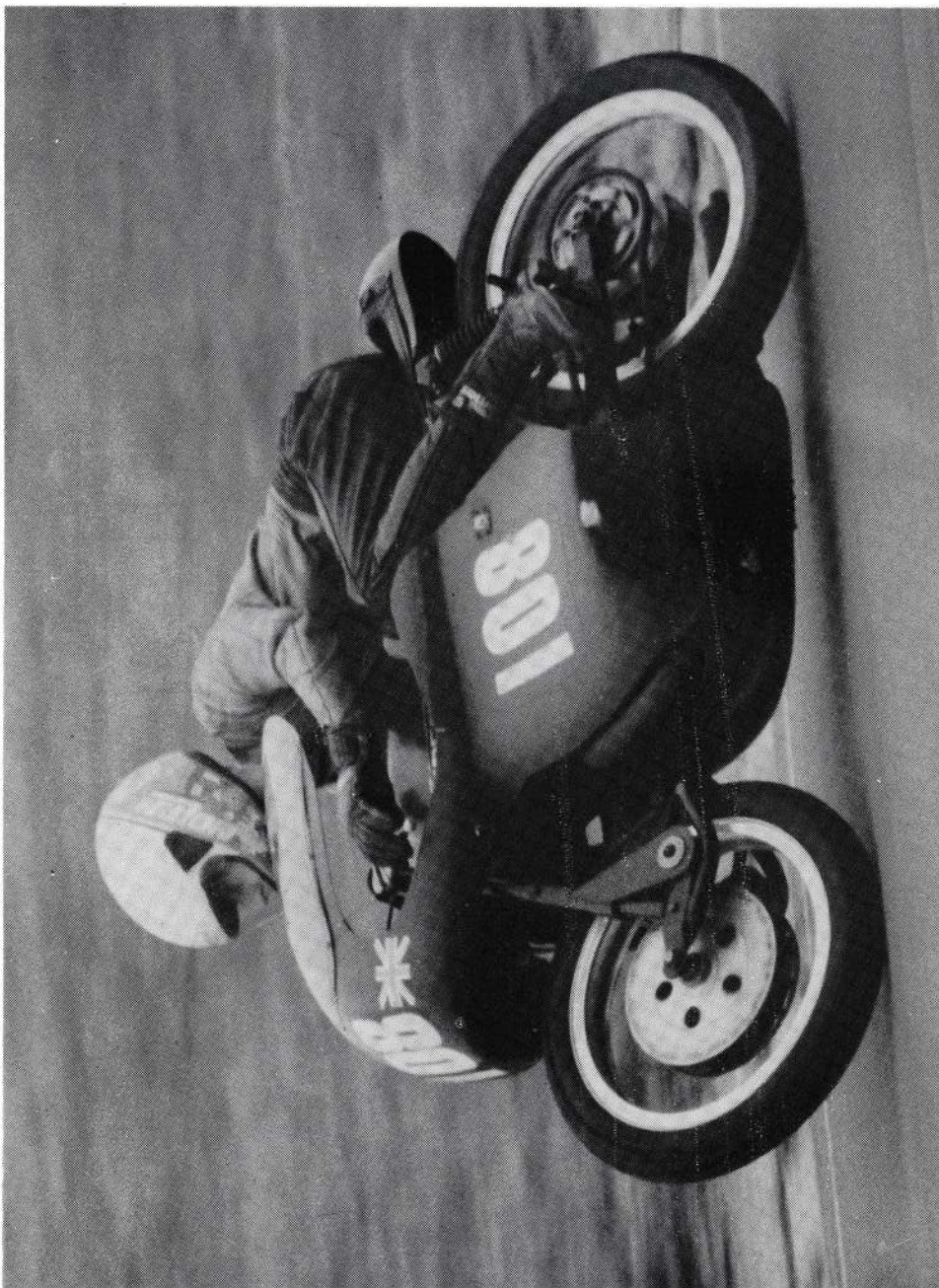

## 1991 CRMC CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS

The new 1991 CRMC Club Championships are the first to be run by the CRMC itself and will incorporate the existing RACECO Trophy for 250 Group 2 championship and the BARWIL Trophy for Period 1 sidecars. Simon Wilson will continue with this championship and will also organise the Club championship for Period 2 sidecars along the same rules.

Championship points will be awarded for the following classes:-

1. 250cc Group 1
2. Up to 200cc
3. 500cc Group 1 (P&O European Ferries trophy)
4. 501cc to Unlimited
5. 250cc Group 2 (RACECO Trophy)
6. 350cc Periods 1 & 2.
7. 500cc Group 2
8. Formula 750
9. Group 3

The Championship races will be the first races on each single race day and the first races on the second day of a two-day meeting and will be published in the programme. There will be no championship races at the Race of the Year meeting at Snetterton.

Points will be awarded on the basis of:-

- 9 points for 1st place
- 6 points for 2nd place
- 5 points for 3rd place
- 3 points for 4th place
- 2 points for 5th place
- 1 point for 6th place

No rider can score championship points on the same machine in more than one class on any one day.

A minimum of ten riders shall start in each class for championship points to be awarded for that race.

The championship will be decided on the best six results over the season. No individual race trophies will be awarded for Championship races, winners will receive a Championship Trophy at the end of the season.

The championship organiser's decision is final.

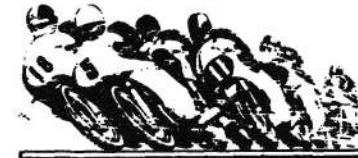
