

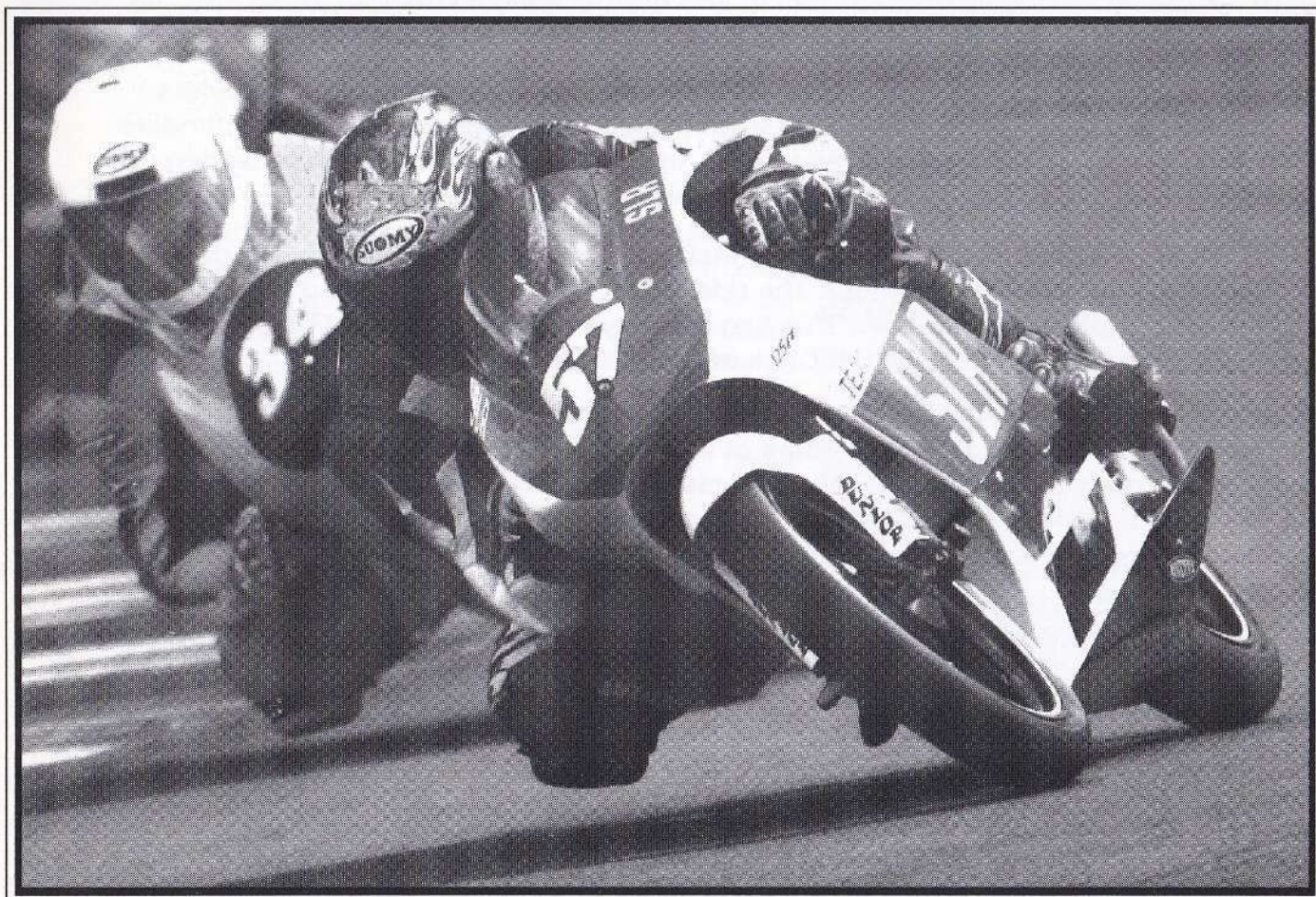

## Important Notice FLAG SIGNALS USED AT NEW ERA SAFETY CAR EVENTS

### FLAGS GIVING INFORMATION & INSTRUCTIONS

**RED FLAG OR RED LIGHTS:** The Race or Practice is being interrupted for safety reasons. Riders must immediately cease racing and return slowly to the Pits, or as directed by the Marshals acting on the instructions of the Clerk of the Course.

**YELLOW FLAG:** Danger on this section of the track. When shown motionless riders must prepare to slow down. When shown waved, the danger is imminent and riders must slow down and be prepared to stop. In both cases overtaking is forbidden up until the point where the green flag is shown.

**BLACK:** This flag is designed to convey instructions to one rider only and is displayed together with the rider's number. The rider must stop in the at the end of the current lap and cannot restart. This flag is always shown at the start/finish line on special instructions from the Clerk of the Course.

**BLACK WITH ORANGE DISK ( 40 cm dia. )** Shown together with a white number on a black signalling board, on the orders of the Clerk of the Course at the start/finish line, it informs the rider whose motorcycle number is displayed that his motorcycle has mechanical problems likely to endanger himself or others, and he must immediately leave the track.

**WHITE FLAG WITH RED DIAGONAL CROSS:** This flag informs the riders that the race has been neutralised and will be shown at each Marshal's Post. A White Board showing the words "SAFETY CAR" will also be displayed at the Start Line. Riders must immediately slow down. Overtaking is forbidden. When the leading rider approaches the Start Line a Safety Car with two flashing Yellow Lights switched on will enter the track. Riders will line up in single file behind the Safety Car without overtaking it. During the last lap of the neutralisation period the Safety Car will switch off the Lights to indicate to the riders that it will enter the Pit lane at the end of that lap and the race will continue. Overtaking is forbidden up until the Start Line where a Green Flag will be waved and all the White Flags with Red Diagonal Crosses will be withdrawn.

### FLAGS & LIGHTS GIVING INFORMATION

**UNION JACK:** Start of a race.

**GREEN:** Course is clear of all hazards This flag is shown on the first lap of each practice session, on the sighting lap and the warm-up lap. After the last yellow flag, the green flag will be shown motionless at the following flag marshal's post to

**YELLOW WITH RED STRIPES:** Oil, water or another substance is affecting adhesion on this section of the track.

**YELLOW WITH BLACK CROSS:** Denotes start of last lap.

### SLOW MOVING VEHICLES ON THE TRACK

Ambulances, Fast Intervention Vehicle (FIV), and other slow moving vehicle on the track may be encountered by riders during a Race Neutralisation or when riders are despatched from the Assembly Area on their "Sighting Lap" to the Startline prior to the start of a race. This "Sighting Lap" is not considered to be either Practice or Racing and riders must always be prepared to encounter such vehicles. RC30 Flagsig.Pm5.P1

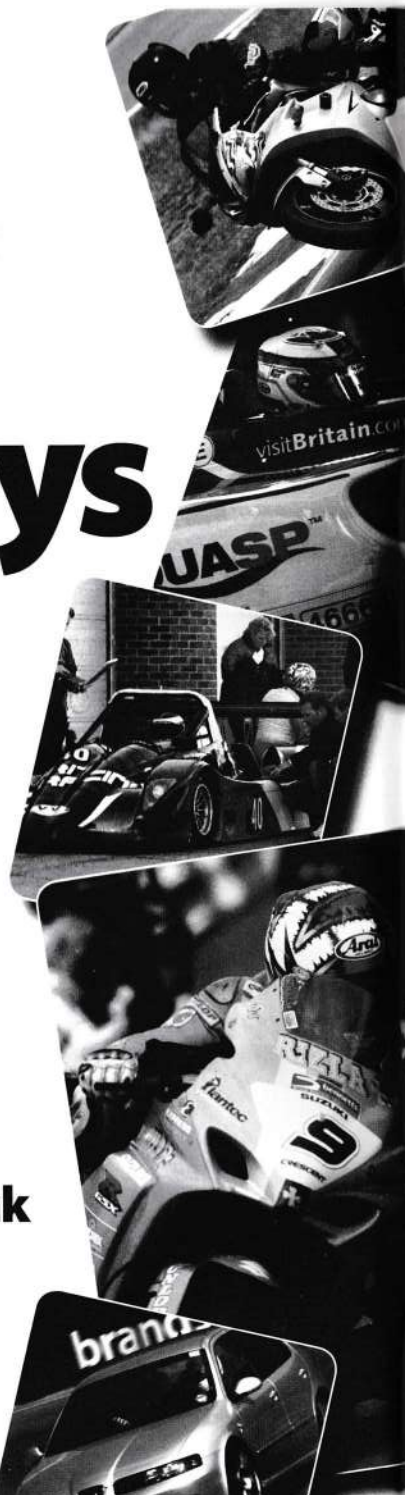

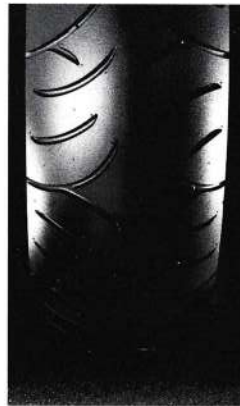

## ACU / 2008 Yokohama / FSRA British F2 Sidecar Championship

Welcome to Brands Hatch and the ninth round in this year's championship.

For the last two years Brands Hatch has been the venue for the opening round of the championship but this weekend sees the famous track host the ninth of an enthralling eleven race series. Mathematically any one of 14 teams could still win the championship but realistically the winner will come from the top six.

After wins in the last two races at Donington and Castle Combe, double TT winners Nick Crowe and Mark Cox lead the way on 106 points, just five in front of Snetterton winners, Roy Hanks and Dave Wells. No race wins as yet for Gary Horspole and Scott Parnell but podiums at Donington and Castle Combe have helped them to third place and 99 points, while in fourth on 85 points are Simon Neary and Stu Bond, 21 behind the leaders. But 21 is less than a race win and Simon and Stu are the only previous winners of a Brands championship race in recent years here today. And not just once, for in addition to their 2007 opening round victory, they scored a double win in 2005.

Conrad Harrison and Lee Patterson lie fifth on 79 points, a fine reward for their consistency which has seen them placed from 4<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> positions in all eight races so far. In sixth and hopefully back on track today are John Holden and Andy Winkle, clear leaders of the championship after three wins in the opening four races but John's hand injuries from his

Southern 100 crash have seen the pair miss the last four.

So, those are the top six. No one will win the championship today but the result could reduce the chances of some of the title pretenders. The same goes for the F2 Cup where only five teams can still win the championship. With five 'maximums' from the eight races Steve Coombes and Gary Partridge lead the way on 145 points but David Lillie and Lee Watson, with a first win at Donington and a runner-up spot at Castle Combe, have narrowed the gap to 15 points. Early leaders Dean Henry and Ian Smith have been stuck on 90 points with their recent engine blow-ups and that has seen both Matt and Jo Williams, and Dean Lindley and Mark Sayers close in on their third place. Matt and Jo were models of consistency until their Castle Combe prang but they are on 82, eight ahead of Dean and Mark. This young pairing began with three non-scores but five point scoring places including three podiums have seen them rise to fifth place.

All told, spectators today should see a wonderful battle with close racing throughout the field, especially with so many of the teams having a say in the final outcome of both championships.
